Witnessing the Collapse

Once I understood and accepted that the disintegration of our civilization is already underway, I spent a number of years trying to get people to change their beliefs and their behavior. I felt that if they made the changes I was proposing they could make a "good" outcome more likely. I was disappointed when my exhortations and hectoring fell on mostly deaf ears - whenever I wasn't just preaching to the choir, that is. It was <u>Cassandra's</u> dilemma too.

The more I tried to promote change, however, the more I suffered. But the suffering didn't spring simply from the pain of disappointment. It went much deeper than that, and eventually precipitated my Dark Night of the Soul. The Buddha was right when he taught that all suffering springs from attachment. In my case the attachment was to a particular outcome - my vision of a sustainable, just, ecologically conscious society that made room for all living things on the planet, not just our relatives and friends. When that outcome was thwarted through public indifference and even hostility, I suffered mightily.

Fortunately, I went through a transformation about three years ago. The shift was complete enough that it enabled me to detach from outcomes while still remaining committed to the awareness of what's going on. At the same time I adopted the position that this reality is co-created by all its participants, and that at some level the nature of reality and our individual roles in it have been consciously chosen by us all. At that point, I realized that I had been working at cross purposes to the reality that was unfolding. The ongoing transformation, even if it becomes a collapse of civilization, is not meant to be stopped. Rather, it is the vessel within which our conscious awareness is being nurtured, developed and annealed. This leads to the rather uncomfortable conclusion that the collapse is not to be lamented or prevented, but rather to be celebrated and engaged. It will come as no surprise to those on similar journeys that when I surrendered to this understanding, my suffering ceased.

From that perspective, I decided that the most useful thing I can do - something that is aligned with the point of the exercise rather than in opposition to it - is simply to contribute my little bits of awareness to the field. I try to do it without expectation or attachment, without trying to elicit a particular response or outcome. Just put the awareness out there. Those who aren't ready for it yet will ignore or reject it, those who don't yet see it but are ready may awaken a bit more, those who are already aware may find some fresh nuance to play with.

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Whatever role my observations and discussions play in the unfoldment is the part they are meant to play. This is what I call "vocal witnessing".

I still care very deeply about what's happening, but I now remain relatively unattached to how it might unfold in the future. As a result I avoid talking about solutions as much as possible, largely because I don't think there are any - at least at the level most people think of "solutions" (like new policies or new technologies) The point of all this apparently catastrophic unfoldment is not for us to "solve the problem", but for us to wake up.

I agree completely with the writer Charles Eisenstein ("The Ascent of Humanity") and other observers we do not have a soluble problem, we have an insoluble predicament. Because of that, our most useful response will be at right angles to the problem space. That means that the door out of this mess isn't going to be opened by a new version of our old ways (new legislation, clean energy and more recycling) although that will play a role. The real doorway out will be found by shifting into a completely new way of being - the revolution of consciousness that so many of us know in our bones is just around the corner.

These days I'm putting all my chips on abetting that r/evolution of human consciousness, by acting as a vocal witness to the unfolding collapse.

Within the community of the environmentally and ecologically aware, this is an uncommon position, although perhaps less so among those who have chosen a spiritual response to their apprehension of collapse. Within the mainstream of activist thought it is still viewed as fatalism and defeatism. How does thinking about this perspective make you feel? Do you think it is a useful point of view or not? Is it helpful or dangerous? Is it an approach you have taken, or could see yourself taking? Or does it feel like sophistry - simply a tricky justification for fiddling while Rome burns?

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I never said it was easy to find your place in this world, but I'm coming to the conclusion that if you seek to please others, you will forever be changing because you will never be yourself, only fragments of someone you could be. You need to belong to yourself, and let others belong to themselves too. You need to be free and detached from things and your surroundings. You need to build your home in your own simple existence, not in friends, lovers, your career or material belongings, because these are things you will lose one day. That's the natural order of this world. This is called the practice of detachment

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The Nature of the Soul: What It Is and What It Isn't By Matt Sharpe

The Soul is a thing of much discussion and much assumption and misunderstanding. Many people, including the clergies of various religious and spiritual paths, haven't a clue as to the true nature of the Soul. Most often when they speak of the subject, they use their religion's holy texts, which may or may not be accurate to begin with, but even if they are, must be interpreted by an individual who has yet to have the experience of viewing life through the eye and from the state of consciousness of the Soul.

Many times, one will hear others speak of the Soul as "an atom of God", or another such comparison. Having the experience of the state of being that is Soul, in nearly every case, will completely change whatever the previous definition one held was, as well as the way one might have defined the words used to give the idea. An "atom" or "molecule" is an apt way to put it, however, it is also inaccurate, which should come as no surprise being that words, concepts and ideas are things solely of the Mental Plane, or mental understanding and arena. Therefore a word simply cannot encompass the reality of the Soul. The mind itself is not wide enough to encompass it, and even has a very hard time coming into any degree of an understanding of it, the Soul. Speaking of it and passing any understanding along verbally or in written form is very difficult to do.

I wish to name things that Soul is, as well as the things that it is not, to hopefully clarify the definitions, as well as to debunk the various misunderstandings and misinterpretations. Soul is quite beyond form. It has no shape, unless it chooses to adopt one, but that shape cannot, and does not, exemplify it in its own reality of being. I will begin by explaining the basic way the plane structure gives many the misunderstandings that they have. The Soul exists on its own plane, which is the first that is beyond all duality, and is therefore the first than can truly be called "heaven."

As it descends to the physical world for an incarnation, it picks up a mental body at the Mental Plane, a causal one at the Causal plane, and then an astral form at the Astral Plane, which actually corresponds with emotions. Next is the Physical Plane, and this is of course where one gets into the physical body that everyone is used to. The body that most of us refer to as a "ghost" is the Astral Body, which leaves its Physical counterpart at the time of physical death. This is not the Soul. The majority of times when one is having an out of body experience, this occurs by moving the consciousness into this body, and away from the physical. This is also what happens when we dream.

Although some with the gift of sight can see an Astral Form leave the body at the time of death, it is not the Soul that they are witnessing, but merely this lower, emotional body. The Soul has no emotions, has no mind, and no attachment, as they are things of the emotions and the mind. Soul is well beyond these in every way.

As it says in the Bible in the book of John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." The Holy Spirit, as it is called in the Bible is the literal Voice of God, and from IT was created the Soul. What this means is that, not only is the Soul both eternal and divine, but it is also Sound, very literally. The Light of God is a secondary Manifestation, but is merely the means of viewing the Sound of God. Being that the Spirit is Sound and is of God, so the Soul is the same, being of the Spirit (or Voice) of God, and in this way we find a truer understanding of what is meant by words explaining that "Soul is an atom of God."

Soul is Godlike, but Soul is not a God in and of itself as many make the mistake of assuming. What so many term as "enlightenment" is simply the realization of what Soul is, and its nature concerning both God, and All else in existence. This is usually called "Self-Realization." This occurs at a state of consciousness where there are no forms, no matter, energy, space or time. Soul and Heaven are beyond these things, which are merely lower aspects of reality which humans must learn to work with, and then through and beyond. Another cliché saying among "New-Age" groups today is that "We are all One," or "I am you." Neither of these are accurate definitions to the various phrases. The difficulty happens often for the same reason, we are trying to use words and language, which are purely mental placards that we use to identify things, to express a thing or experience that is quite beyond the lower states of matter, energy, space and time. There can tend to be much misunderstanding, as well as much assumption not based on any direct experience. "All are OF One," would be a much more accurate way of saying it. All Souls, while being the ultimate definition of an individual, are still all the same thing, the same ingredient, coming from the same Source or Cause, and are therefore equal in potential.

The degree, or state of realization of each individual unit or Soul, as experienced from the physical awareness upward, through the various lower planes, and eventually the higher ones also is different for each. Each Soul must willingly seek to work themselves into ever higher and more refined states of experience and consciousness, and it is this that is usually spoken of as "expanding awareness." This is literally the only way that one can "raise vibrations," or "ascend." There is simply no such thing as a "soul contract," as Soul, being beyond mind, emotion, energy and form, simply cannot be bound by any contract. The idea is somewhat ridiculous. Neither can a person, while online nor typing, lead another on any sort of a "soul journey." There are a great many fraudulent people who claim such things, but the way they explain it shows very clearly how little experience they have with Soul at all, much less any other Soul.

Now, having said the above concerning contracts, there remains a distinction to be made. First, any and all contracts made, are made by one of the lower bodies and/or states of awareness, but none of these are the Soul. The most obvious example would be a karmic "contract." This situation is not one imposed by God, or any angel or anything else, it is, rather, a thing chosen by one's self, and being that, and also a lower form of manifestation, is very dualistic. This means there will be both situations that are good or bad to the perceptions, meaning only the degree to which we like or dislike going through the experience. If one looks deeper, one finds that this has absolutely no bearing on whether or not that occurrence is good or bad concerning development of the state of consciousness. For example, one can use their free will to choose a thing they want for no good reason, and having made that choice are now bound by the "contract" of balancing the wrong they had chosen to do. It is an absolute requirement, and will be done, at some point along the way. But when one comes into the experience of balancing, or what is often termed "paying" the karma, they may not like it at all, just as another may not have enjoyed what was caused by the first individual's choice earlier on.

But making this "payment," while uncomfortable for the individual, and thus perceived as "bad," is actually a good experience as far as spiritual development is concerned, in this case "good" meaning "causing forward advancement." A situation where one gives a thing selflessly, such as aid or succor, freely and without asking payment, results in a measure of "good" karma, that in most cases proves to be a step up the spiritual ladder to a matching degree, or in simpler terms, a spiritual benefit that was not required in the first place for the gift that was originally given.

In any and every case, where any such "lower" action causes any act of retribution to become necessary, the laws set in place by the Divine alone, can and will execute it's re-balancing, through the agents of their choosing, before it can be considered balanced and then be removed from the books, as it were, and this is not by any means a "soul contract" as it does not, in any way, concern or bind the Soul Itself.

When a person has finally achieved this first major spiritual stage of development, or state of consciousness, they are not beyond creating and having to re-balance any further karmas. Nor do life's challenges and troubles magically end. If anything they only then, become greater, first as that Soul learns to balance itself within the lower aspects of life that it must live out. This balance is necessary to one's state of being, and if not gained, they will not be able to develop any further beyond that point. Having said that, it must also be mentioned, that achieving this Saint or Sant hood (by which I mean to or beyond Self-Realization), will actually free one from the cycles of karma and reincarnation, however, one must remain in that state by not creating further karmas that might build up and change the state of being. This is a constant challenge for any who enter the higher states of consciousness. They do not simply end the karmic circle, gain enlightenment, and then walk off in an eternal state of bliss. The entire struggle of earning this state of being, is always done "from the ground up," because this teaches the individual the true meaning of this state, as well as putting it into a perspective that won't so easily allow the ego's impulses to regain control. It is truly a struggle, and for many good reasons.

Many find that one who has supposedly attained this state, won't necessarily act in ways they believe such a one would. This is based on their own misunderstanding of the state of consciousness itself, as well as being seen through that lower state of consciousness that others are working through at any given time. This can often cause a further struggle between these different individuals, living from different states, but the one who is in reality Self-Realized, is willing to surrender the situation to the Divine Will, and allow God to work things out in the way IT sees as the best for all involved. This ensures that one is not working from their ego. One who is seeing and interacting with life from this point of view, will also practice a great deal of detachment that most often, the average human is utterly unaccustomed to. It is this very quality that is nothing more than an aspect of unconditional love and is thus free of placing conditions on another concerning whatever interaction that one has with others.

The Soul, being formless and also Godlike can easily expand Itself and Its awareness, to any degree, and in terms of the Physical Plane, this means that It can literally be aware literally anywhere, from the Sun in our solar system, to any planet in the furthest galaxy from planet earth. This also explains its ability to be aware anywhere on any of the lower planes as well, from the emotional worlds to any of the Mental Planes. The consciousness of the Soul can be consistently aware on all of the planes it occupies simultaneously and independently. The bodies used on each of the lower planes lives and acts in full awareness even if the physical self is unaware of this happening. 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SPIRITUAL GREED

In the world today, one quality that seems to have no end is that of spiritual greed. It is not a new activity as it has existed for nearly as long as human civilization has existed, but it seems now to have reached previously unknown heights of activity. Spiritual greed is a thing that happens when a person begins what they term as a spiritual endeavor, but their motivation for doing so is purely for personal and monetary gain. It matters not if this is done knowingly or unknowingly as it is always the individual's responsibility to discern whether a pursuit or goal is accurate, truthful and effective, or if it is a form of self-deception that misleads to acquire a gain from the victim. Whether or not that course of action will stand in the way of Soul's development or aid it in moving forward.

One of the more recent variations of this is what is termed "DNA activation." The sellers of this purported action have not only a lack of a complete understanding of DNA, but also an obvious lack of spiritual experience. The theory is that by having the DNA activated by numerous methods, this activation will enable the individual to "ascend" to a higher state of being. This goes along with the belief that there is a new earth that is about to be manifested only in a different dimension that only activated persons would be able to go to. Most often this is stated to be able to happen because the DNA activation will allow them to move permanently into a light body. Often a large sum of money is charged for these sessions. In Eckankar the Mahanta, the Living ECK Master, will never promise any such useless or fraudulent action since the teachings make very clear how consciousness works and manifests on each plane. The reality is that every individual is always already in their own light body (the Astral Body). And the only way to ascend is to raise the state of consciousness which enables one to be aware in the Astral Body and to bring back the memory of the experiences in that area. Therefore I say that those who offer these activations have no spiritual experience and are obviously unaware of this factor.

DNA is only to be found in the physical body, and it in no way dictates the ability of one to consciously leave the body. The entire concept is a delusion based on fantasy, such as that created by Guy Ballard and his "I AM" and "Ascended Master" teachings. With the idea of ascension, factors such as DNA upgrading were added in later, along with inaccurate historical translations, specifically those of Zecharia Sitchin of the Sumerian cuneiform tablets. These so-called translations have never found another proponent that was actually trained in the field of translating ancient scripts, thus the use of italics around the word historical. After the Ballard's died (and ascended) what had begun as their channeled teachings were carried on by others who expanded the ideas to include the physical universes and many races of alien beings. From this entered the idea that DNA upgrading and activation could enable humans with so called super powers and the ability to manifest a light body on the Physical Plane. DNA has no way to give an ability to enter a light body, just as there is no light body on the physical plane. Some speak of upgrading the physical body to one of crystal, but if you research you will find not one individual anywhere that is able to show anyone this crystal body and thus prove the concept. It all sounds feasible to the imagination, but the idea has no basis in reality, and this in itself demonstrates very clearly that there is no actual experience with the ideas of this nature that are being sold to the public. A little common sense can go a long way. There is nothing wrong with critical analysis just as there is nothing wrong with having an opened heart. A balance between both is the most advantageous and honest way to go about things.

For any fraudulent persons who knowingly deceive others to collect profits for their personal gain, their actions demonstrate very clearly how spiritually bankrupt that individual truly is. It makes little difference what deceptions they may be guilty of while plying their trade. It also matters little if one claims things, they are not capable of, or have no actual experience with. The price for such actions will absolutely come due despite the many attempts made to deny any such situations having ever taken place. And the lessons abound on every side of the issue. Many times, the so called victims of such are equally involved with the perpetrator and the crime when speaking of the karmic sense of things happening. And while past karmas are involved, the situation is also going to be full of tests for each of the individuals that can only progress according to the choices made by each in each specific situation. Things are often not quite what they might seem to be at first glance. And no one is truly innocent.

One more form of spiritual greed that manifests itself quite often on earth and throughout all time periods, is religious fundamentalism. It wears a mask that tries to convince all observers that it is righteous. It uses a righteous anger to persecute its perceived enemies, and often persuades its followers to have an unshakable and unquestioning observance of its standards in a particular land and amongst a culture. It can be very hard to defy what is purported to be a spiritual authority that judges one for the crimes this group perceives to have been committed. Such groups of people gather often, throughout all differing cultures, religious paths and time periods. When one finally observes its true face, it will invariably be named spiritual or religious intolerance. Often those in a religious group who start it, do so after an apparent crisis amongst that group, sometimes this may begin in a righteous manner, but it always devolves into judgment that has little or no tolerance for the ways of other religious or spiritual groups. In Eckankar we maintain that our teachings support all other spiritual groups and their teachings rather than oppose them.

Often those who support the intolerant view are those within a religious group that tends towards a fundamentalist view of their chosen religion. Obviously, this can cause those within it to adopt a prejudiced view of others outside of their group. It is a good idea to use a greater amount of patience with such people, should one meet any, regardless of the faith they practice. Much of the trouble that can arise from this sort of attitude could easily be detected by any group of people that is in possession of a willingness to be honest with themselves and ask if they are an example of love in the way they view other differing groups of people. How the word love is defined is of great importance since love is such an expansive concept. The definition ought to include honesty, patience, a calm detachment, gratitude, forgiveness, and tolerance. If a fundamentalist group were living by the example of the teachings they promote, how could these qualities not be a part of them? Note the word tolerance. In Eckankar there is also a fundamentalism that has been known to exist, but all members are encouraged to practice tolerance instead as well as forgiveness, as these are the ways of love.

Many spiritual paths over time adopt rules that become known as dogma, which are a principle or set of principles laid down by an authority as incontrovertibly true. Such can exist, but it is of tantamount importance for the individual to gain their own direct experiences with those founding principles so that they can develop the awareness to be able to interpret them accurately. When a path sets out its dogmas in a way that makes them a set of rules that can never be questioned, it becomes impossible to gain any actual experience with them, and spiritually speaking, that religion dies from closing off the place where the divine can enter them.

This is usually because the powers that be have constricted the ways of interpretation so that only a very limited range can be accepted or applied. Whether this is a good or more negative factor is a matter of opinion, but it can truly vary from path to path. It is important that the individual develop their own ability to go within consciously and to be able to experience, learn, and interpret what they have experienced. This makes possible an understanding of many levels interpretation that may not have been apparent to an individual at first sight.

From this expanse of various circumstances and experiences one may glean a great many meanings and interpretations that can widen and deepen any great truth into realms that hadn't been considered previously. From these experiences a teaching can develop and reach much further than anyone could have guessed at. It is this purpose that a living Master or Guru is meant to serve in his time. This does not necessarily mean that they are teaching different truths than any that came before them, but rather that they are re-interpreting the applications of the same truths in a way that people of that time period can easily understand and work with. In this way teachings can be brought from the inner to the outer life and worked with and progressed through in a meaningful way. This evolution and development is necessary for a teaching to be a living teaching. It must live. To do so it must also have the ability to evolve in a number of ways and must always be presented by a living Master to the Physical Plane who can also offer them inwardly in a balanced fashion. This has always been the chief means of spiritual education from humankind's beginning. The first known living teachers were always shamans, usually in a localized tribal setting. But these shamans were visited by the Adepts who were necessarily alive in the body and were thus able to teach and demonstrate the application of the teachings in the daily lives of the people. There were also those no longer alive in the body that may have even been recognized in various other spiritual paths around the globe. A Spiritual Master is not owned by any religious tradition, regardless of what any of these might claim in their dogmas.

There is no shortage of persons who purport Eckankar to be one they see as being chiefly founded on fraud. The usual reason is a claimed spiritual greed in the form of monetary gain. However there has never been shown any actual evidence of this other than a person's purported claims, founded on memory alone, which has been proven in court to be highly changeable and totally unreliable. When asked for written and signed proofs of these claims none have ever yet been able to provide any, which leaves each individual free to make the choice that they see fit to make. Inner experience is proof enough, if the teachings of Eckankar work for one, what more proof is needed? Based on these I maintain the verity and authenticity of both the Masters of the Vairagi Order and the teachings of Eckankar as standing outside of the confines of any form of spiritual greed. Whether or not a person agrees with this is a thing they will have to arrive at their own decision on, and each is entitled to their own opinion.

Another form of spiritual greed is expressed in many cases by the people that fall into that previous group, former chelas of Eckankar who have left for whichever reason. At some point after they decide they are finished with these teachings they may join groups with other former students to discuss what they consider to be evils perpetrated by the Eckankar Organization. While no student of Eckankar is necessarily perfect and cannot always be expected to act in the best manner, it is still most beneficial to view things from an objective viewpoint. Some ECKists may think, speak or act in ways that are simply not good, but this is to be expected of anyone, regardless of the belief system or spiritual path they happen to be on. It is a common thing as Soul goes through varied experiences designed by its need to learn certain lessons and this is an ongoing process.

On the other side of the aisle, the former students seem too often head into the exact same place as far as sets of ideas about their former path and the imagined motivations behind what they consider to be wrongs committed.

In the way these individuals often act, they demonstrate clear tendencies towards a sort of fundamentalism that is very closed and limited. One sure sign is a person that refuses to admit the possibility of any other factor, condition, or motivation than the one they have decided is the fact of the matter. Any individual certainly has the freedom to have their own opinion, even if others do not agree or like it. But when one decides they have discovered the truth of a thing it might be a better course of action to go ahead and test it out, search for direct evidence or to even debunk that course of thought, or honestly try to which demonstrates an ability to keep the mind and heart opened to learning more about a thing. A thing may seem to be the obvious case in a particular matter, but if the individual who committed it has left the physical life, they can no longer be so easily asked detailed questions about why they did a certain thing, and that most often leads to rampant speculation which can tend to form walls within one's consciousness, walls that the individual can be very unwilling to look beyond. And of course, that requires the closing of the various pathways of perception. When challenged the persons purporting a specific thing might jump to calling names rather than providing solid evidence of the situation, they claim to have evidence of.

When another suggests a different possibility of explanation for that situation or factor, often you might find some without the necessary education trying to diagnose another's mental condition, which of course is simply a defensive mechanism created in the attempt to support that person's egoic tendencies. Some simply refuse to be wrong, which demonstrates that limited way of thinking and closing off of the ability to learn, generally having to do with some condition of the pride. One who is less under the control of the egoic-self has no trouble allowing others to have opinions that oppose their own. Those within the firm grasp of the egoic-self do not tend to offer this freedom to others that do not hold the same opinions as they do, as they lack the ability to hold a different view and remain comfortable by themselves in it. In this way it demonstrates itself as a weakness and a form of spiritual greed that is every bit as bad as any religious or spiritual group has ever been in the fundamentalist sense, in history choosing self-preservation over even the slightest degree of spiritual liberty.

It becomes an essential piece of experience and learning for anyone, especially an ECK chela, to not only forgive and allow that non agreeing party to hold their own views, but at the same time it is equally as important that one remain steadfast in their own views and their ability to continue gaining direct experience and learning. This process never stops, regardless of the lifestyle or spiritual choices an individual makes. Just as each are responsible for the thoughts, words, judgments and actions they take against another, so also must one constantly examine their own motivations to be certain to not allow the lower or egoic-self to assert control over the conscious choices made. Where necessary an individual might also need to be strong enough to hold their own center in the face of being challenged. One should never be afraid to stand for the principles they have accepted, despite the challenges that others might at times present them with. The spiritual journey is never an easy one, and it is without doubt filled with a great many challenges, ones that may send the weak at heart running in fear. Fear has no place in the life of those who seek to achieve the highest levels of spiritual attainment and consciousness, for by overcoming said fears an ever-greater degree of strength and fortitude are born, as well as the ever growing levels of patience, experience and freedom.

While one allows another their own space and freedom, another potential pitfall of attitude can impose itself upon him. Another form of spiritual greed, the judgment of others for the path they choose to take and regarding oneself as being higher, better, or more spiritually evolved than another because of the path of their choice, be it Eckankar, Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism, Judaism, Christianity, Islam or any other, is nothing more than a manifestation of pride. This quality seeks to boost the self above others by a means that does not in reality exist. Religious pride is a form of spiritual greed in that it attempts to take all of the benefit for one's self by deciding that that he is taking a more righteous way and is thus far ahead of any others that take another way. This is always an illusion and for that reason one must remain aware and keep a watch for it. When found it must be gotten rid of, it cannot remain as it will throw the individual off balance. The attention must always be kept on oneself to identify bad habits such as this and remove them.

Spiritual greed is simply greed, one of the five passions of the mind, despite the separating of this specific form of greed. Let there be no mistaking the reality of greed and its ability to hold Soul in these lower realms. The effects are the same regardless of the type of greed, but spiritual greed had need of being mentioned and having attention brought to it being that it is a far-reaching temptation that many fall prey to. This quality must be discerned wherever possible, and there is a great need of individuals being able to recognize it whether it be a trait of another or if it be a quality that one discovers within their own self. Many times, a thing such as this can exist habitually within one's personality by virtue of its never having been recognized as what it truly is. The realization of finding it is one that is never pleasant but is necessary. For this reason, the qualities of self-honesty and humility are very important as they act in a way that brings these unrecognized qualities to the attention of the conscious self that one may choose to make the conscious effort to change it. Never be satisfied to simply recognize the existence of such a thing, instead seek to add a plus one factor to it by conquering it and removing it from the self.

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One thing: you have to walk, and create the way by your walking; you will not find a ready-made path.

It is not so cheap, to reach to the ultimate realization of truth.

You will have to create the path by walking yourself; the path is not ready-made, lying there and waiting for you.

It is just like the sky: the birds fly, but they don't leave any footprints.

You cannot follow them; there are no footprints left behind.

SACRAL- Near sex organs: Use Jasper


ROOT – Near anus: Use Onyx

The very structure of trauma, including activation, dissociation and freezing are based on the evolution of survival behaviors. When threatened or injured, all animals draw from a "library" of possible responses. We orient, dodge, duck, stiffen, brace, retract, fight, flee, freeze, collapse, etc. All of these coordinated responses are somatically based- they are things that the body does to protect and defend itself. It is when these orienting and defending responses are overwhelmed that we see trauma.

The bodies of traumatized people portray "snapshots" of their unsuccessful attempts to defend themselves in the face of threat and injury. Trauma is a highly activated incomplete biological response to threat, frozen in time. For example, when we prepare to fight or to flee, muscles throughout our entire body are tensed in specific patterns of high energy readiness. When we are unable to complete the appropriate actions, we fail to discharge the tremendous energy generated by our survival preparations. This energy becomes fixed in specific patterns of neuromuscular readiness. The person then stays in a state of acute and then chronic arousal and dysfunction in the central nervous system. Traumatized people are not suffering from a disease in the normal sense of the word- they have become stuck in an aroused state. It is difficult if NOT IMPOSSIBLE TO FUNCTION NORMALLY UNDER THESE circumstances.

MASQUERADE

Over the years I have come across some very odd circumstances and stories during my paranormal investigations and reading research but none odder than beings who show up occasionally in broad daylight and interact with humans and they are, well, just plain odd.

One case that stands out was that of Rick Aiello of New York. He had stopped in a local tobacco store next door to where his wife was shopping for groceries. He was very familiar with the store and the woman behind the counter as he had frequented the place for many years. Upon entering, Mr. Aiello noticed a small group of about five people who appeared to be in their mid-twenties or younger which by state law at the time required an ID check. As Mr. Aiello waited his turn to check out he observed the bunch all had their backs to him except one male who was standing there looking at him. He was described as tall, thin, wearing and black suit and tie and a bright white shirt. His skin was the palest Mr. Aiello had ever seen. This male was fiddling with a gold cigarette case which appeared to a 1940s style case, stuffing it with candy cigarettes.

In the meantime, the counter lady was becoming suspicious because each ID she was checking was from a different state and New York law at the time held a heavy penalty for selling cigarettes to minors with fake IDs. She inquired, "Who are you people and what are you up to?" This caused Mr. Aiello to pay more attention to the group and he then noticed that they were all dressed odd with 1940s clothing. The one female of the group had on a corduroy jumper and a pair of go-go boots from the 1960s. He also noticed that they acted peculiar. None of them had answered the counter lady's questions. They paid for a couple of cigars and left picking up their suitcases that had been left by the door. The suitcases were also odd 1930s or 1940s style.



When they left, Mr. Aiello felt a strange tingling in his body. He approached the counter lady to pay for his cigarettes. She was white as a sheet and when he asked her what was wrong she replied that she had no idea what the group of people are talking about and couldn't remember half of what they said. She was confused and scattered. Then the worst part of the whole situation happened. The odd group had crossed the street to the parking lot and simply disappeared. It was two o'clock in the afternoon.

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The Danger of Elementals in Paranormal Investigation

The topic of elementals often comes up in paranormal investigation. The question is just how dangerous are they?

Elemental spirits are Earth entities that are often believed to be primitive, evil, and often dangerous. They attach themselves to locations. Their character is often connected to one of the four elements; earth, wind, fire, and wind. There are different levels of danger associated with elementals usually related to various cultures. For example some think the Fire and Water elementals are the most dangerous because of their capacity for destruction. It is generally felt that elementals are not dangerous to humans UNLESS they are provoked, called upon or challenged. The general consensus is to stay away from them because they are more powerful than ghosts and at times, more potent than demons. Some investigators have reported that elementals are shape shifters capable of looking like animals, trees and plants or even geography. They can even take on outrageous mixed forms like something out of a nightmare. Despite all this they are also believed to have a mortal soul unlike humans who have immortal souls. *

Elemental hauntings often manifest in the following ways:

- poltergeist-like activity: items being blatantly moved, slammed, destroyed, loud knocking on walls at night
- personal items going missing or moved to odd places
- aggressive physical touch being grabbed, pushed, hair pulled, bitten, blankets being pulled off of you in the middle of the night
- balls of glowing light or lightning-fast wisps of light
- food items spoiling long before their expiration dates
- hearing far-off music OR faint drumming in the distance **

A famous haunting including an elemental was that of Leap Castle in Coolderry County Offaly, Ireland. According to occultist Mildred Darby (1915) it was described as an undefinable grey shadow "thing" with humanlike features – black holes for eyes, slobbery lips with a saliva dripping slack jaw, no nose and thick coarse dark hair covering its forearms.

Some reports say Mildred was responsible for conjuring up the elemental because of her dabbling in the occult. Other theories are:

• the Druids put it there to protect the site which was sacred to them




- Gerald Fitzgerald Earl of Kildare, a renowned magick practitioner who had attempted to take over the castle on several occasions conjured it
- he spirit of an ancient O'Carroll who died in the castle from Leprosy which validates the decrepit look of the elemental as described ***

It is difficult to get rid of an elemental attached to a location. You can consider getting help from a Shaman who understands such things connected to land. Cleansing with sage won't work. If an elemental threatens to invade your personal living space, you can use sea or kosher salt the outside perimeter of the abode to hold it at bay until you consult a shaman. The inside of your abode should be blessed at the same time by a priest or minister.

Hello to all. I was sent these two questions some time ago. Here are the queries...

Dear Rev. John Holbrook - I like to read books about real paranormal investigations. One thing I have never been able to find out is how to properly get rid of a Ouija Board. The only thing I could find was that if you have already used a board, you should not burn it because it only destroys the oracle and not any portal that has been opened. My questions:

1. How do you close a portal?

2. How do you properly dispose of a Ouija Board?

Thank you Jamison for your question. To start off again, this is just my opinion on the question and this is my best understanding of the question asked. Let us first look at what a portal is. Webster has "Portal definition is - door, entrance; especially: a grand or imposing one". So we are talking about a door or entrance to the spirit realm that was opened by the use of the Ouija Board. The tool that was used is the Ouija Board and this is just the tool and cannot open the portal by itself. There are many different tool that are used to open portals besides a Ouija Board. There has to be at least one person involved in the opening of the portal. The more people involved in opening of the portal the more energy is used to open the portal. There could have been a portal already nearby unknown to the people until the tool was used. The portal may stay attached to the tool, the place that is was opened or even to one of the persons that used the tool to open the portal. So if a portal has been opened and needs to be closed you first need to know if it is attached to the tool, place or person. I will start with how to close a portal attached to the tool and not a person or place. The way to close a portal will depend on your own personal spiritual beliefs. Your beliefs have more power to you than using something that may go against your beliefs. Some Reiki users believe that they can close portals using intent and the energy and chakras associated with Reiki. Some of the other Asian spiritual beliefs have chants and talisman that they use to cleans an area where a portal may be. I believe that the user of the belief has to have good intent and confidence in that their belief can close the portal. There are several things that could be useful no matter your spiritual belief like intent, burning sage and using the higher power of your belief. For me personally I do ask for the Angels for help in closing a portal while burning sage. Within your beliefs you can find strength and help in closing a portal. Now if it is attached to a person you may have to use their spiritual beliefs to help them to close a portal that is attached to them. You will not be able to close it if they do not want you to close it. If it attached to a place you will have to be the owner of the place, you have to have the right to close the portal. Some have opened portals in locations that no one has the right to close the portal. This can cause issues that takes multiple tries and ways to close the portal and may not ever close the portal completely.

The second part of your question was "How do you properly dispose of a Ouija Board?" As will all spiritual tools once you have closed any portal or any attachment it may have there is several ways that you can dispose of it. You can seal it off. This will require that you cleanse it first. Here again it will depend on your spiritual beliefs. Burning sage or using holy water if it fits with your spiritual beliefs will cleanse the tool. If the tool has been cleansed and any portals or attachment closed you can burn the tool if it is burnable. Burn it during the day and do it with good intent and that the fire cleanse our world of this tool. You can bury the tool after it has been cleansed and sealed. If you are not burning it you will want to seal it so that it cannot be used. This again will again be specific to your belief, for me I may paint a cross on it or cover it in paint and then paint a cross on it. Or put it in a box that you have done this to, in the box you put the tool and some salt then bury it during the day and maybe plant some flowers there also. Some people have after they have cleansed the tool will have it on display. Not to be used but sealed behind glass usually with other tools that have been cleansed. They will usually have items of their spiritual belief sealing the tool from causing any problems. If you have cleansed the tool and don't use it again you can dispose of it just about any way you want as long as you stay true to your spiritual beliefs. I hope that I have answers your question and thank you for your question.



Hello Mr. Holbrook - I would like to know about animal spirits. Can a deceased pet still hang around a home? If so, can they ever be mean or evil? Thanks! (Editor: No state given).

First I would like to say that my answer will be my own opinion based on my own personal beliefs and experiences. With that being said lets first look at the different types of hauntings. I am not going to discuss animal spirits in general because of all the different types that are out there in folklore. Let's just keep our discussion on a family pet.

The first thing that comes to mind is the residual energy type of haunting. If you have had a pet you have probably noticed that they are creatures of habit. They will do the same things every day and have a routine. Some residual energy hauntings are just like a playback of an event that has occurred. There is no real interaction with the spirit, they are just seen or heard doing something that they did in life. This could be like that pet running down the hall or any other activity that they used to do on day to day basis. So looking at this type of haunting it could be that the pets residual energy is making the human still think that the pet is still around.

The next type of haunting is the intelligent haunting. This type of haunting will possibly interact or try to be noticed by others. This is not a playback, this is more like a visit from your pet

This haunting can be a smell, sound, feeling or even a specter of the pet. With the love that the human has for their pet (and the pets own love) being a cause that may keep them connected even after death. The feeling that you are being visited by your pet can be very soothing to a person. So this type of haunting could be viewed as being a positive haunting but the next can be more of a problem type of haunting.

Poltergeist type haunting can be distracting and a disturbing types of haunting. Having items broken, doors opened and closed or physical harm can be quite disturbing and may not be a deceased pet visiting their human. This maybe the part of the question asking "if so, can they ever be mean or evil'. When looking into poltergeist hauntings there is always a chance that you are not dealing with a ghost type entity. Many of the poltergeist entities will appear as something from your memory to hide their true identity. Your loving pet would not comeback on a visit to torment you. Well maybe knocking a glass off a table, maybe your cat but I doubt that they would do that as a ghost.

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Glamour

By the pricking of my thumbs, something wicked this way comes. - Ray Bradbury

Glamour began quite literally with magic. Growing from the Scottish *gramarye* around 1720, *glamer* was a sort of spell that would affect the eyesight of those afflicted, so that objects appear different than they actually are. Sir Walter Scott anglicized the word and brought it into popular use in his poems ("You may bethink you of the spell / Of that sly urchin page / This to his lord did impart / And made him seem, by glamour art / A knight from Hermitage"); not long after his death in 1832 the word began to be used to describe the metaphoric spell we cast upon one another by being particularly beautiful or fascinating. It wasn't necessarily a compliment ("There was little doubt that he meant to bring his magnetism and his glamour, and all his other diabolical properties, to market here," from an 1878 novel) but by the 1920s—not coincidentally, the time women started developing the styles that we now recognize as glamorous—the meaning had shed much of its air of suspicion. ¹

The Scottish weren't the only ones to associate grammar with magic spells.

In classical antiquity the Greek and Latin ancestors of the English word *grammar* were used in reference not only to the study of language but also to the study of literature. In the medieval period, Latin *grammatica* and its outcomes in other languages were extended to include learning in general. Since almost all learning was couched in a language not spoken or understood by the unschooled populace of Europe, it was commonly believed that mystifying subjects such as magic and astrology were included in *grammatica*. And scholars were consequently sometimes regarded with awe and more than a little suspicion. (One of those scholars was the legendary Faust, the necromancer and/or astrologer who sold his soul to the devil in exchange for knowledge and power.)²

Today, Glamour magic is generally used to make a person more appealing to others – emphasis on the word "appear." It does not actually change a person but helps boost confidence which can make them more desirable. It is very charismatic and change perceptions. The question of ethics comes up here – is this deceptive or lying? In a personal situation, it may be more acceptable but – it can sweeten your words so that other people are more likely to believe you, to agree with you, or to think you're right. So it's great to use for use before presentations, job interviews, or any kind of negotiation. What about Glamour magic used on a wider scale – to make an organization or business per se look like it is something it is not. That is a manipulation and well, let's face it, it breaks Universal Law.

It is ritualistic by nature (spells to be recited, tools and objects to be used, correspondences to be made), a practice of manipulation by applied psychology to bend situations to one's will. On a large scale, by those who are into demonic practices, it can be used to infiltrate society in nefarious ways. Think of a serial killer who uses it to dupe victims into thinking he/she is charming and kind. As Satanist Anton LaVey described, "the change in situations or events in accordance with one's will, which would, using normally accepted methods, be unchangeable."

Yes, it goes that far and further. Consider a Paranormal Witness Protection program and the implications that might have. (Read here: <u>http://meticinestication.com/proportion.</u>)


Have no doubt, the internet and magazines (particularly teen magazines) and books are full of DIY spells to assist in getting what you want as long as you understand you may not get what you need.

Hermetic Templar Folklore

There are a few stories among the Hermetic Templars that have become legend over the years. One of them is the story of the hanged Templar and his Witch bride.

In the early 1200's a Hermetic Templar married a Witch in the Cult of Isis. Their names were never known. She had coven sisters within the Cult that attended the wedding of the two. They were married for two months when the Catholic Church called on the Templar to go to the Crusades in the Israel. During the two months they were together the Witch conceived a child, which the Templar didn't know about at the time of his leaving. There was a rumor around at the time that the women in the Cult of Isis were prostitutes that had left the profession. A rumor which was not discouraged by the church. One of the Catholic priests took a liking to the Witch, and wanted to use what he believed were her skills from her past life. She apparently wasn't a past prostitute, but then such things didn't matter to the catholic clergy at the time. When the Witch told him he wasn't getting anything from her, as she preferred to wait for her husband's return, the priest became vindictive. The Witch became one of the first to come under the inquisition. She was stoned for being a Witch. The church had no concern for her unborn child. A child of a Witch would be born as evil to them. When it was over, her sisters in the Cult buried her under the shade of a tree.

When the Templar returned he found his home abandoned. Thinking his wife had gone to stay with her sisters in the Cult, he went to them to ask if she was there. It was at this time that he learned what had happened. The High Priestess of the Cult told him that he might also find his unborn child in the grave as well. When they showed him the grave, he dug it up, intending to try to rescue the child. When he reached his wife's body, he found that in death she had somehow managed to cross her right leg over her left leg. The child appeared to be in the process of coming out of the womb.

The child's head was resting on the Witch's right leg, which was making a type of pillow for the child. Both were already skeletons.

The Templar, enraged, rode into the city and went on a killing rampage of all catholic clergy that were responsible. He was eventually caught and sentenced to hang for the killings. The Witches' sisters were present for the hanging. As the Templar fell, and the rope snapped tight, the crowd saw him trying, as a final act, to cross his right leg over his left. The Witches ran forward and pushed the right leg up so he could do it. This is how he died. He was buried beside his wife.

There are 3 additional stories that sprung from this legend.

1) As a tribute to the Templar for bringing Justice for their sister....the Witches brought "The Hanged Man" of the Major Arcana in the Tarot into existence.

2) Years later, when some Hermetic Templars started to become pirates they returned the honor to the Witches by making the "Skull and Crossbones" flag which now represents piracy.

3) In the 1600's an unknown Irish poet wrote the poem titled "Táim sínte ar do thuama". Its rumored the author wrote it in honor of the Templar and the Witch. In the 1960's this poem was translated into the English language by another Irish poet named Frank O'Connor. In 1979, a musician named Phillip King put the poem to music. The song "I Am Stretched on Your Grave" has become the most recorded song among Pagan and Occult bands, with the most famous version being done by Sinead O'Connor.

THE ASTEROID AMERICA



Did you know that there are literally thousands upon thousands of asteroids or "minor planets" on record? All of them can be identified by number and most of them can also be identified by name. Earth Quirks: True North VS Magnetic North

What is there about Earth areas where a compass would point true north rather than magnetic north?

The difference between true north and magnetic north is an angular difference that is called magnetic declination. The needle on a compass aligns itself to the local geomagnetic field which varies all over the earth's surface. You will need to visualize the earth having a magnetic field that runs through the center and out at two ends. This field starts at the north and is pulled south covering the entire earth. This is very similar to how a stick magnet is; there is a positive side and a negative side of each magnet. The earth's magnetic field is the same, the positive is the north and the negative is the south. The reason that the magnetic field is varied over the surface of the earth is that there are minerals, magma and all types of things that can affect the magnetic field.

When looking at the magnetic field and how a compass lines up to true north there is a zero line of magnetic declination. This is where true north and magnetic north are the same on a compass. I think that it is on the west side of the panhandle and the Bermuda Triangle is on the east side of the panhandle.






Spiritual Sanctuary - Where the Hell Is It?

And there he sat like a Buddha on one of our mother's boudoir cushions, legs crossed, and hands in a yoga position. There were Ram Dass posters on the walls. He even had a portable tape player in there.


Now our dad's first reaction was to burst out laughing but he held back and requested my brother leave the closet and his bedroom as he performed an exorcism of the closet. Posters were removed, rolled up and excommunicated to the garage. Our mother was ecstatic to get her cushion back. Then our dad had a little heart to heart chat with clone boy in his den. Not surprising to me but to the rest of the family, our dad knew quite a bit about Ram Dass and had his angle all set to roll. We never knew what he said to Dass Clone but my brother seemed perfectly normal for all intent and purpose shortly thereafter.

So to wrap it all up – establish yourself a sanctuary and go there when needed. What you find out may not solve the problems of the world but it may give you some needed grounding and rebalancing to cope.

Terry worked for many years as a journalist and press officer, writing in his spare time and publishing a number of novels. Regarded as one of the most significant contemporary English-language satirists, Pratchett has won numerous literary awards, was named an Officer of the British Empire (OBE) "for services to literature" in 1998, and has received honorary doctorates from the University of Warwick in 1999, the University of Portsmouth in 2001, the University of Bath in 2003, the University of Bristol in 2004, Buckinghamshire New University in 2008, the University of Dublin in 2008, Bradford University in 2009, the University of Winchester in 2009, and The Open University in 2013 for his contribution to Public Service.
