The Straw that Broke the Camel's back

The “*straw that broke the camel's back*” means an action or conversation that causes a person to reach their breaking point. It describes an inflection point and causes a change, either in the situation or in the person's behavior. *

Ever use the expression “the straw that broke the camel's back” or a similar idiom when referring to an incident that pushes an ongoing situation too far across a line of tolerance? Many of us have likely encountered situations in which something that is baneful to us triggers off a noxious outcome. At this point we may blurt out words we cannot take back or otherwise react in ways that leave some sort of damage. In some cases, the damage is unfortunately permanent because who do these arrogant holier than thou bastards think they are in the first place?

According to [Wikipedia](#), the straw that broke the camel's back is from an Arabic proverb about “how a camel is loaded beyond its capacity to move or stand”. It is a “reference to any process by which cataclysmic failure (a broken back) is achieved by a seemingly inconsequential addition, a single straw. This also gives rise to the phrase ‘the last/final straw’, used when something is deemed to be the last in a line of unacceptable occurrences.” A similar proverb is “the drop that makes the cup overflow”. **

You can use the phrase “the straw that broke the camel's back when you're trying to describe a tipping point. It defines a situation where you're letting someone know that you are about to react to their repeated bad behavior towards you or other people.

The straw that broke the camel's back is the final action by another person or entity that sparks the conflagration of the reaction.*

If you care to contemplate the situation and examine motivations of yourself and the other party, ask yourself the following:

- What is the situation? What was the “straw that broke the camel’s back” for you in that interaction?
- What more specifically made that the breaking point?
- How did you react?
- What happened as a consequence?
- What sorts of things had built up for you and between you and the other party that resulted in that outcome? Is it describing the final bad action by your partner that causes you to leave them?
- At what point may it have been advantageous for you to save the straw from being the one- more-time or one-last-thing in the situation?
- What could you have done at that time?
- What stopped you from doing or saying that?
- When you have observed “the straw that broke the camel’s back” for someone else, how would you describe what occurred?
- What do you think has to happen in the future to prevent the camel’s back from breaking? **

It is very important for all people to have boundaries and to let others know what they are. Some people you encounter in life don't respect boundaries and consistently trespass and transgress thinking they know what's best for you. That's narcissistic behavior at its worst.

Boundary violators are not only disrespectful, they are downright creepy and often evil. They may deny that they said or told you something and then question your sanity. They may even tell you that you needed to hear it. -Ask yourself "really?" What you need to do is listen to your inner warning system and remove that individual from your life. Their only purpose is to use you for their own satisfaction of ego.

I've learned.... That life is like a roll of toilet paper. The closer it gets to the end, the faster it goes.

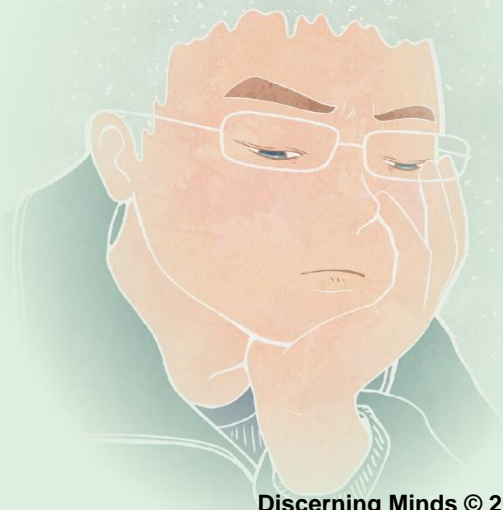
I've learned.... That we should be glad God doesn't give us everything we ask for.

“It’s time to put the four horsemen of the Apocalypse out to pasture.”

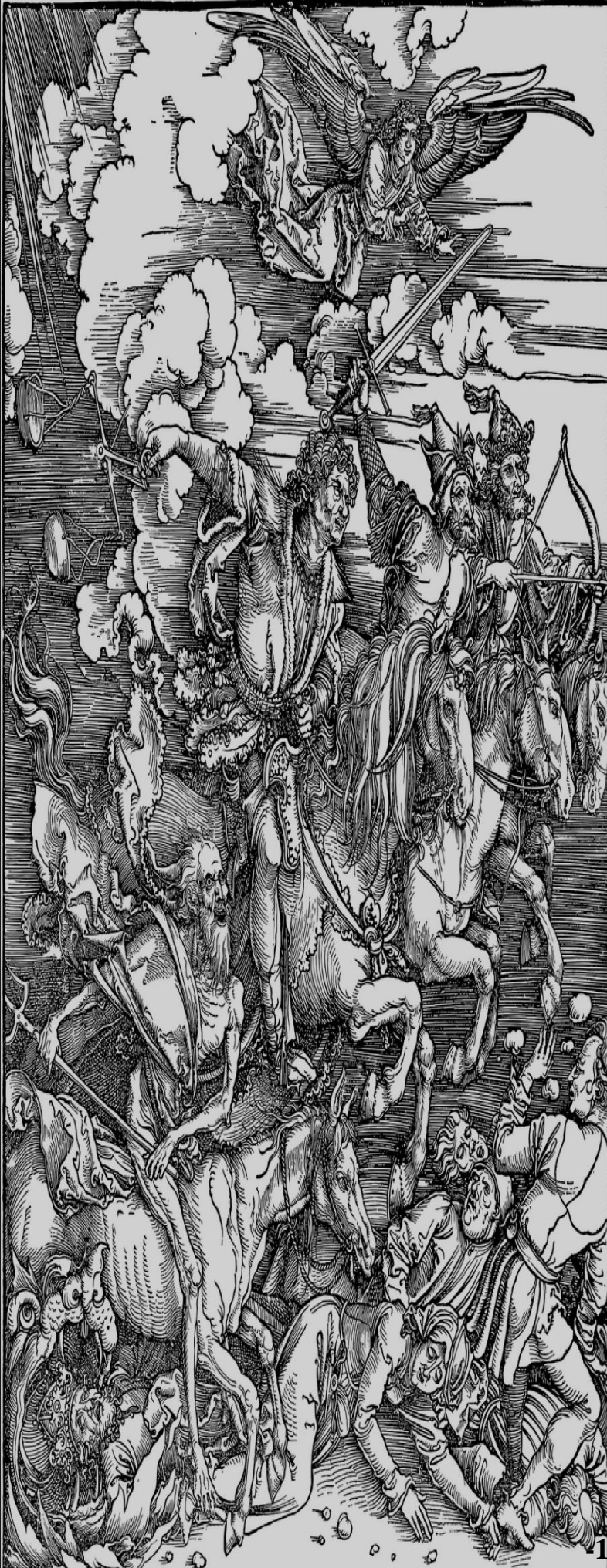
New Agers counted off the days until the Mayan calendar ended in 2012. Evangelical Christians look for the Antichrist and long for the Rapture. Extropians dream of the Singularity, when super-intelligent computers will abolish all human limits to progress. Doomers stockpile freeze-dried food as they wait for civilization to crash and burn. Why are we waiting for Armageddon be it a spiritual or physical event?

If there’s one thing I’ve learned about Druids, it’s that they certainly don’t think like the average bear.

“When the seventh seal was opened, says the Book of Revelation, “there was silence in heaven for the space of half an hour.” In a very real sense, that brief interval of expectation in total silence sums up the whole history of the Apocalypse meme. For more than three thousand years now, people have managed to convince themselves that their world was teetering on the brink of total transformation, that their enemies were about to be annihilated and their fondest hopes fulfilled by a shattering event that would change the nature of reality itself. **FOR MORE THAN THREE THOUSAND YEARS**, they have waited in breathless anticipation, moment by moment, for “The great change to manifest.” - Grand Archdruid John Michael Greer AODA

During these three thousand years, apocalypse prophecies and “theories” have convinced people all over the world that the future will provide them with the world they “want” instead of the world “have.” Does anyone ever notice that these doomsday, end of world, vision of Utopia prophecies and theories that have found a niche in the various forms of communication and media throughout every age have one major feature in common? Every one of them has been wrong. Yet we still persist ...

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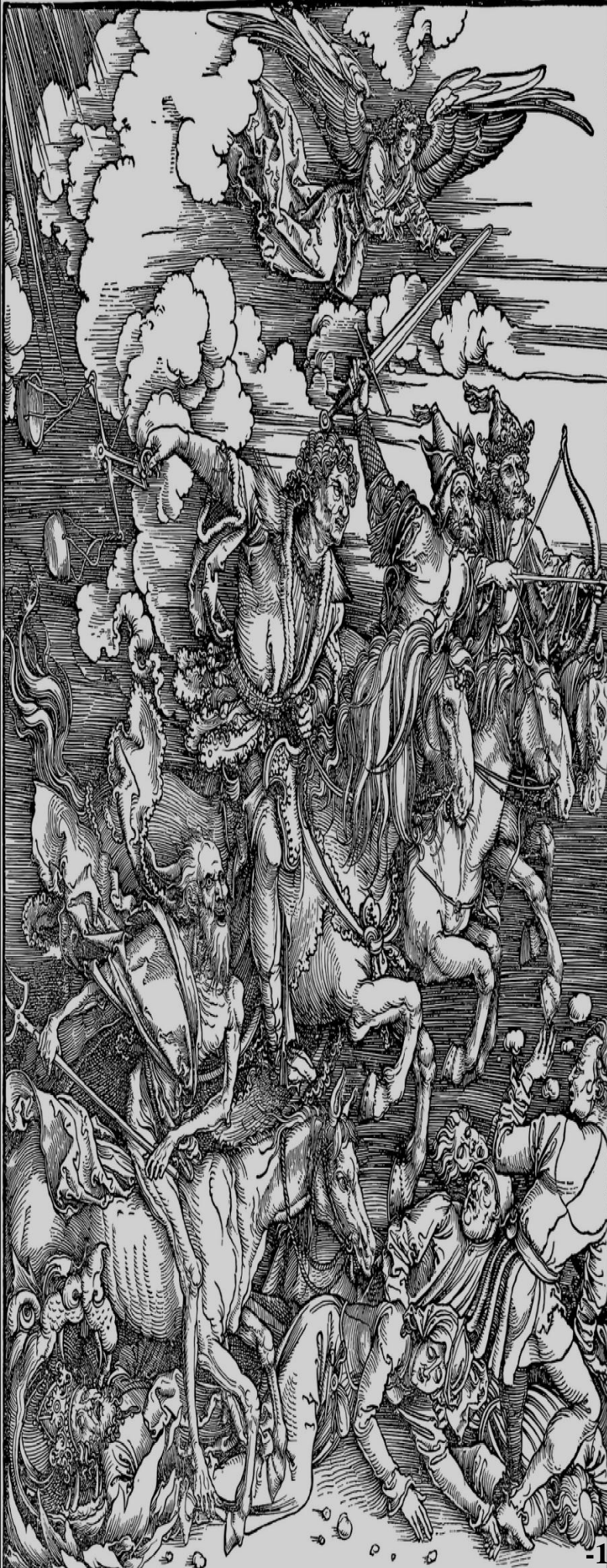
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I sense some fidgeting in the audience and a few struck chords of indignation so let's pursue this a little further. How did humankind get on this track? Why are we drawn to these dismal tapestries of woven conjecture postulated as "absolute?" According to Greer: "A strong case could be made for the idea that storytelling is one of humanity's oldest and most powerful technologies. As soon as the extraordinary of human language finished emerging out of what-ever forgotten precursors gave it birth, hunters back from the chase and gatherers returning with nuts and tubers doubtless started describing their day's experiences in colorful terms, and their listeners picked up more than useful tips about how to track an antelope or wield a doffing stick: the glory of the impala's leap and the comfortable fellowship of gatherers working a meadow together wove themselves into the stories and minds of the audience, and helped shape their experience of the world."

OK. So, basically, we like to amuse ourselves to the point where we have lost ourselves in our own BS. According to Greer's research, the Apocalypse meme found its origins between 1500 and 1200 BCE, birthed in Persian Zoroastrianism and Zarathustra's first assertion that the world would end in a battle between the forces of the good god and his evil opponent. Since a meme is an idea or set of ideas which is transmitted from person to person until it becomes widespread and persists through time, it follows the same natural laws as biological evolution – it grows and transmutes itself to adapt to time and environment. 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So, a few of you more logical types out there are saying, ‘Well, what about science and the natural death of the species?’

“Someday far in the future—about four billion years from now, according to current astrophysical theory—the core of the Sun will have burnt enough of its hydrogen fuel that it can no longer counter the pressure of its own gravity. As it gradually collapses inwards, over the next two billion years, the Sun will balloon into a red giant, a hundred times larger than it is today, and any life that happens to remain on Earth at that distant date will be crisped by daytime temperatures that will peak somewhere around 2600° F.

A quarter million years or so later, the Sun’s core will pass a critical threshold and start fusing helium; the resulting “helium flash” will blast a third of the Sun’s mass into deep space in a matter of minutes. In all probability, whatever charred cinder remains of the Earth at that point will be blown to smithereens by that blast, and its fragments will be scattered back into the interstellar dust from which it formed some ten billion years before.

Countless millions of years before that happens, it’s a safe bet that humanity will have gone extinct. The average species, according to the few available rough estimates, lasts for about a million years, and our species, *Homo sapiens*, has existed for around two hundred thousand years, or some- thing like a fifth of that theoretical span; the average genus, again according to a rough estimate, lasts for about ten million years, and our genus, *Homo*, has been around for maybe a quarter of that. All of recorded history amounts to five thousand years so far, so if our species has an average lifespan and maintains written records from now on, we have compiled a little more than half of one percent of our ultimate written history. Still, one way or another, the time will doubtless come when the last human beings die out, possibly to be replaced after a time by some other intelligent species, perhaps not.

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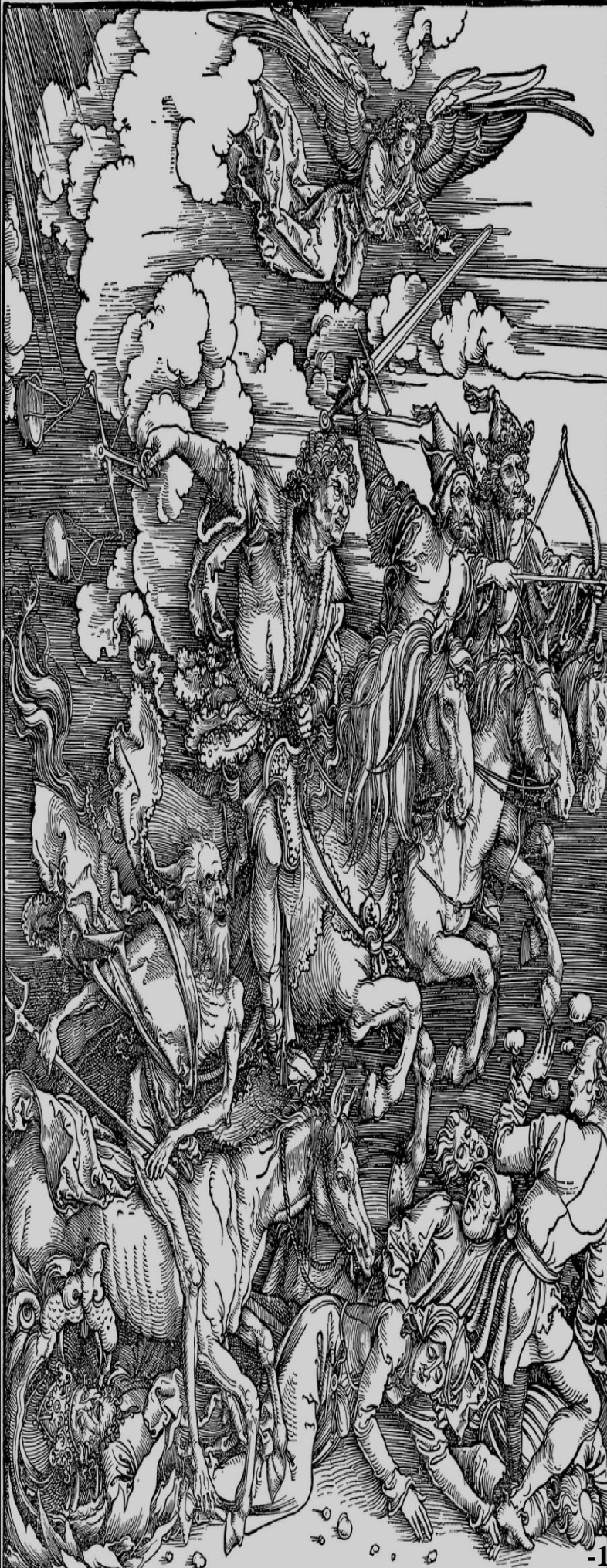
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Much closer to our own time, in all probability, our current civilization will have joined the long list of human societies that overshot their resource base and ended up as one more addition to history's compost heap. One common fantasy these days insists that contemporary industrial civilization has nothing in common with the civilizations of the past, and thus can expect to soar endlessly upwards to some date with destiny out there among the stars; another common fantasy insists with equal fervor that contemporary industrial civilization is poised on the brink of cataclysm and will shortly and suddenly be annihilated for its sins. Both of these fantasies come straight out of the apocalypse meme, one by way of Joachim of Fiore and the Marquis de Condorcet, the other by way of secular re-hashings of the standard Christian apocalyptic myth, and both can therefore be discounted. It's far more likely that future generations will visit the crumbling remains of today's urban centers the way we visit the ruined cities of Egypt and the ancient Mayans, and scholars of that distant time will argue with one another about the reasons why the ancient Americans traced out the same course of political dysfunction, economic decline, and eventual technological collapse as so many other civilizations before—and, no doubt, since." One half of one percent of our ultimate written history ... hhhmmmm. Well – not worrying about this for this lifetime.

Since the Mayan Calendar and 2012 is still considered a relatively hot topic ... "The Mayan calendar has many different cycles. One of them rolls over on that date, but there's only one brief reference to the date anywhere in the ancient Mayan inscriptions, it says nothing about an apocalypse, and there are dates in the Mayan inscriptions predicting events many thousands of years into the future after it. The notion that the some kind of end time scenario would happen then was invented out of whole cloth by the late Jose Arguelles, with some help from 60s psychedelic guru Terence McKenna, and it's frankly about as believable as Harold Camping's Rapture predictions.

That won't keep hundreds of thousands, maybe millions, of people from expecting the end on that date, or from suffering the usual disappointments afterwards."

Greer explains that now, when we can read "over ninety-five percent of all Mayan texts" we can find only one mention of the date December 12, 2012, which in Mayan is 4 Ahau 3 Kankin 13.0.0.0. Greer describes this as "one passing reference on one stela at one minor Mayan site" (recently, Mexican experts revealed that there is another reference to the date, but interpretations vary on whether it refers to the past or future, and experts decry modern interpretations that they describe as having "twisted the cosmovision of ancient civilizations like the Maya").

Saucy fellow this Greer aye? Some of you might be saying "Har-umph! Well, of course we are not going to be annihilated BUT we are going to have a tremendous shift in ... WHAT?!" Well let's hope we have *something* ... with or without a **date**. For a work of change to take on a life of its own, it must come from a positive spiritually based conception to be conceived and crafted.

What about increased UFO sightings connected to "end times" beliefs? Before reading this section, note that this excerpt has nothing to do with abduction phenomena and experiences. "The UFO Phenomenon, is that the phenomenon was largely created and is still managed by the Air Force as protective camouflage for whatever the current secret aerospace technology happens to be. In 1947 it was high altitude balloons, in the 1950s it was the U-2, in the 1960s it was the SR-71 and early spy satellites, and so on. If UFO sightings are on the increase, it's a safe bet that in ten or fifteen years, we'll find out that the Air Force was testing some new technology right about now. It's interesting, but it's not especially relevant to end times claims."

Seeking a Savior

There are actually in total 15 pre-Christian Gods that have traits and stories exactly like *Jesus Christ*.

For example, In 900 BC Krishna was born of a virgin with a star in the East signaling his coming. A tyrant slaughtered thousands of infants trying to kill the new born king. He was a teacher in the temple and a healer who performed miracles, was crucified between two thieves and resurrected from death. Mithra's birthday on December 25, close to the winter solstice, became Jesus's birthday. Shepherds were to have witnessed Mithra's birth and were to have partaken in a last supper with Mithra before he returned to heaven. Mithra's ascension, correlating to the sun's return to prominence around the spring equinox, became the Christian holiday of Easter.



Colors for Life

The word *color* or *colour* is derived from the Latin *celare* which means “to conceal.” Hue, a synonym for color has its meaning in old English *hiw*, meaning form or appearance. In our earthly experience color is universal and is the most descriptive of the human condition. Are you feeling blue today? Are you green with envy? Did you get angry and see red?

What of the actual visual effect or color? There have been many documented cases of experiments with color and behavior. For example, in an air conditioned factory that had a steady temperature of 72 ° many employees complained of feeling cold. Some even put on jackets even when the temperature was raised to 75°. A color consultant suggested that the walls be painted orange. After that was done the employees complained the 75° temperature was too high. Once the temperature was reduced back to 72°, everyone was happy. In another example showing how a switch from black and white visuals to color visuals affects memory retention, a US college professor found that when he substituted green slides for black and white, test scores rose as much as 40%. Further, red and green slides produced scores twice as high and black and white and red and green on a blue background increased scores by 30%.

Everything that exists may be expressed in terms of color, since color is just another name to describe energy or spirit from which everything is composed. ~ Zolar

The Ancient Mind conceived of everything in the world as consisting of the four elements earth, air, fire and water. Earth was said to be blue, air, yellow; fire, red; water, green. Ancient civilizations assigned colors to their various gods and goddesses. For example in Ancient Egypt, Osiris was green; Horus, white; Set, black; Isis had a garment of many colors. In Hinduism, Brahma is often represented as red or golden; Vishnu is clad in yellow; Shiva, the destroyer is black. The Druids of Britain and Gaul wore colored garments according to division - The Ovate wore green (the color of instruction and learning); the Bard wore blue (symbolizing harmony and truth); those of high stature the Ministers, wore white (symbolizing the purity of the sun). These three colors, green, blue and white, are the exact same designations used by the Greeks in reference to Atlantis. (Could Atlantis be more than a myth and could these colors suggest that the Druids were descended from migrated Atlanteans?) For the Ancient Hebrews, the colors red, blue, purple and white were all symbols of God. Sin, love and sacrifice were connected with red, glory with blue, splendor and dignity with purple and purity and joy with white.

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In primitive Christianity, the Holy Trinity is associated with blue (the father), yellow (the son) and red, the Holy Spirit. In traditional art, Christ is often portrayed wearing a purple robe symbolic of suffering and endurance before his Crucifixion. Much of Christian art also portrays the various saints in green robes with a gold or yellow nimbus surrounding their heads.

According to the Ancient Egyptians, there were four races of humans: red, yellow, black and white. Purple not brown was the color of the Earth. The floors of the temples often were painted in greens and blues symbolizing the River Nile from which all life was thought to originate. The Tibetans who viewed life from high in the mountains believed the north to be yellow, the south blue, the east white and the west red. In China, the heroic guardians assigned to compass points also had "color." Mo-li Shou, the guardian of the north has a black face, Mo-li Hung, who guards the south, a red face, Mo-li Ch'ong who guards the east, a green face and Mo-li Hai who guards the west a white face. For many Native American Tribes, the colors red, yellow and black are considered masculine while white, blue and green are feminine.

Everywhere we look in history and the development of civilizations we find consistent use of color, in some cases even unconscious use. That leads us to how color can be applied personally to our everyday lives. Most people are familiar with the idea that everything that exists in the Cosmos is made up of atoms and molecules. In the still controversial work of color investigator Dinshah P. Ghadiali many correlations have been made. Some of these refer to the human body and how and what we eat. This thinking follows unusual lines but it is very suggestive of the connection of the particular colors we surround ourselves with and even digest with the state of health. 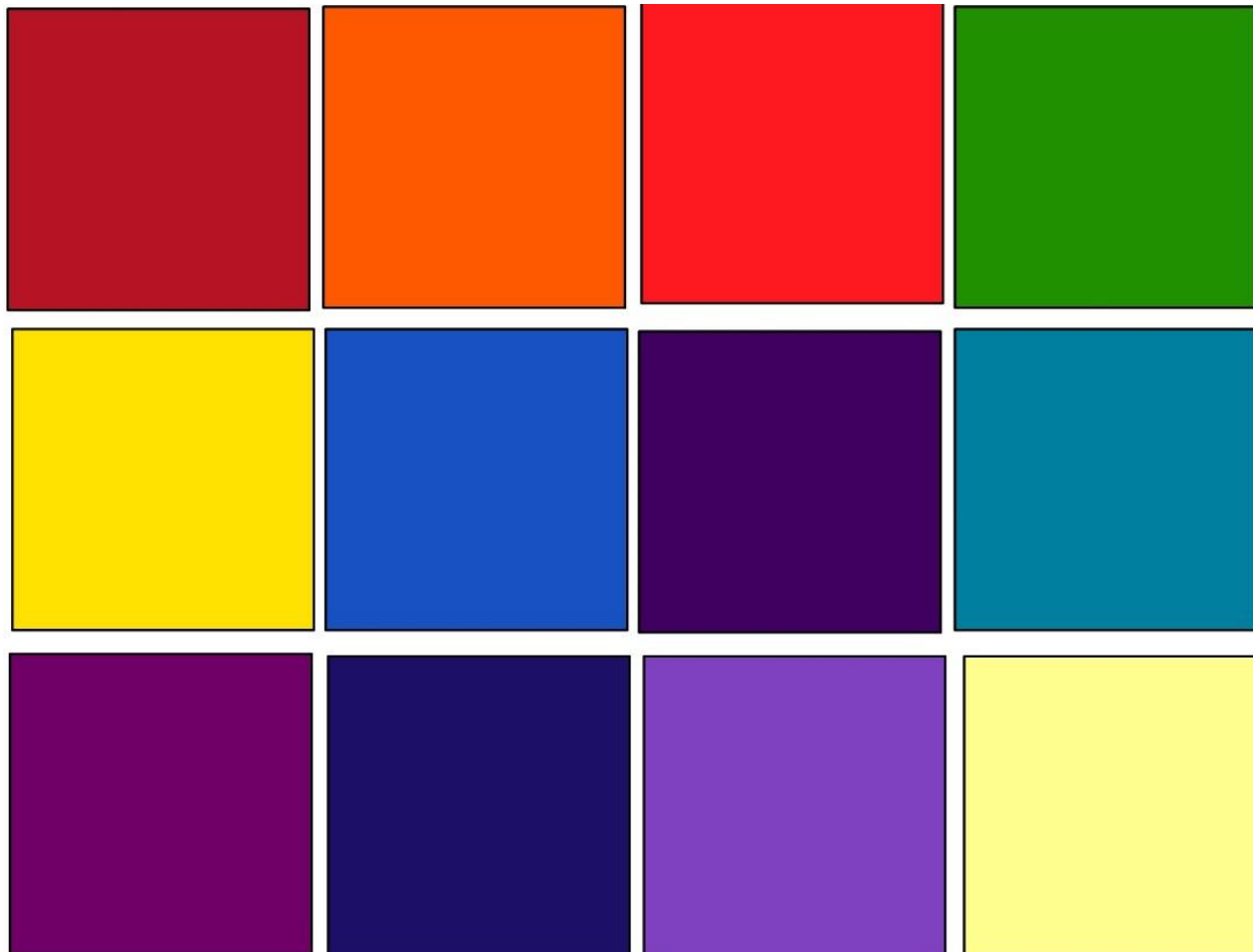

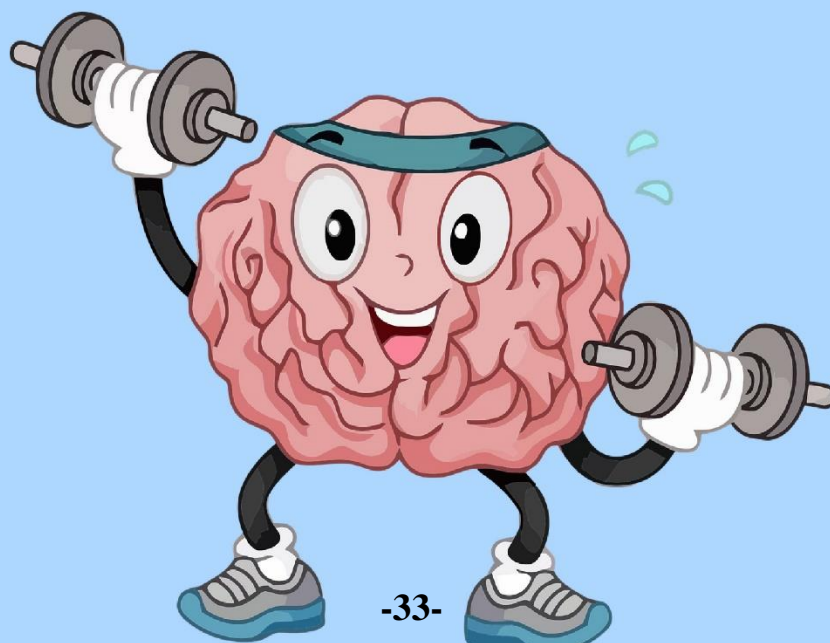



The Oxford University press dictionary states, “Leprechaun >noun (in Irish folklore) a small, mischievous sprite. -ORIGIN Old Irish luchorpán, from Lu 'small' + corp 'body’.” The name Leprechaun may actually have been derived from the Irish leath brogan (shoemaker) or the Gaelic word luacharma’n (pigmy), or any of the other Gaelic words that may or may not fit the description of a Leprechaun. The Leprechaun is a fairly ancient belief of Irish folklore, but it started out quite different than we know it today. According to many texts the ancient origins of what we know today as a Leprechaun was a Euro-Celt God named Lugh (pronounced “Luck”). Lugh was an important God to the Euro-Celtic religion, he was the great Sun God, patron of arts and crafts and the leader of the Tuath de’ Danaan, these myths eventually became simplified and popularized into the Leprechaun. They have also become the self-appointed guardians of ancient treasure (possibly left by the Danes) by burying it in crocks or pots.

In the early years of the legend it was believed that they would help humans and perform small favors for them, but they were eventually driven out by the Gaels (possibly derived from Gwyddel meaning raiders) who the Leprechaun’s would regard as foolish, flighty and greedy. This would be when the Leprechaun family spilt in two distinct groups the shoemaker pot of gold Leprechaun’s and the Culricauns.

The Culricauns are described the same as Leprechauns except for the fact that they may steal or borrow almost anything while creating mayhem in the houses during the hours of darkness, turning milk sour, raiding wine cellars and cupboards. They will also harness sheep, goats, dogs and even domestic fowl and ride them throughout the country at night.

If you’re looking for a leprechaun, they are described as being two feet tall, unfriendly and gruff dressed in old fashioned green coats with a shoemaker’s apron and a green hat. It is believed that they speak in poetry or rhymes and are often found in an intoxicated state caused by home brew poteen. They are never so intoxicated that they would have an unsteady hand with their shoe making hammer. They are said to be shoemakers for elves but only for one shoe and never a pair. Some have described them as fairy shoemakers but they are elf in nature not fairy.

In all my readings, I have never found mention of a female leprechaun; this may explain the fact why they are gruff and unfriendly. One of the most popular beliefs regarding the Leprechauns is that they possess a treasure (the pot of gold) which you could take if you could only catch one.



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If caught by a mortal, a leprechaun will promise great wealth if allowed to go free. He carries two leather pouches. In one he has a silver shilling and in the other a gold coin. The silver shilling is said to be a magical coin that returns to the pouch each time it is paid out. The gold coin is used to try to bribe his way out of difficult situations. This coin is also magical and usually turns to leaves or ash once the leprechaun has parted from being captured. It is said that you must never take your eyes off a leprechaun or he will vanish in an instant.

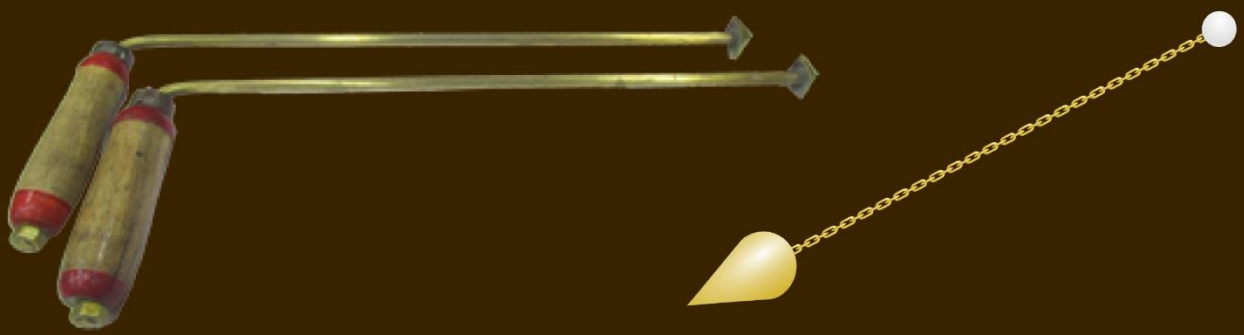
So, in your search for the solitary leprechaun you may want to follow any rainbows you come across to the end - for that is where his pot of gold is said to be

Dowsing

Dowsing has been around for thousands of years in one form or another. Some of the original forms may have been strictly for divination, like to divine the will of the gods or to foretell the future and divine the guilt of a person on trial.

For the most part the way dowsing is done today can be traced back to Germany in the 15th century where it was used to find metals. Dowsing spread to other lands as the miners traveled to foreign lands like England to mine for coal.

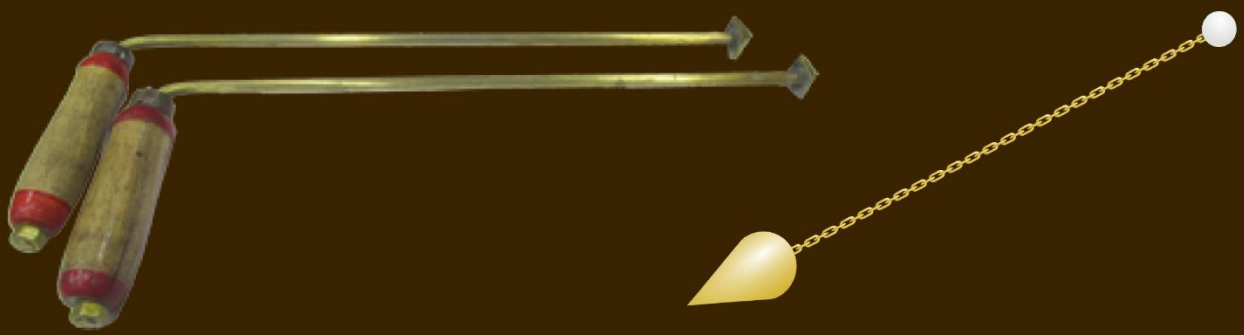
In the middle Ages the church associated dowsing with the Devil but was said to use dowsing in the Inquisitions. A lot of this is speculation regarding it being viewed as Satanic and if it was used in the Inquisitions. I have also heard it called water witching and this may refer back to when it was said to be of the Devil.

When I was young, my grandfather took me out and showed me how to dowse for water. He would take a willow branch that was forked evenly and trim off all the bark and sometimes he would wrap copper wire around the big side of the fork. The divining rod would look like a "Y" with the copper on only one side of the stick. You would hold one of the two other sticks (the Y part) in each hand and walk slowly around an area letting the divining rod lead the way. It was said that you will feel the tip point one way of the other and when you were on top of the water it would start to point downward.

Nowadays the divining rods are made of brass and you have two rods in the shape of an "L". You would have one rod in each hand and when searching for water or something else you would walk and watch the rods movement. The rods would point which way for you to go or cross in front of you when you were over water or the intended metal. Some use a pendulum to do dowsing or scrying. A few thoughts about using pendulums:

As with all etheric tools, it is the intention of use that makes the difference and even with clean intention there can be problems. Why do I say this? Use of a pendulum requires an "answer." If the person was scrying with the pendulum then we are talking about a medium type of scrying. This is very similar to the Ouija boards that almost everyone is familiar with from our childhoods and movies. So just like the Ouija board the person with the pendulum is asking for help or guidance from the spirit world. This is the dilemma I have with doing this - who or what is giving you the information?

The tool in itself is not a problem, I know of a crystal healer who uses a pendulum to see how the energy is flowing on a person she is working on. With all tools, pendulums can be used in ways that seem harmless but are just the opposite in the long run. Most tools in the world or metaphysics have the ability for being very powerful - it is all in accordance to how and who is using them. Think about spies trying to gather information, if they find who appears to be good informant they will take the person's word for things that may be half-truths or misleading lies.

A good thing to remember is that anyone can be wrong and they may have an agenda that is not good for the person asking the questions via the pendulum. I know some out there will not like my opinion about the uses of a pendulum but this is my opinion and I am sorry if this upsets anyone.

An interesting digression - A story about a true case of scrying to assist remote viewing:

This story took place in 1959 and has to do with the US Navy. It said that in a room full of naval officers (as witnesses), a civilian using a pendulum and several maps of the world, identified the location of the entire US submarine fleet and the location of every Soviet submarine in the world.

The civilian in the story was using a pendulum as a tool to assist in remote viewing so we are talking about using it to help him focus on an area on the map with his own clairvoyant abilities. The United States in 1972 had a program codename "Scanate" that researched remote viewing and the name changed to "Star Gate" in 1991. The CIA was involved and the DOD and many other agencies were as well. Considering the time and money spent by the government they were getting some results. So "yes" pendulums are dangerous, but with all tools that are out there to be used they are only dangerous if they are misused or used without caution and discretion.

EVPs – How Dangerous Are They?

Today's ghost hunting shows are full of new types of equipment to help hunters make contact with ghostly entities yet you may notice that a tried and true method of contact remains the EVP.

Electronic voice phenomenon is said to be a spirits voice that is manifested on an audio recording. EVP is a subcategory of instrumental trans-communication (or ITC), which includes all electronically recorded phenomena, including telephones, televisions, computers and specialized audio equipment. Interest in EVP apparently began in the 1920's in an article in the Scientific American and the perhaps the first documented case of EVP was in June of 1959, so this is not a new idea.

I have used tape recorders (before digital came out) on some of the investigations I worked with only one very faint voice that I could not rule as an EVP. This was because some of the people on the investigation were in the area of the recorder. With the new technology that has come out and more people using all sorts of recording devices as tools in investigations of the paranormal there will be an increase in the information that will have to be sifted through with a discerning mind.

In the movie "White Noise" which frightened a lot of people because of the prospect of what may be out there, the important thing to remember is that it was a story of what *could* happen. The players in the movie were drawn in with half-truths and bits of hope by evil entities until they were devoting all their time and energies to listening for messages from the other side. They opened every type of channel of communication with no direction just hoping to make contact. They did not use any discernment to view the information they were receiving until it was too late and the trap was sprung.

When viewing information of a paranormal investigation or just in day to day life we need *not* to jump to conclusions without looking at all the possibilities of what we could be seeing or hearing. On the program Ghost Hunters they show that everything captured on film or tape needs to be put to several tests before it is taken at face value. 

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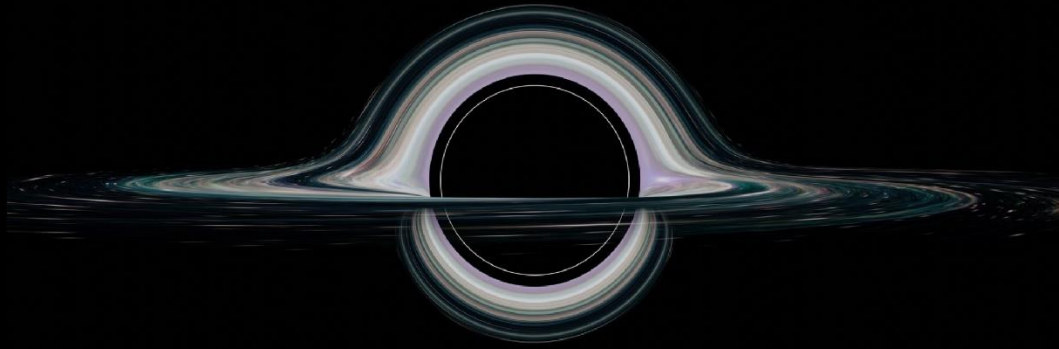

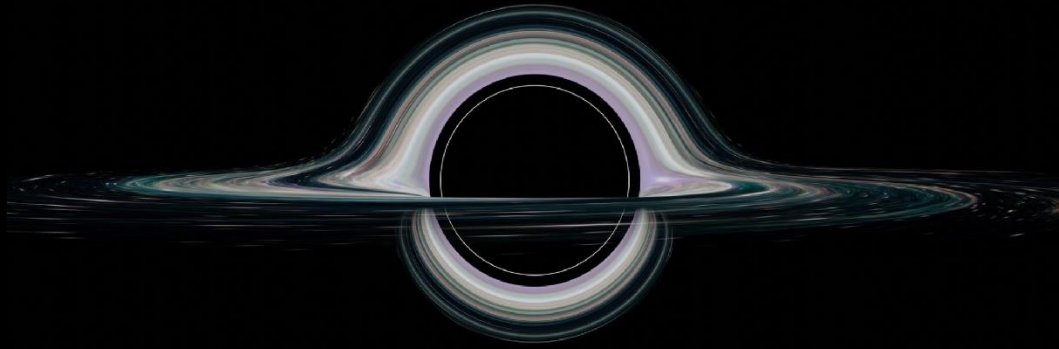

2. Open-mindedly increase contact with other types of social groups'
3. Continue to speak your truth and not fear to make people aware of their own inconsistencies of belief.
