The **lesser of two evils principle**, also referred to as the **lesser evil principle** and **lesser-evilism**, is the principle that when faced with selecting from two immoral options, the least immoral one should be chosen. The principle is sometimes recalled in reference to binary political choices in democratic voting under a two party system. <sup>4</sup>

Remember - One of the most successful and seductive strategies of evil is to convince us our only choice is evil—that we must choose between the lesser of two evils.

No. We don't.

But you might justify doing so...

The moral dilemma behind these scenarios is the subject of a well-known argument in moral philosophy. Bernard Williams argued that you should care about maintaining integrity in your personal ideals — not necessarily at all costs, but at least a bit. That's because you have a special proprietary responsibility for acts you perform. Those choices and acts are, in some special sense, *yours*, distinct from outcomes that result from combining your choices and acts with everyone else's. <sup>5</sup>

It's all you – your choice – your consequences.

- ➤ People with healthy self-esteem who don't suffer the dire insecurities that narcissists do, are comfortable to allow others to shine or know more than themselves, and can ask questions and be genuinely interested.



- ➤ Narcissists, however, need to have centre stage complete with people seemingly being mesmerized by the narcissist's accomplishments, brilliance and talents.
- ➤ He or she will be deflated, sullen and moody if this is not the case, or even downright nasty, such as discrediting anybody who stole the attention that he or she so desperately needs in order to try to feel "normal". \*\*




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## Memories of a Dream





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## Psychic Space and the Law of Non-Interference

One thing that can often make for problematic situations amongst groups of people is the idea of, or lack of, recognized psychic space by which is meant the emotional and varying mental aspects of space, both on the inner planes and relating states of consciousness, as well as the inner states of every human being in the Physical Realm. The boundaries of these are often not recognized or shared between any group, and that only becomes harder between different groups of people, one often refusing to respect the space and freedom of choice, as well as the basic right to make a choice of any other. In Eckankar we refer to this as the Law of Non-Interference, which states "Anyone who uses any means of change or influence on another's mind, including prayer, is violating a law of spiritual consciousness." \*

A person's space is no different than a home owned by one, no one can enter it unless first invited or allowed by the owner, and any who enter under any other circumstance, is a criminal. And this works to the same extent in reverse. It can be said that a person's space extends right out to the point where another's begins. Any individual who is minding their own business, and is not stepping out into another's, may do as they see fit, so long as it harms no other. A situation where a person wants another to do a thing that they have said no to, who then proceeds to attempt to talk the person into doing that thing, is quite literally attempting mind control. There are no exceptions within that framework. Not many would recognize such a simple, everyday situation such as that as being an attempt at mind control until it is done to themselves, where it suddenly becomes far more obvious.

One who has perceptive "gifts", that can perceive more deeply than the average person must also be very careful not to invade another's space without first gaining permission. While they might well have a flow of information incoming that can be turned off, also if one hasn't yet learned how to do that, the very least they can do is be respectful and remain silent. Not everything that comes in necessarily needs to be said aloud. This is often a matter of self-control, and if one says something that causes a disturbance, they may find themselves rightfully to blame for that.

In any such case where one's psychic space has been invaded, there will always be a karmic debt incurred. This is simply another way of saying that that individual that used the invasive behavior has chosen to learn the principles of the lesson in a harder way, one that is generally referred to as "bad" karma. When this happens, the individual themselves have made and are responsible for, the choice that brought the karma into being. Because of this, they and they alone can re-balance the scales, and in every case, the way this occurs is by completing the cycle of karma and learning the lesson, also putting into being a more evolved choice which proves the lesson has indeed been learned. Thenceforth the individual can recognize the same circumstances in a great many situations and have better options to deal with them and by doing that, avoid a cycle of repeating the same mistakes.

Where the psychic space of others and the Law of Non-Interference are concerned, the Golden Rule applies: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you." And after applying the Law of Karma to it, one might add to the quote: "Because they WILL!" Those that consistently indulge themselves in following a double standard will undoubtedly find that karmic law is very detailed and accurate. It cannot be dodged or outrun, and it never falls victim to trickery and cannot be deceived.

A thing as simple as talking someone into something, is nothing less than an attempt at mind control as well as an invasion of another's space that might not seem so obvious at first glance. The fact that a person needs to be talked into a thing denotes that they are not willing to engage in it to begin with, and thus, an attempt to change that person's decision is invasive. Many have no idea of this fact. It is no different when a child seeks to talk a parent into giving them a liberty, they might otherwise not have available to them, however, in such a case generally no grudge is held and rightly so, however, after a certain age, such things will most often no longer be tolerated. It lasts as long as does that child's cuteness and is outgrown quickly.

One aspect of "space" in general that isn't often considered at all is whether a person is extending their own space outward to include things they would rather not include or be affected by. Often this can be causing a reaction unconsciously for one. A thing one had never thought of as having any effect on them can be having an unknown effect that isn't so easily recognized by all.

It pays to become aware of all the things one's attention is extended to include. Some of the time problems can actually be drawn towards us by ourselves acting in an unconscious way. What I mean is that we don't always realize the true effect a thing might have upon us, so that we continue onward never realizing that a thing we have extended our attention in some way out to include might have a negative effect upon us, and the only way to remove that is to become aware of it, and removing our attention and thus our state of consciousness away from it, and in this way becoming better aware of the true effect a thing can have in this way, so that we can look out for this happening again. For example, one might think something not so nice or considerate about a friend, based on a prejudicial attitude one some aspect of that person's life, one which is completely within their rights to have. By not having been aware of in the first place, our mistake in judgment, and in the second place, the effect of said judgment, we can bring negativity into our purview that we would rather not have to deal with.

In this case a more honest and complete view of the self is needed, as well as the development of a less judgmental view of others and the choices some might make. Nothing less than adapting in this way will begin chipping away at the formation of a less than advantageous point of view of others. It is generally not a terrible way of looking at a situation, by placing ourselves in that other's position to gain a notion of what it would be like were positions reversed. This can go far for developing degrees of consideration that may not have been so easily come by before then.

The idea of psychic space is on one hand a very familiar concept to some, but on the other hand, almost unheard or thought of by many others, and because of this the rules regarding it are often unclear to many. Healing of any sort is a thing that falls very much within the area of an individual's space, and stands at risk to be possibly invaded by those unaware of the limits of their own free will, which are of course up to the point at which another's space begins. Any average doctor would never begin medical treatment until any potential patient came to them willingly, seeking medical help. This obvious situation is many times much less obvious in the area of psychic or spiritual healers, and most often this is the specific area where invasions occur. A happy Muslim isn't likely to enjoy having Jehovah's Witnesses coming to their door weekly attempting to "save" them by convincing them to change their religion.



In the very same way, any healer will find it not only impossible to heal a person that hasn't yet asked to be healed, but also that if they go forward uninvited with such an action, there will be a heavy karmic burden to bear. These things, regardless of motivation, break spiritual law and bear a karmic price.

And on the positive side of this, if a person is unwell and asks for a healing, or for further information on a different spiritual path than the one they had been on, an interested person can certainly offer aid and information that they might have the capacity to perform. And the very same standard applies to inner spiritual teachings, one who considers themselves, or is considered by others to be a teacher, and who has the ability to channel spiritual teachings and experience to a student, cannot ever do so without first asking

Trees are sanctuaries. Whoever knows how to speak to them, whoever knows how to listen to them, can learn the truth. They do not preach learning and precepts, they preach, undeterred by particulars, the ancient law of life.

A tree says: A kernel is hidden in me, a spark, a thought, I am life from eternal life. The attempt and the risk that the eternal mother took with me is unique, unique the form and veins of my skin, unique the smallest play of leaves in my branches and the smallest scar on my bark. I was made to form and reveal the eternal in my smallest special detail.



But when we have learned how to listen to trees, then the brevity and the quickness and the childlike hastiness of our thoughts achieve an incomparable joy. Whoever has learned how to listen to trees no longer wants to be a tree.

He wants to be nothing except what he is. That is home. That is happiness.





## Hu, a Most Wondrous Prayer (With a Few Words about Non-Directed Prayer)

First, we know that Hu is the name used by the Persians to speak of God which was later brought to India and we know it as Sanskrit, but there was more, this coming from Proto-Germany who used a very similar term. Etymologist have always debated which came first, but we'll leave that to them. It is the etymological source of the English word God and according to some, the word was used as the name of God in Persia, but here we want to think about prayer.

It was said in the late 1960's by Paul Twitchell that HU was different than a prayer as other religious groups might use, but it has still developed into becoming a prayer in the way of expressing the same gratitude, hope, and feeling in the modern day.

Spiritually speaking, HU is very real, and is one of the most powerful things that can be found though not all can witness the blessings it brings. It is originally, God's voice as IT sang the worlds and all in them into creation (John, 1:1). Even the Egyptians knew this and named the Sphinx HU or Hwl. This is where we find differences with prayer, but these are mostly a matter of understanding as to rightful or wrongful use. IT is deeply powerful and emanates from the Absolute that we call Sugmad, which is why it can never be used to influence anyone to do a thing that is against their will or to do negative. We humans use HU as a love song to God, so while it can be a prayer, it is much more than that too. This too falls under the category of purification, which is most often not so easy to do.

Always let God be God. Don't encroach on ITS will or activities by insisting a thing be done your way. Accept what you're given and use it to learn from. There are always multiple lessons contained in each example.

When some pray, they can sometimes move into the area of personality more than they should, and this leads to being demanding or sometimes other ways of acting that tend to not be in the spirit of helping or giving which are best when they are a part of prayer. When one finds themselves acting this way, it can be hard or easy to change, depending on the person. Try to lighten up and let go of some of the troubles that weigh you down as well as any selfish desire for revenge, or the egotistical way of always winning. Instead, try being helpful to someone else who is in need. This can be very rewarding though it may not be expected. When it comes down to a non-directed prayer, one sentence can remind us of the nature of one, "not my will be done, but God's will be done." That point is the whole thing on non-directed prayer.

Carl Edward Sagan, November 9, 1934 – December 20, 1996) was an American astronomer, planetary scientist, astronomer, cosmologist, astrophysicist, astrobiologist, and author and science communicator. His best known scientific contribution is research on extraterrestrial life, including experimental demonstration of the production of amino acids from basic chemicals by radiation. Sagan assembled the first physical messages sent into space, the Pioneer Plague and the Voyager Golden Record, universal messages that could potentially be understood by any extraterrestrial intelligence that might find them. Sagan argued the hypothesis, accepted since, that the high surface temperatures of Venus can be attributed to, and calculated using, the greenhouse effect.

## **Exercise: Letting Go**

## If Your Dwelling Doesn't Feel Well, Neither Do You

Most of us like to have a clean dwelling. We clean out physical clutter, open the windows to clear the air and/or even purchase expensive purifiers and humidifiers to make the spaces healthier. But what about energetic clutter? If the atmosphere is invaded by negative energy, we are surrounded by it and probably feel ill from it.

This negativity is usually human generated – you had a bad day and are feeling blue or angry, you had a fight with a family member, broke up with a partner or ended a long standing friendship, had a traumatic or transitional life change or, on the supernatural level dragged in a negative attachment from somewhere else. The energies created by all this can contribute to the temperament of the environment making it feel "heavy" and unwelcoming as soon as you step through the door.

Here are some suggestions to help "clear the air" and bring light and ease back into the space.

After you have cleared out physical clutter try the following:

- 1. It starts with you. Set an intention for your space and how you would like it to feel. Always remember that form follows thought. Try saying out loud, "My intention is to clear this space of all negativity so I am peaceful, safe and productive." If you feel some of the negativity is based in another person who either lived or visited there, then vocalize specifically you are removing that energy as well. Stating intentions out loud is a key factor as it sets shifts in motion.
- 2. If it appeals to you, try some Feng Shui methods. Often rearranging furniture, art, mirrors etc. makes a big difference. There are plenty of sources on the internet where you can read about the process. Particularly pay attention to the color theory of Feng Shui. A fresh paint change can be very helpful.

3. Sage. Saging is a time tested method in clearing spaces. It "smokes" out negativity. If you cannot sage for health reasons then try some live green houseplants as they are great absorbers.

4. Crystals. A few crystals placed strategically around the space keep energy moving and also absorb negativity. Dark stones like Hematite or Black Tourmaline are literally known for absorbing negative energy. A piece of Citrine coupled with clear quartz can work wonders in the kitchen in the food prep area. Family rooms or living rooms benefit from Amethyst while entryways and foyers benefit from Rose Quartz, Pyrite or Carnelian. Selenite is beneficial for bedrooms while Celestite does well for kids' rooms.

5. Crazy as this sounds, make noise. If you have a sing bowl, use it. Use gongs or try drumming. If you have none of these tools simply walk through the space and clap your hands. Sounds especially melodious tones drive negativity out. The difference between these methods and simply playing music is that they are made intentionally and pack more of a punch.

- 6. Salt. This is a very old but effective measure.
  - Dissolve *sea salt* in a spray bottle filled with spring water and mist the air of every room. You don't need to use a lot of salt. Remember it can be corrosive.
  - Place a thin line of sea salt in front of your home's entrance or around the perimeter of your property.
  - Use Himalayan Salt Lamps.

There is always debate about salt. Kosher salt, Sea salt or Himalayan salt work best.

7. Diffusers. Many people like to use essential oils and waxes in diffusers and burners. I would caution that if you have pets these items can be harmful. Otherwise have at it. A safe substitute is to simply simmer some lemon peels in a pan so the steam can cleanse the area.

Try out the methods that suit you and your space and live happier and healthier. You'll like the way it feels



## Herbs that Heal Topical Wounds

We all experienced cuts, scrapes, bumps and bruises. Certain herbal remedies may offer relief from symptoms and help topical wounds heal faster. Herbs are generally available as dried extracts (pills, capsules, or tablets), teas, or tinctures. Follow directions on these products.

## Applied to skin wounds only:

Note: Never apply herbs to open wounds unless under a doctor's supervision.

- **Aloe** (*Aloe Vera*), as a cream or gel. Aloe has been used traditionally to treat minor wounds and burns, but scientific studies about its effectiveness are mixed. In one study, aloe seemed to extend the time needed for surgical wounds to heal.
- Calendula (*Calendula officinalis*), or pot marigold, as an ointment or a tea applied topically. To make tea from tincture, use 1/2 to 1 tsp. diluted in 1/4 cup water. You can also steep 1 tsp. of flowers in one cup of boiling water for 15 minutes, then strain and cool. Test skin first for any allergic reaction.
- Marshmallow (*Althaea officinalis*) as a topical ointment to help wounds heal and fight inflammation.
- **Tea tree oil** (*Melaleuca alternifolia*) as oil or cream. Apply 2 times per day to reduce inflammation. DO NOT use tea tree oil to treat burns.
- **Gotu kola** (*Centella asiatica*) as a cream containing 1% of the herb, to help heal wounds.
- Chamomile (*Matricaria recutita* or *Chamaemelum Nobile*), as an ointment or cream, to help heal wounds.
- Echinacea or coneflower (*Echinacea spp.*) as a gel or ointment containing 15% of the juice of the herb.
- **Slippery elm bark** (*Ulmus rubra* or *fulva*) as a poultice. Mix 1 tsp. dried powder in one of cup of boiling water. Cool and apply to a clean, soft cloth. Place on affected area.

Trauma victims cannot recover until they become familiar with and befriend the sensations in their bodies. Being frightened means that you live in a body that is always on guard. Angry people live in angry bodies. The bodies of child-abuse victims are tense and defensive until they find a way to relax and feel safe. In order to change, people need to become aware of their sensations and the way that their bodies interact with the world around them. Physical self-awareness is the first step in releasing the tyranny of the past.

In my practice I begin the process by helping my patients to first notice and then describe the feelings in their bodies—not emotions such as anger or anxiety or fear but the physical sensations beneath the emotions: pressure, heat, muscular tension, tingling, caving in, feeling hollow, and so on. I also work on identifying the sensations associated with relaxation or pleasure. I help them become aware of their breath, their gestures and movements.

All too often, however, drugs such as Abilify, Zyprexa, and Seroquel, are prescribed instead of teaching people the skills to deal with such distressing physical reactions. Of course, medications only blunt sensations and do nothing to resolve them or transform them from toxic agents into allies.

The mind needs to be reeducated to feel physical sensations, and the body needs to be helped to tolerate and enjoy the comforts of touch. Individuals who lack emotional awareness are able, with practice, to connect their physical sensations to psychological events. Then they can slowly reconnect with themselves.

## Druidic Healing



Druidic Healing can be considered an alternate healing method. Contemporary Druids of today would include both physical and spiritual health through diet, exercise and energy manipulation. Some may also include reiki, healing spells or rituals, and herbalism. The ancient Druids were the priest class of the Gallic and Celtic cultures, and contemporary groups such as the Order of Bards, Ovates and Druids, and the Ar nDraiocht Fein (ADF) base their contemporary system of Druidry on aspects of ancient Celtic practices and knowledge.

Herbal Remedies were a mainstay amongst the Celts and included St. John's wort and vervain, which were taken internally as teas or tinctures. Other plants were used symbolically in rituals such as Mistletoe which is highly poisonous and never taken internally. Mistletoe was a particular favorite of the Ancient Druids and can be found in use throughout their history. Exactly how it was used is unknown since the original Druid adhered to oral history where nothing was ever written and handed down.

Druid healing spells and rituals usually combine some form of incantation as a request for healing and the visualization of healing energy or light being sent to the person being healed. Healing herbs may also be burned as incense or strewn around the area to increase the strength of the spell. I have always protected myself whenever I go on an investigation and there was once that I think that I was protected from going on an investigation. The story begins with an investigation that was planned for a Saturday afternoon that was several hours away by location. I did not set up the investigation but was invited to take part in the investigation by another paranormal investigator. The background story that I was told was that the site used to be a plantation that housed many slaves most of who were killed on the property during the Civil War. The investigator who invited me to assist on the investigation also said that the client was being very pesky about having the location investigated.

We had planned to meet up there and all ride in the same car to the site. I was the farthest one away from the meeting place and the site of the investigation and was going to have to leave at 10 am to get to the meeting place by 12 pm. So I set my alarm for 8 am and had all my equipment ready and in my vehicle before bed. I went to bed early because it was going to be a long day and I did not think that I would be home before 2 or 3 am.

It was around 6 am when I was awakened with the need to go to the bathroom and after I finished I went back to bed. Then at 7 am I was suddenly awakened feeling very sick. It was hard to sit up or even get to the bathroom. So for the next three hours I was so sick that I decided that I was not going to be able to go on the investigation. I called the investigator and cancelled and went back to bed. Then around 12 pm I woke up feeling really good like I had not been sick at all, no ill effects or fever. I knew that I could not get to the meeting point as I did not have the directions to the site of the investigation. I did not have any clue to why I had been so sick and then was suddenly feeling better. I did some work around the house, I had my meals and felt really good, now when I say I felt really good that includes not feeling depressed or guilty about missing out on the investigation. I was also in a very upbeat mood.

On Sunday I contacted the investigator and was invited to look over photos taken on the site. I was also told that it was a 'really weird place' and that everyone who was on the team agreed on the way home that the place gave them the creeps.

The very next Saturday I met up with the team and they all had some interesting pictures - lots of orbs some of which were red. I did look at all the pictures and listened to each person's story of the investigation (most of the people that went on the investigation were hobby hunters and were not very objective). So when the rest of the group left, I sat down with the lead investigator and went over the pictures while asking questions. I noticed that most of the orbs were dust but there were some shadows that were out of place. From what I could tell the orbs that were red were from the redeye light that some cameras have or from a laser thermometer that they were using to take temperature readings. Then I saw something that caught my eye - there were red spots on some of the pictures that were taken outside/outdoors. The lead investigator took several pictures that had these spots. They were not orbs and always appeared in twos. I asked questions about the area outside and could find no natural or manmade reason for the red dots. The investigator did not even notice the dots until I pointed them out. There were other pictures of the same area taken at a different time and the dots were not evident.

The lead investigator said that the lady (client) that had originally contacted her was calling her every day for information asking when the team would come back out to the site. We discussed the psychology of the lady and decided that she was not mentally 'stable' and that it would not be a good idea to go back out there. The lead investigator received a call from the lady before I left and I did hear the lead investigator say that she would send a copy of the pictures but that the team would not be coming back out to the site. The lead investigator had a hard time getting off the phone and said the lady did go a little 'psycho.' We called it a night and I went home.

The next day the investigator called me and said that she had a tough night with bad dreams about the lady and that lady had called an additional two times. I advised the investigator to tell the lady that if necessary a harassment complaint would be filed if she did not quit calling the agency.



The investigator said that she did ask the lady if she had seen the red dots before. She said that the lady got upset again and then asked who in the group had seen them. The investigator advised her that she had shown me the pictures but that I had not visited the site. The lady wanted to talk to me but the investigator advised her that she was the contact person for the group and it would not be OK to call me.

That night after we had talked, I had some bad dreams about the area that I had seen in the pictures. The red dots were not dots but eyes and they followed me everywhere I went and I felt very threatened. I awoke from the dream with the feeling that someone was in my room at the foot of my bed. I tried to turn and look to see who it was but I could not move - I could move my eyes but I could not move my body. Then I felt a pressure like something was on top of me trying to push me through the bed. I could not speak but I was still breathing and could only scream in my mind. The pressure changed from holding me down - it seemed to get colder and smaller and was trying to get inside me. I could tell that I could not stop this by myself; it was like I could tell by the way it was starting to feel that my willpower was not enough. Just my telling it to stop was not going to work so I started to pray and ask for Divine help.

As soon as I started doing this, the feeling of cold stopped and turned into a feeling of pressure and then it was off me and I could move again. I sat up looking around my room and could see a shadow that was in the corner of the room where there was nothing to make the shadow. So I continued to pray and called for it to leave and to never return but now that I could move I said it out loud. I got out of bed and again in prayer demanded it to leave and never return. Then the shadow just faded away and the feeling in the room became more angelic. I turned on some light and looked at the clock and it was 3:05 am,\* so I then got out my sage and smudged the room before I went back to bed. I did not turn off all the lights and did not go to sleep right away. I did not wake up till late morning feeling sore and drained.

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I called the lead investigator later that day to see how the team was doing; they said that they all had a tough night with nightmares. I told them of my experience and said they should do a clearing also just like I was going to do and that any equipment that they had used on the site should be cleared also. I did my clearing and did not have any other problems but the lead investigator had many different problems even after the clearing. I think that they were still having problems because the lady from the site continued to call the investigator.

Sometime later that year, I was talking to one of my personal spiritual mentors about the incident. My mentor believed that one of my guides or Angels kept me from going on the investigation because of what was there. My mentor thought that there were evil entities on the site and that because of the nature of the clearings that I had to do that it would have been bad to have gone there with the team. It would have caused more problems than actually happened and that the investigator's problems continued because of the contact with the lady. After talking with my mentor and doing some reading I came to believe that my mystery illness that morning before the investigation was to keep me at home. So my guides or Angel were trying to protect me from whatever was out at the site. It was my own continued involvement in the investigation after the fact that caused the attack. It is important to have protection when dealing with the supernatural and it is important to remember that the paranormal is not always 'Casper the friendly ghost' but something that may want to cause harm."

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### Moon Phases and the Paranormal

Did you know that the energy connected to paranormal events is often connected to the phase of the Moon?

NEW MOON: (0-45 degrees ahead of Sun): Occult energies may be impulsive, and aggressive, wanting "attention." There is a "reach out and touch response" where investigators sometimes feel a brush, tickle, or pressure from unknown sources.

BLACK MOON: (Second NEW MOON in the course of a single calendar month): Highly occult energy that opens a portal to other dimensions including everything from the Faerie Kingdom to the Realm of the Ascended Masters as well as the spectral world. Altered states of awareness and higher consciousness are present.

CRESCENT MOON: (45-90 degrees ahead of Sun): Occult energies may seem to occur in "slow motion" because they are subject to a lack of momentum.

FIRST QUARTER MOON: (90-135 degrees ahead of Sun): Occult energies are "challenging" and looking for a "power-up."

GIBBOUS MOON: (135-180 degrees ahead of Sun): Occult energies are strong, moving toward full response and very perceivable.

FULL MOON: (180-135 degrees behind Sun): Occult energies are in "full" response and a variety of conditions are possible. The most powerful occult situations occur during the Full Moon.

DISSEMINATING MOON: (135-190 behind Sun): Occult energies are "perceivable" but may be hard to pin down.

THIRD QUARTER MOON: (90-45 degrees behind Sun): Occult energies will try to "alienate" or hide themselves from the environment and contact although they are still perceivable.

BALSAMIC MOON: (45-0 degrees behind Sun): Occult energies are not in full response and may show up erratically in a teasing fashion. A variety of conditions are possible.



ARIES: Spirits can be temperamental, angry or boisterous such as in poltergiest attack. Physical harm can come to investigators.

TAURUS: Spirits will hold their ground and may force expulsion or not allow entry. ("Get Out!")

GEMINI: Spirits are communicative-good for detection of messages by EVP or spirit to light meter response.

CANCER: Spirit activity is tied to residual emotion. Spirits might respond to mediums they feel are understanding.

LEO: Spirit activity can be playful or pushy. Full spectromatic color or tones may be visible in manifestation. Restored scenes can play out like a motion picture.

I found out the next day that my friend who dared me had some weird stuff happen to him too. No one else had anything happen to them. This lasted for about four days and we think it is because of what we did. One night I just said out loud that I was sorry and all the weird stuff stopped. What was this and is it over? ### **RESPONSE:**

Ryan, the good news is you're not alone in your experience and in most of the cases of this type, it does not last very long. This would be different if there was desecration or disrespect for the graves or anything in the graveyard. Some would say that the act of lying on a grave is disrespectful but the way you described the event it sounds more like you had a "hitchhiker." Some spirits or entities are attracted to the energy or presence of some people and will "attach" to them for a short time. This is all according to the strength of the spirit or entity which dictates how long they stay with no action on the person's part to get rid of them. The way you described what happened and your actions, I do not believe this to be an evil or malevolent spirit entity. You may be one of the people who attracts spirits or entities due to your energy and may have to take some steps to keep this or something worse from happening in the future. If you have future problems of this nature, feel free to request procedural information.

### **QUERY:**

### **RESPONSE:**

### Don't Step on a Crack - Superstitions

Superstitions have always been a part of culture. We find them humorous and at times even scary. What compels people to believe in them and act upon them?

For many people, engaging with superstitious behaviors provides a sense of control and reduces anxiety—which is why levels of superstition increase at times of stress and angst.

Although there is no single definition of superstition, it generally means a belief in supernatural forces—such as fate—the desire to influence unpredictable factors and a need to resolve uncertainty. In this way then, individual beliefs and experiences drive superstitions, which explains why they are generally irrational and often defy current scientific wisdom.

Superstitions have different connotations – some based in religion, others in folklore and still others in practical origins.

### Examining superstition:

It is bad luck to walk under a ladder: A leaning ladder forms a triangle with the wall and ground. Triangles represent the Holy Trinity, and violating the Trinity by breaking it (walking through it) would put you in league with the devil himself. Considering what Christians did to those who were considered to be in league with the devil, it's hardly surprising that leaning ladders were avoided at all cost.



**Friday the Thirteenth**: The idea that this day would bring bad luck has its roots in both Norse and Christian beliefs. The Scandinavian's believed that the number 13 was unlucky due to the mythological 12 demigods being joined by a 13th, an evil one, who brought misfortune upon humans. Christ was said to have been crucified on Friday and the number of guests at the party of the Last Supper was 13, with the 13th guest being Judas, the traitor.

God Bless You: The blessing of those who sneeze started when the great plague took hold of Europe. Sufferers began sneezing violently, and as such, were bound to die. The Pope therefore passed a law requiring people to bless the sneezer. At the same time, it was expected that anybody sneezing would cover their mouth with a cloth or their hand. This was obviously to stop the spreading of the disease, but many believed that it was to keep the soul intact. Sneezing 'into the air' would allow the soul to escape and death would be imminent. Up until this time, the opposite was true. Those who sneezed were congratulated as it was believed that a violent sneeze would expel evil from their bodies.

**Black Cats**: In ancient Egypt, the Goddess Bast was a black, female cat. Christians, wanting to rid society of all traces of other religions, convinced the ignorant that black cats were demons in disguise and should thus be destroyed. In the process, they also destroyed the kindly ladies who cared for the cats, believing them to be witches. Being demons, a black cat crossing your path would create a barrier of evil, cutting you off from God and blocking the entrance to heaven.

**Spilling Salt**: Salt was, during the middle ages, a very expensive commodity used mainly for medicinal purposes. For this reason, spillage was to be avoided at all costs. The idea that it is unlucky to do so probably stems from the belief that Judas spilt salt during the last supper. Throwing spilt salt over the left shoulder is linked to its medicinal use. If it could not be administered, the next best thing was to throw it into the eye of the evil spirits that brought sickness upon us. These spirits were thought to lurk behind your shoulder, waiting for an opportunity to strike.



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**Fingers Crossed**: This is probably the superstition that is most widely used today. By making the sign of the Christian faith with our fingers, evil spirits would be prevented from destroying our chances of good fortune.

**Knock on Wood**: This goes back to the days before Christianity made its entrance. It was believed that good spirits lived in trees, and that by knocking on anything made from wood, we could call upon these spirits for protection against misfortune

### More Superstitions

ACORN - Carrying an acorn on your person will ensure good luck & longevity!

APPLE - You have to eat at least 1 apple every day to guard against ill-health, an apple a day, keeps the doctor away! "

BED - You must never put a hat on a bed. Also you must get out of bed the same side you got in otherwise you bring bad luck upon yourself!

BEE - If a bee flies into your home then you will get a visitor, but if you kill the bee then the visitor will turn nasty!



BIRD - If a bird flies into your home then it is an omen of death!

BRIDGE - If you want to see a friend again, then don't ever say goodbye to them on a bridge!

BROOM - Never take a broom with you when moving house - buy a new one!

CAT - If a black cat walks towards you then it brings very good luck to you - but if it walks away from you, then it takes its good luck with it!

CHEEKS - If all of a sudden your cheeks feel as if they're burning, then someone, somewhere is flattering you!

### The History of Crystal Gazing

Crystal gazing was once thought to be a branch of magic but now is generally accepted as an important phase of experimental psychology. History and romance, ancient and modern, contains many interesting legends and stories about magic mirrors and magic crystals. Some date back to the Greece of the 4<sup>th</sup> century B.C. The practice was traced among the natives of North and South America, Asia, Australia and Africa. In all countries, the crystal was used for the purpose of divination and the process usually explained as the result of Spirit, Angel or Devil. Those who visited India know of the use made of the round mass of roughhewn, polished glass and the superstitious awe with which it is regarded.



In former days, the High Priest of the Buddhist or Hindu temples, when attired in the consecrated robes for festive ceremonies, wore one or more small crystals of dazzling brilliancy suspended from his neck on a chain of great value. It was believed that through their power he was able to commune with the Spirit or Spirits to whom he and his followers showed great reverence and to whom they interceded for solutions to their problems. The crystal served much as the famous oracle of Apollo at Delphi, which is said to have given responses in answer to inquiries of worshippers.

Among the Ancients, the Seer muttered certain prayers over the crystal and then gave it into the hands of a youth or virgin. They taught the importance of purity. When crystal gazing or any occult ceremony was performed, young boys and girls were employed in divination, as no others were deemed pure enough for spiritual revelations. In instances of crystal gazing, particularly, it was they who read in the brilliant ball of glass the answers to questions asked, usually conveyed by means of written characters on the crystal. Sometimes, the Spirits called upon were supposed to appear in the crystal and respond to questions put to them.

Many savage races gazed into the water's depth or any clear depth to foresee distant events for enlightenment on immediate problems. In bygone days the ceremony of crystal gazing for divination purposes was elaborate and spectacular, including Lamen or Holy Table, the use of swords, wax candles in highly polished gilt or brass candle sticks, compasses, and many other accompaniments identified with magical functions.

These rites were performed by priests or other personally trained by those who understood the invisible forces of the world unseen. They resorted to frequent washing and prayers three to four days prior to consulting the crystal.

They sought its help, counsel or advice most generally when the Moon was in increase going toward full. Every preparation for gazing was made when the Moon was increasing. The room and everything pertaining to the ceremony was immaculately clean and void of anything likely to disturb or detract attention. The object then was to bring the actual presence in the crystal of certain Spirits and to evoke from them answers to questions presented to them. Nowadays, we use the crystal, or any other medium for that matter to develop the clairvoyant power of the individual gazer. Through it he is brought into the world of the unseen.

The word crystal is derived from the Greek meaning "clear ice" or "frozen water." As early as the 4<sup>th</sup> century B.C., the Greeks supposed it to be a hard substance from frozen water. This belief persisted until the end of the sixteenth century, when the name crystal was applied only to ordinary quartz or rock crystal. Later, it was more generally applied to "any symmetrically formed mineral, solid, transparent or opaque, contained or bounded by plane surfaces." Its smooth, even surfaces were noted by the ancients but were regarded as accidents or as "pleasing to the gods."

Crystals are distinguished from other bodies by the sameness of internal structure. Their physical properties are the same in parallel directions and are generally different in direction not parallel. Globes or eggs for crystal gazing purposes can be made of beryl, rock crystal or glass. There is no such thing as genuine "rock crystal" although quartz glass is frequently referred to as "rock crystal." The few specimens of real rock crystal in the world are priceless. An irregular mass of some three inches in diameter is valued upwards of twenty five thousand dollars, and the only piece in existence of that size is in a museum.



Real rock crystal means a piece of glass formed by volcanic action. Commercially there is a term "rock crystal" applied to exceptionally clear glass – but it is still artificial glass, no more or less. The Ancients sought to use crystal only when the Moon was on its increase, so it seems logical to conclude that a strong link between the crystal and the spirit world is magnetism. Continued...

This magnetism is attracted to and is in the crystal because of its iron properties. Many authorities advanced the theory that the greater the increase of the Moon, the greater the supply of the Moon's magnetism in the crystal. In Astrology, crystals are said to be influenced by the Moon as are the intuitive powers of mind and brain.

Visions in crystals may be classified as follows:

- 1. Images of something unconsciously observed. New reproduction, voluntary or spontaneous, and bringing no fresh knowledge to the mind.
- 2. Images of ideas unconsciously acquired from others by telepathy or otherwise. Some memory or imaginative effect which does not come from the gazer's ordinary self. Revivals of memory. Illustrations of thought.



3. Images, clairvoyant or prophetic. Pictures bringing information as to something past, present or future which the gazer has no other chance of knowing.

Many cultures consider crows to be the keepers of the Sacred Law, for nothing escapes their keen sight. Crow medicine signifies a firsthand knowledge of a higher order of right and wrong than that indicated by the laws created in human culture.

"Native Americans had great respect for this bird. Several southwestern tribes heralded the Raven as the bringer of light that escaped from the darkness of the cosmos. Thus, they associate this bird with creation because it brought light where there was none. Other tribes looked upon this bird as a trickster or even a shape-shifter because of its high intelligence and ability to adapt to different situations."

The relationship with war and death also underlies the crow's connection to the Otherworld. The crow is sometimes perceived as a harbinger of death as well. The Scots have a term for death: "going away up the Crow Road." In Hindu belief, crows serve as intermediaries who bring offerings of food and water to deceased ancestors on the anniversary of the relative's death, a practice of expressing gratitude known as 'Sr-addha. In ancient Egypt, however, the crow was a symbol of faithful love because of the bird's monogamous nature. <sup>2</sup>

"Greeks pegged the crow as a white bird initially. But the white crow gave Apollo (Greek god of prophecy, healing and much more) some bad news and Apollo turned it black as a mark of displeasure. From that day on, the crow kept her secrets to herself in an effort to protect her brood, and her knowledge.



The Latin term "Corvid" identifies the crow family. This word is derived, in part, from the word "cunning". This is oh-so-true with the crow. These birds have been known to outsmart other birds, many animals, and even more humans at times. They are masters at tactical maneuvers, and cunning is definitely the name of their game.

The crow is associated with many a god and goddess. Research it, and you'll discover that's true. Morrigan, Shani, Odin, Badb...these and more deities are aligned with the crow. In my studies, it's rare to have a creature shared by so many deities. Why is that? My guess is the power of the crow. There's something majestic and magnetic about the crow that temps a god or goddess to affiliate themselves with this bird.

The crow can be monogamous (having one partner), but this isn't always the case. The Egyptians noticed their tendency to keep one mate and deemed this bird as a symbol of devotion and faithfulness.

Chinese Lore places the crow on a throne of masculine rule. In ancient Asian legend, the crow was said to be the father of the Asian race. As a result, the crow is respected and given great devotion (at least it was back in the day) as the parent of humankind." – Avia (http://www.whats-your-sign.com).

A number of verses appear in American and European folklore to describe the crow's influence. In North America, "Crow on the fence, rain will go hence" is an often cited expression. In Maryland the following verse is found:

One crow--sorrow
Two crows--mirth
Three crows--wedding
Four crows--birth
The English version is as follows:
One bad luck
Two luck
Three health



Four wealth
Five sickness
And six is death
Still another version goes like this:
One means anger
Two means mirth
Three a wedding
Four a birth
Five is heaven
Six is hell
But seven is the Devil's ownself.



## Life and Death

We are truly infinite beings whose mode of existence goes through many transformations with death and a new incarnation all part of a greater cycle. How is this determined from an astrological lens?

The actual death or final shut down of the body or physical form is announced by Saturn since the body is the structure which houses the soul/spirit. Pluto then takes charge to shut down the mental processes. This makes sense since as humans we are governed by our thoughts and our capacity for understanding in other words, the mind must understand that the physical vehicle of the body can no longer house the control panel or brain. The silver chord that attaches the soul/spirit to the body is governed by Neptune so it is the job of Neptune to sever the silver chord so the soul/spirit can be released. In a near death experience, the soul/spirit leaves the body but is still attached by the silver chord. The circumstances surrounding one's demise are described by the activity in the 4<sup>th</sup> house of the chart and the type of death is described by the 8<sup>th</sup> house which is considered the Gate of Death.

The Imum Colei or IC is the most hidden point in a chart. It lies at the cusp of the 4<sup>th</sup> house. It is believed to be the place where we experience our connection to the Universe. Our cell memory lies here as does our understanding that we are all a part of creation and the collective. This is the point associated with endings and beginnings where we finish a "life term" and begin another. It is the point where the soul enters the physical body. The Soul Essence can be gleaned from the sign on the North Angle and from any planets that are in "applying" conjunct aspect (one degree or less) to the North Angle.

If a Mutable sign, Gemini, Virgo, or Sagittarius occupies the 4th House cusp, the individual will approach basic needs with adaptability. Life is a continuing series of impacts because he/she is easily influenced by others and the environment.

A Fixed sign, Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, or Aquarius occupying the 4th House Cusp signifies a life of testing, purging and cleansing. These individuals are subject to quiet periods interrupted by sudden upsets. These will either be initiated by the individual or come from outside influences. How much the individual suffers these experiences depends upon how much information they need to move forward.

A Cardinal sign, Aries, Cancer, Libra or Capricorn on the 4th House cusp indicates a spiritual warrior who views the lessons of the current lifetime as an initiation in moving closer to Source or God. These individuals will be a constant state of flux and movement intellectually.

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Planets conjunct the Imum Colei by applying aspect from the 3rd House at birth relate to additional gifts brought in through the spirit.

They will need to overcome material hurdles in order to bring the total sum of self-expression to fruition since there is a strong need for distinction in some area of life. The Sun connected to this point signifies intellectual brilliance and a desire to investigate new things.
