

Do they really?

Psychologists consider a little competition now and then a healthy thing but, what happens when the situation gets out of hand bordering on the extreme and ends up in a proverbial *pissing contest*? What's a spiritual person to do to avoid letting that *alpha-person* get on one's nerves? Remember it takes two to tango so stop fueling the fire.

Pissing contests occur in all walks of life and in just about every social situation. It's worth remembering that being competitive isn't bad - just being overly so. If somebody wants to be the best, but balances that with respect for others, competitiveness isn't a problem. A pissing contest ensues because all involved are taking it way too seriously. If you are working diligently on something and someone else is trying their damndest to out-do you, try to take it stride. If your work is good it will shine and nothing or no one else will deter its glimmer no matter how hard they try to piss on your attempts.

Some of the worst pissing contests occur over materialism. Gloating is a nuisance and who cares if something cost more or is a *rare* find? The one with the most toys does not win in the end... coffins don't have pockets. This behavior can be diffused by honestly finding and expressing sincere happiness for the other person's good fortune and letting it all go. If you cease to give a reaction to this type of nonsense, *the pisser* will cease thinking it important to tell you about it.

Learn how to laugh - long and hearty as it will prevent your ego from getting in the way. Let the other guy overspend on his material needs. 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Some people are simply narcissistic and arrogant, and see you, according to psychologist Dr. Melanie Greenberg, "as a potential threat to their own success, or as an object to use or manipulate in order to meet their own needs or increase their resources."

Manipulation is large by-product of competition and a necessary component of a pissing contest. Manipulative techniques are based in fear behavior and are thus expressed as a strong desire to control others and situations. The worst kinds of pissing contests have foundations in this defense mechanism. When you think about manipulators, they are nothing but bullies with psychological flair. They like to blame you for things and are adept guilting others into doing certain things. In their minds, they can never lose a pissing contest because they believe themselves to be too clever and subtle to lose. What can be done about this piss puddle?

Avoidance can work but if the person is persistent, you'll need more than an umbrella for the yellow rain. It might be better to be honest with them about their behaviors. Have a frank and upfront discussion about how you understand what they are doing and that it is unacceptable to you. Expect them to deny ever doing any of the things you say they are doing or trying to turn the tables and blame it on you. However, continue to explain that you don't care for the way they are treating you and they must stop immediately. If they truly have any feelings for you as a person, they will change their ways. If they still refuse to respect your wishes, then it is time for you to re-evaluate if the other person really has any meaning to your life. Remember, anyone who does not support your growth needs to go! If lying is at the basis of the manipulation you're better off getting this person out of your life completely. This kind of leopard never changes its spots. Don't let him or her keep pissing on you with their stream of lies and deceits.

The master manipulative pissers will literally stoop to making threats. Some will say that they'll leave the relationship or friendship if you do not comply or try to through down major blame on you saying they cannot live without you which really means they cannot live without your *approval*. This behavior is difficult to counter but you can acknowledge their threat and see if they will really carry through with it. Many times, their threats are empty and they end up backing down and trying something else to get their way.

Believe this – you are *not* the only person they are trying to manipulate and piss on so get a clue here! Confronting a pisser may be uncomfortable but it is still better than remaining a pissee.

Perchance to Dream

In these contemporary times, dream symbolism has taken on a more psychological view which also tends to be the currently accepted world view. Nearly everyone today is familiar with the psycho-analytical work of Sigmund Freud and Carl Jung who basically both believed that dreams had their own language and logic based in the unconscious. Their personally approaches to dream analysis is where the psychological camp became divided with Freud an advocate of 'contra-desire' and free association symbolism and Jung who believed in 'sticking with the images' and their connection to the Universal Archetype only as they pertained exclusively to the life and experience of the individual.

There are all sorts of "Dream Books" on the market today ranging from serious psychological texts to the more esoteric brands. The psychological spin on the subject often lists common dreams and their possible 'conscious time' connections and meanings. For example, a dream of flying by one's own volition is a very common dream as is being naked in public or falling.

Flying dreams are generally pleasant or unpleasant but should this opportunity come up in the dream state it is not likely the dreamer will pass up being able to soar freely from one place to the next. Some of the ancients believed that the higher one soared in a dream the luckier he would be in his waking life... soaring to the heights so to speak. Modern psychology would ask the individual to define how he or she felt while flying in the dream and if those feelings in any way equated with a waking life situation. If pleasant, the dreamer would be asked if the dream equated with any conscious situation whereby the individual wished he or she felt as good as was portrayed in the dream. If unpleasant, the dreamer would be asked if the dream paralleled any life circumstance that was threatening triggering reticence to cope.

The being naked in public dream has had several meanings in the world of psychology. Freud relegated it to a waking need for exhibitionism based upon infantile tendencies and wishes for freedom. In the 1950's, Psychoanalyst Emil Guthiel expressed that he thought this dream revealed the dreamer's feelings of guilt or inferiority thus bolstering the waking sense of justification for personal shortcomings. Today this dream is thought to exemplify anxiety or worry over feeling vulnerable and being exposed particularly concerning matters of sexual prowess.

Finally, the falling dream and the misnomer that if the dreamer hits the ground he or she will die. Almost any practicing psychologist will tell you that they have spoken to many dreamers who have hit the ground in a falling dream and lived to tell about it! Nearly all also agree that dreams of falling are generally dreams relating to anxiety connected to loss or failure. In this case the dreamer is often asked about the part of the dream that precedes the fall and how that might equate with a conscious time situation.

DREAM THEMES

One thing that has remained a constant since ancient times is the importance of recognizing the main theme of a dream. This is easier to determine in some dreams more than others if the dream tends to have less tangents or minor frivolous details. To discern the theme of a dream and the subconscious wish it is helpful to record the dream in the following way:

- Jot down the dream "story" (try to keep down to a one page synopsis) during a time of the day when you are relaxed and undisturbed but do so within 12 hours. Some of the minor details may be lost but this is actually a help not a hindrance.
- Divide the dream into its parts or elements such as settings, people, characters, animals, objects, emotions, dilemmas, and actions. Don't forget to note any outstanding colors.
 Dream breakdown is done only to avoid overlooking something that may be important to analysis.
- Since you are actually one of the dream elements, note whether you had an active role in the dream or a passive observer role.
- Highlight the main elements of the dream.
- Ask yourself if any of the main elements relates to a recent event or idea in your life that you are currently struggling with or considering. Also allow yourself to memory associate to see if the dream relates to anything from your past.

Dream Theme Example


This was the dream of nice Hindu woman who for many years had been holding a serious religious occasion for her community in her home. This was an important event in the community which lasted a full week and ran a full 24 hours each day with people coming and going at all hours. It took tremendous planning for the religious aspects, food, lodgings, and entertainment. She and her husband were considered pillars of the community and her husband wanted to continue the event on an annual basis but she has grown tired of it all and needed a break. She expressed her wishes to her husband who was resentful and who kept arguing with her in an attempt to change her mind. The dream occurred the day after her husband expressed a vehement counter argument in favor of the festivities.

Summary:

"I (active role) was in my house doing my routine (setting) domestics when I became aware of a terrible commotion (action) outside. When I went outside I saw Shiva the Hindu god of destruction (character) tearing up the neighborhood destroying (action) everything in his path. He was jumping from rooftop to rooftop smashing and burning everything. Finally he landed on the roof of my house and I was very frightened (emotion) trying to figure out a way to get out." (dilemma) Dream ends.

After a brief analysis it was discerned that the subconscious wish was to be <u>free of the guilt</u> she felt by declining to host any further festivities. She felt trapped and was looking for a way out of the situation. She was also worried that she would be punished on a spiritual level because she was declining to do her duty and was concerned about losing face in the community. It just so happened that this woman's personal patron god was Shiva.

Once the dream was analyzed she felt better. She was able to reason with her husband who finally agreed to take a break. She spent the following year having her home repaired and painted. She was able to bring her subconscious wish to conscious fruition.


What is an intellectually sound person to do? If you decide to engage a "high nose" here are some tips:

Although this mind boggling query has obviously been dissected to the point of obliteration aka "kicking a dead horse," consider the following:

"In reality, the most astonishingly incredible coincidence imaginable would be the complete absence of all coincidence," says John Allen Paulos, professor of mathematics at Temple University in Philadelphia, and best-selling author of Innumeracy: Mathematical Illiteracy and Its Consequences. "Believing in the significance of oddities is self-aggrandizing," he adds. "It says, 'Look how important I am.' People find it dispiriting to hear, 'It just happened, and it doesn't mean anything.""

To the mystically inclined, however, coincidence is a synchronicity, the purposeful occurrence of two seemingly unrelated events. The argument is not likely to be resolved anytime soon. Of late, though, the phenomenon of coincidence has begun to yield new scientific insights. It turns out that we may actually be hardwired to connect anomalies in a meaningful way. Many of the remarkable feats our brains regularly perform—including our ability to learn the meaning of words or decode the unspoken laws of social decorum depend on our penchant for noticing coincidences. In fact, mathematicians, cognitive scientists and paranormal researchers are applying the tools of statistics and probability to tease out just where coincidences lie on the bell curve of everyday experience. ~ Jill Neimark Psychology Today

The Concept and Construct of Satan

At some stage in our esoteric lessons, we come to consider the need for clarity regarding a subject that has been greatly misunderstood throughout the ages – the concept of Satan or the Devil. The Devil is not a particular possession of the Christian faith and its origin is found in the remote past.

Some thought flow buoyed by history.

We'll keep it simple.

Consider:

In the Old Testament, Satan is mentioned only three times.

Zechariah 3: 1-2 – "Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him. And the Lord said to Satan, 'The Lord rebuke you, O Satan! The Lord who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you!"

Job 1-2 – Satan is presented as the tempter and adversary of God, plying him for the soul of his servant Job.

1 Chronicles 21:1 – Satan appears as the tempter of David.

These particular passages, scholars consider to be from the postexilic period dated later than 539 B.C. Historically from this, we can theorize that Satan did not stem from the period when the Jews were held in captivity by the Egyptians. Current thought then lends this possibility – that the idea of a force of evil equal to God may have been derived from contact with members of the Zoroastrian faith of Persia.

The Zoroastrian religion, based on the teachings of Zoroaster, holds that two gods, Ahura Mazda aka Ormazd, was the leader of the "host of light" and the source of all good while Angra Mainya aka Ahriman was a spirit of darkness and the source of all evil. These two constantly battle for control of the world and all of its manifestations. At the end of it all, it is believed that Ormazd, the god of good wins and defeats Ahriman, the god of evil.

Further along, when this concept came to Judaism it led to the creation of the Satan (Sa-tan) patterned after Ahriman the creation who stood in opposition to God who sought to ruin man and frustrate the purpose God had for man. The Hebrew word Satan literally means adversary or accuser. This particular creation was always inferior to God rather than a dualistic equal version found in Zoroastrianism.

When Christianity rose and at the Council of Toledo I A.D. 447, Satan was transformed into the concept of Devil which is Greek for slanderer by the Church.

The Devil gets his horns:

Yet here is a puzzle piece to consider: The Devil as understood by Christianity was a misunderstanding based upon ignorance regarding the true nature of Wicca and its traditional association with horned gods and priests. This was fostered during the medieval period when Christians happened to stumble upon outdoor meetings of Wiccans whereby a priest might be dressed as a creature of horns dancing around a fire as it had been done for centuries. Because of the teachings of the Church and some lively imaginations observers went back to their priests insisting they had seen Satan himself. Unfortunately, because these people could not read or write, they did not know *why* the Church came to believe in the Devil.

In contemporary times, some people still believe in God and Satan in a literal sense often using the argument that Satan's strongest tool is the use of non-belief in his power or existence. Some believe there is God but certainly no Satan.

Still others believe there is a foundation based upon the balance of the forces of good and evil with no constructed concept of the duality of God vs Satan.

"The problem of evil is one of our oldest intellectual conundrums. Volumes have been written attempting to define evil, to catalog its horrors, to account for its persistence, to explain its appeal, to confront its consequences. The moment we begin to ask questions about the nature of evil, however, we begin to understand how difficult it is to answer them. One way to start the discussion is to narrow the focus." ~ Alan Wolfe

How do you define evil? Is it merely a relative term that each person will define differently? When we review history, do we see concepts that were once considered evil are now acceptable?

Theologians will tell us that evil is the absence of God in our daily lives, a neat little umbrella term that loses some of its punch when these very same theologians, in the same breath, have a good degree of difficulty defining Divine Essence in general. Contemporary metaphysicians and philosophers will confidently claim that evil is a disturbance in the natural order of the Universe only to fall short trying to explain "what" the "nature" of the Universe actually is let alone what "order" constitutes. Science will tell us that evil is a by-product of some faulty cross wiring in our brains so we are then reduced to mindless madmen and women who are not responsible for what our minds are producing thus giving birth to the neighborhood rapist, the hell bent destructo-terrorist and even the covetous unethical politician who's helping to pass legislation to rob us blind.

Some believe that evil is divided into three categories - physical, moral, and metaphysical.

These following definitions are from the Catholic Encyclopedia:

Physical evil includes all that causes harm to man, whether by bodily injury, by thwarting his natural desires, or by preventing the full development of his powers, either in the order of nature directly, or through the various social conditions under which mankind naturally exists. Physical evils directly due to nature are sickness, accident, death, etc. Poverty, oppression, and some forms of disease are instances of evil arising from imperfect social organization. Mental suffering, such as anxiety, disappointment, and remorse, and the limitation of intelligence which prevents humans beings from attaining to the full comprehension of their environment, are congenital forms of evil each vary in character and degree according to natural disposition and social circumstances.

Moral evil is understood to be the deviation of human volition from the prescriptions of the moral order and the action which results from that deviation. Such action, when it proceeds solely from ignorance, is not to be classed as moral evil, which is properly restricted to the motions of will towards ends of which the conscience disapproves. The extent of moral evil is not limited to the circumstances of life in the natural order, but includes also the sphere of religion, by which man's welfare is affected in the supernatural order, and the precepts of which, as depending ultimately upon the will of God, are of the strictest possible obligation. The obligation to moral action in the natural order is, moreover, generally believed to depend on the motives supplied by religion; and it is at least doubtful whether it is possible for moral obligation to exist at all apart from a supernatural sanction believed to depend on the motives supplied by religion; and it is at least doubtful whether it is possible for moral obligation to exist at all apart from a supernatural sanction.

Metaphysical evil is the limitation by one another of various component parts of the natural world. Through this mutual limitation natural objects are for the most part prevented from attaining to their full or ideal perfection, whether by the constant pressure of physical condition, or by sudden catastrophes.

Thus, animal and vegetable organisms are variously influenced by climate and other natural causes; predatory animals depend for their existence on the destruction of life; nature is subject to storms and convulsions, and its order depends on a system of perpetual decay and renewal due to the interaction of its constituent parts. If animals suffering is excluded, no pain of any kind is caused by the inevitable limitations of nature; and they can only be called evil by analogy, and in a sense quite different from that in which the term is applied to human experience.

Say what??? You might want to read that again ...

Many times I'll hear someone refer to someone else as "evil" and this generally applies to the describer describing the described as evil due to actions based upon his/her particular belief system or personal philosophy. A popular tag line connected to this scenario is, "... that S.O.B tells lies and manipulates others into believing the BS peddling he/she is putting out there." Is this *really* evil? What if the person isn't cognizant of this evil-doing? Is this accusation warranted because it is not in accord with proper rational value structures? Let's say it is true; the persona lies and leaves a BS trail a mile long. Is this evil or is it a matter of irresponsibility?

If something is defined as evil, then the ways and means for eradicating it from society becomes legitimate. We know enough about history to understand how that statement plays out - Hitler blamed Jews. Once he had defined them as evil, his solution was to make them pay. Sin requires payment; when we falsely identify sin, we falsely demand a sacrifice for sin. Marx blamed capital and capitalists as the depraved element that polluted society. Marxist revolutions have thus tolerated every horror imaginable against these elements as cathartic for society.

Could it be that man is inherently good and evil is imposed upon him from the external?

Even if we surmise that evil is external to man, why good men are so susceptible and controlled by evil?

What about evil and malevolence? Are they the same thing? Most would answer with a resounding, "YES!" OR at the very least one was a sub category of the other. Both are conscious disregard for the welfare of others but does evil kick that whole concept up a notch? Think about it.

Can we actually define evil or are we only capable of coming up with a myriad of examples?



Something else, that I feel is absolutely relevant to us at this time, is the fact that when some people go in or are around the Pyramid, they get ill.


Science has proven that the human anatomy is light, at a foundational level.

What does your aura say about you?

Are you singing the blues today? Have you ever been green with envy? Have you ever been caught red handed? Are you feeling in the pink today? Has anyone ever told you that you have a heart of gold? Has anyone ever told you that radiated joy or had SUCH positive energy? Be careful because your aura can give you away!

Almost everyone knows that the human aura is an electromagnetic energy and light field that surrounds the physical body. This energy field vibrates with specific speed and intensity unique to each individual. Since color is defined as light vibrating at various speeds, the human aura expresses color based upon the physical, emotional and mental intensities that affect this speed.

Your aura is basically an extension of who you are and by learning more about your aura you can certainly learn more about yourself.

The human aura can be photographed using special computerized equipment that can measure the electromagnetic field. The image is caught on Polaroid film. The original "aura camera" was invented by Guy Coggins, (President of the Progen Company and inventor of the Aura Camera 3000 & 6000 and Interactive Biofeedback Field Imaging). Initially fascinated by Kirlian photography, Guy set out to find a way to capture the human aura on film.

Here is some background from Guy:

"I became interested in the "New Age" movement through Kirlian photography. I discovered that an aura camera had been developed in Russia in the 1930s that could photograph the energy-or corona discharge of your fingertips and toes. I was practicing meditation and yoga at that time too.

My interest is auras was mystical, spiritual, and scientific. It seemed natural to me to blend together what I knew from each discipline. I built my first Kirlian style aura camera in 1970... to me it just seemed like the most logical step to develop existing technology into a system that could show the energy field around someone's portrait. Aura imaging systems can help people see what is going on in their personal space, and seeing it is the first step towards making changes."

Guy goes on to say that he believes that hospitals in the future will employ a combination of surgical techniques and spiritual energy balancing. For example, future MRI (magnetic resonance imaging) will not only show the body but also the energy field around it in 3D on a computer screen. Along with the medical team, a holistic counselor would also view the energy to find out why you're hurting from a subconscious level. Finally! A complete diagnosis! Currently, biofeedback Aura Imaging technology can be used to measure biological changes which show up as Aura values but Aura Imaging has not been approved or recommended for medical diagnosis or therapy.

The colors of the aura are always in a state of flux due to "human" factors such as physical and emotional stress, feelings, body temperature and even spirituality. Each color expressed in the aura has a different meaning and can tell an individual quite a bit about their current health and "human status."

There are no "absolutes" in aura color interpretation and no two auras are exactly alike. A seasoned aura interpreter can determine the meanings of the colors and color combinations along with the meanings of spheres, balls, spikes and sometime objects or figures that appear within the aura or around the edges. They also examine the right and left halves of the aura to see if "manifesting energy" (right half) is balanced and matches "reserve energy" (left half).

I have personally heard some amazing things during aura analysis from a good aura interpreter. While observing a friend's session - she was not only told she was hungry and needed to go eat and drink something immediately before she dehydrated but was also told in detail about a shoulder injury that needed attention.

Here is a <u>general</u> guideline to aura colors that has been compiled with help from my aura interpreter (Sorry – she does not want her full name disclosed).

RED: A physical color that reflects vitality and stimulation. A large amount of red in the aura often indicates a person who is a mover and shaker with strong willpower, passion, and intensity. Dark red indicates overdrive, stress and/or anger.

ORANGE-RED: Shows extra confidence and a high degree of energy that can be used for creativity.

PINK: Sensuality and sensitivity are indicated by pink. The individual may be very artistic and also compassionate and loving. Clairvoyance is often a gift. Muddied pink can indicate dishonesty and immaturity.

ORANGE: Balance, harmony, creativity and playfulness belong to the orange aura. The individual is a great intellectual communicator often with a funky sense of humor and social skill. Murky orange can indicate uncertainty and self-victimization.

ORANGE-YELLOW: Intellectually creative with a penchant for detail. The individual is often a perfectionist with a scientific nature.

YELLOW: Power and high intellect are governed by yellow. The individual tends to be very goal oriented, analytical, independent and very stubborn.

This is also the color of joy and spontaneity. Pale yellow indicates that psychic awareness is starting to bloom. Lemon yellow indicates fear of losing control or respect. Muddy yellow indicates fatigue.

GREEN: Green shows affinity between the heart and soul and is often connected to healing. It also represents growth rebirth and change. Emerald green is often found in the aura of healers. Dark green represents feelings of resentment or blame, jealousy and lack of self-esteem.

TEAL or TURQUOISE: The individual is a natural healer who is sensitive and compassionate. This color is often found in the auras of therapists.

BLUE: Vision, imagination, creativity and spirituality are reflected in the blue aura. The individual is a "communicator with consciousness" who is trustworthy and willing to help others. Muddied dark blue indicates fear of self-expression or of speaking one's personal truth.

PALE BLUE: Indicates honesty, peacefulness, intuition and truthful communication.

ROYAL BLUE: The individual is highly spiritual following a Divine Path. Clairvoyance is finely tuned and used to recognize new opportunities that might have otherwise been missed.

INDIGO: Still waters run deep as do the feelings of the indigo individual. Universal awareness and psychic ability is prominent.

VIOLET: Indicates an extremely psychic individual with natural healing abilities. The individual is very mystic with deep spiritual understanding and could be a spiritual leader. The individual can also be very magical, idealistic, and futuristic.

LAVENDAR: High imagination and vision with a touch of daydreaming is indicated by lavender. The individual is often attuned to the "etheric" or "angelic."

SILVER: Physical and spiritual abundance are indicated by silver. The individual may in fact be wealthy or coming into money. Silver also indicates a Cosmic Mind that is receptive to new ideas.

GRAY: If this color shows up in the aura it can indicate health problems. It also signifies fear and stress which is contributing to ill health.

GOLD: A DIVINE color that resonates with wisdom and protection from a higher source. Golden auras are often referred to as "Christ Energy." The individual is in a highly spiritual state and is being guided by their "higher self." Gold encompasses, love, forgiveness, generosity and goodwill.

BLACK: Black is considered the absence of light. It draws light in and consumes it and in the aura it indicates that the individual is very unforgiving and might be harboring past life residual hurt and trauma. Some healers feel that black also represents negative entities trapped within a person's aura.

WHITE: A highly evolved being with the ability to focus spiritual and mental energy is indicated by white. Individuals with a lot of white in their auras often express boredom with mundane life and they sometime appear eccentric to others. This is because they are literally "tuned to a higher channel." White sparkles in the aura indicate the presence of angelics.

RAINBOW: Rainbows are multi-colored streams or stripes infiltrating or surrounding the aura usually around the hands, head or body. Natural healing ability is prominent. Some aura therapists believe that the individual might be a "starchild" experiencing their first incarnation.

MUDDY OVERLAYS: Dirty or muddy brown or gray overlays surrounding the aura indicate inability to "let go," insecurity, and guardedness.

The First Time

It was late March of 1988 when I got a call from one of my bandmates asking if I wanted to go with him to pick up a mutual friend. I said yes and we went. Our friend had tried to stop by another mutual friend's place to find him not home. The woman that lived in the apartment upstairs invited him to wait at her place if he wanted to, so he went up. It was from there that he decided to call this other fellow to get a ride home. We pulled in and went to the door waiting to be let in and going up the stairs.

Once there, we met the woman in residence and she invited us to sit for a few minutes in her living room ... so as to not be rude we did. As we chatted a bit, I looked around and noticed the books she had on a shelf under her television stand. There were several, all having to do with types of witchcraft, and a few titles specifically about sex magic. I had been a student of Eckankar for a little over a year by that time, and we well acquainted with some of the more negative types of spirituality that some pursue, and I became alerted after having noticed the titles of her books.

We continued talking as she went out into her kitchen saying she would be back with us in a few moments. Shortly she returned, but within just a few minutes of her coming back into the room, her doorbell rang. She went to answer it, returning with two other females. I could not miss how evenly things lined up now, especially in lieu of her chosen reading material. I knew that she had called two friends to even things out, so to speak. I already knew the intent they had, but that was never actually stated nor even implied. The three settled in the living room and there was nothing done at that point, no propositions or suggestions made in any direction.

One of the girls stood in the corner, where the doorway to the kitchen was. Then it happened. She simply dropped completely limp, quite suddenly and without any noticeable reason or cause, slid down the corner to the floor and collapsed forward between her legs. Then, just as suddenly, her head popped up and looked around at each of us. As I looked into her eyes I could see that it was not her that was looking out of them! Her body moved in a way that was completely unnatural. It had the appearance of a marionette, guided by the movements of the puppet master that held the strings. Hers moved in a way that made it obvious that the human was not in control of the body. Something else was however. She moved in a jerky sort of way which gave it that unnatural sort of appearance. Gone were the smooth movements of a human that knew how to control their form. The entity that controlled it at that time appeared to not be used to doing so, and to also not much care for it.

Then it spoke in my mind, and told me that it would kill me if I did not flee immediately, and all of my friends too.

Everyone there saw what had happened, but I suspect that even the woman that lived there and owned the books had no idea that this was going to happen, and she certainly was not in control of any of it. She looked as surprised as any of us did. At that time, my two friends were also students of Eckankar, so the three of us reacted inwardly in much the same way, and this way is one of the things taught on the path. I however was not satisfied, and decided to take things a step further. In my mind's eye I created a glowing sword made of Divine Love and attacked the demon that had threatened me. After a few strikes with this Sword of Love, it fled. My awareness of it ended there, because at that point she awakened again looking thoroughly confused about what had just happened, and asked why everyone was looking so strangely at her. No one really offered her any good explanation. I think the other two women were still consumed with disbelief and were unwilling to state to themselves what they had just witnessed, much less that any of them had any part in creating that situation. As the girl slid her back upwards in the same corner to standing, we three got up and excused ourselves, saying good bye and hurrying out the door.

On the ride home none of us said a word about it. We held our silence for another years before we three came to be alone in each other's company and someone asked if we remembered that time and situation. We quickly agreed that we had all indeed seen the same thing happen, each being relieved that we hadn't been hallucinating or been misled by something, and that we were not crazy because everyone else had seen it happen too. What we had seen was a full on physical possession. This was my first encounter with a demon in the physical world. I had before encountered disembodied entities on the Astral Plane, but never before something so present on this plane. This of course, was hardly my last experience, and they did not wait very long to start giving me further ones.

Possession is not what they make it out to be in the movies. The eyes will not necessarily turn black nor remain so. An entity will not necessarily be able to remain in control of a physical body for long periods of time either. All of these things depend on the person and the way that they think, and the choices that they habitually make. A lesser condition is that which I call ridden, in which an individual has one or more entities riding on them, doing their best to influence the thoughts and choices of that person. Whenever possible they will place thoughts in a person's head that contain strong desires, in the attempt to make the person choose to submit to the desire and go chasing after its fulfillment. The more this can be accomplished, the more control they are able to exert over the person. Things as simple as a desire for cigarettes or beer, which many have on a daily basis, to even stronger things like drugs, money and sex. One's true motivations are the key.

Negative entities require people of low moral standing that are willing to bend rules to allow their decisions. They begin by riding such individuals. Riding means literally riding on their back, but that also contains the figurative meaning within it as well. In these cases it is not a monkey that is on your back, though in time one might wish that it were. Over time a rider or groups of them on a single individual begin gaining ever more control while the person in question believes that they are making choices for themselves. This however is not the case, but the fact remains that they did make the choices willingly, regardless of how much they were helped in doing so. That creates karma for the individual which is not lessened any by the fact that entities exerted their will upon them. Over time their power and influence grow until it reaches the point where possession is possible. By that time the demon has started habit patterns in the person that makes it easier for them to remain within them than to break free of them, which allows an entity to use laziness against the person to remain in control.

Possession is not exactly the way it is portrayed on television and in the movies. There are limits on the time that an entity can spend in a body and keeping it under full control, and while it may seem unlikely, the individual's choice is the one factor that can cause them to begin breaking free of the demonic influence, but it is no small nor easy task to do so. It requires a great deal of commitment and fortitude to accomplish a complete ridding, or self-imposed exorcism, but it is by no means impossible to do. Having said all of that, merely to paint a broad picture that includes all of the various states and conditions within dealing with entities, it must be noted that free will never disappears, but it certainly can be dulled and with the use of addictive habits a complete complacency to change can begin, and it is that that is a demon's most effective tool to use to keep itself or themselves in control. Doing that keeps the home and the food supply intact so that they can feed as often as they like by causing reactions within the individual that lead them to specific actions and choices, which can tie him or her ever more tightly to the negative entities that live upon the individual, and this is also the reason it can be quite challenging to free oneself from their influence.

In the end it always comes down to the individual's way of seeing the world, other people, and certain actions or habits that they could take that puts them in the greatest danger of moving into any level of the progression of gaining riders to full on possession. The same ability to choose is exactly what also has the greatest effect to protect the aware individual from having such things occur to them at all. Rightful thoughts, choices and actions prevent it just as wrongful, lustful, desirous and selfish thoughts, feelings, actions and choices will bring them assuredly. The burden is on the individual as to what they will choose to bring into existence in their life. The positive or the negative, and each choice made has an effect, even if it is not easily noticeable right away. It exists and will certainly come to pass.

I have always protected myself whenever I go on an investigation and there was once that I think that I was protected from going on an investigation. The story begins with an investigation that was planned for a Saturday afternoon that was several hours away by location. I did not set up the investigation but was invited to take part in the investigation by another paranormal investigator. The background story that I was told was that the site used to be a plantation that housed many slaves most of who were killed on the property during the Civil War. I went to bed early because it was going to be a long day and I did not think that I would be home before 2 or 3 am.

It was around 6 am when I was awakened with the need to go to the bathroom and after I finished I went back to bed. Then at 7 am I was suddenly awakened feeling very sick. It was hard to sit up or even get to the bathroom. So for the next three hours I was so sick that I decided that I was not going to be able to go on the investigation. I called the investigator and cancelled and went back to bed. Then around 12 pm I woke up feeling really good like I had not been sick at all, no ill effects or fever. I knew that I could not get to the meeting point as I did not have the directions to the site of the investigation. I did not have any clue to why I had been so sick and then was suddenly feeling better. I did some work around the house, I had my meals and felt really good, now when I say I felt really good that includes not feeling depressed or guilty about missing out on the investigation. I was also in a very upbeat mood. On Sunday I contacted the investigator and was invited to look over photos taken on the site. I was also told that it was a 'really weird place' and that everyone who was on the team agreed on the way home that the place gave them the creeps.

The very next Saturday I met up with the team and they all had some interesting pictures - lots of orbs some of which were red. I did look at all the pictures and listened to each person's story of the investigation (most of the people that went on the investigation were hobby hunters and were not very objective).

So when the rest of the group left, I sat down with the lead investigator and went over the pictures while asking questions. I noticed that most of the orbs were dust but there were some shadows that were out of place. From what I could tell the orbs that were red were from the redeye light that some cameras have or from a laser thermometer that they were using to take temperature readings. Then I saw something that caught my eye - there were red spots on some of the pictures that were taken outside/outdoors. The lead investigator took several pictures that had these spots. The investigator said that she did ask the lady if she had seen the red dots before. She said that the lady got upset again and then asked who in the group had seen them. The investigator advised her that she had shown me the pictures but that I had not visited the site. The lady wanted to talk to me but the investigator advised her that she was the contact person for the group and it would not be OK to call me.

That night after we had talked, I had some bad dreams about the area that I had seen in the pictures. Then I felt a pressure like something was on top of me trying to push me through the bed. I could not speak but I was still breathing and could only scream in my mind. The pressure changed from holding me down - it seemed to get colder and smaller and was trying to get inside me. I could tell that I could not stop this by myself; it was like I could tell by the way it was starting to feel that my willpower was not enough. Just my telling it to stop was not going to work so I started to pray and ask for Divine help.

As soon as I started doing this, the feeling of cold stopped and turned into a feeling of pressure and then it was off me and I could move again. I sat up looking around my room and could see a shadow that was in the corner of the room where there was nothing to make the shadow. So I continued to pray and called for it to leave and to never return but now that I could move I said it out loud. I got out of bed and again in prayer demanded it to leave and never return. Then the shadow just faded away and the feeling in the room became more angelic. I turned on some light and looked at the clock and it was 3:05 am,* so I then got out my sage and smudged the room before I went back to bed. I did not turn off all the lights and did not go to sleep right away. I did not wake up till late morning feeling sore and drained.

I called the lead investigator later that day to see how the team was doing; they said that they all had a tough night with nightmares. I told them of my experience and said they should do a clearing also just like I was going to do and that any equipment that they had used on the site should be cleared also. Sometime later that year, I was talking to one of my personal spiritual mentors about the incident. My mentor believed that one of my guides or Angels kept me from going on the investigation because of what was there. My mentor thought that there were evil entities on the site and that because of the nature of the clearings that I had to do that it would have been bad to have gone there with the team. It would have caused more problems than actually happened and that the investigator's problems continued because of the contact with the lady. After talking with my mentor and doing some reading I came to believe that my mystery illness that morning before the investigation was to keep me at home. So my guides or Angel were trying to protect me from whatever was out at the site. It was my own continued involvement in the investigation after the fact that caused the attack. It is important to have protection when dealing with the supernatural and it is important to remember that the paranormal is not always 'Casper the friendly ghost' but something that may want to cause harm."



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Voudo

Voudo more readily recognized as Voodoo, is an African rooted religion. Its context varies from place to place and often includes other facets such as Catholic and American Indigenous traditions. It has no overruling body but is rather a community support system conducted to buoy individual experience and empowerment. It is also a survival focused belief system emphasizing healing and social accord with an ethical focus on combating greed and promoting honor. Types include Louisiana Voodoo (or New Orleans Voodoo), Haitian Vodou, Brazilian Vodum, West African Vodum, Cuban Vodú and Dominican Vudú. Despite the bad hype surrounding Voudo, it is a legal religion with very old roots.

Voudo is ancestor oriented so to the voudoist the transition from life to death simply means that those who have passed over from the visible world to the invisible world are still with us. In spirit form the ancestors are thought of as guardians and protectors who can inspire the living. In addition to ancestors there are also other supernatural beings known as Lwa or Loa with whom a practitioner will strike a relationship in order to get advice and counsel to assist with problems in the mundane world. Depending upon locale the personality of the Lwa will vary accordingly to the needs of the area. For example, the Yoruba 'Ogun' will carry the archetype of 'warrior' so a practitioner will adopt the warrior energy in order to get messages. Papa Legba is a popular and important Lwa as he is considered the gatekeeper between the worlds of the mortal and the Divine (similar to St. Peter at the Gates of Heaven). The Lwa are depended upon because the Supreme Being known as Bondye is considered unknowable and uninvolved by nature.

Like other religions, Voudo has an ordained clergy which includes both men known as Hougan (Doctor) and women known as Mambo (Queen). The community thinks of them as responsible people who can offer good advice.

On a higher spiritual level, it is believed that they can also be capable of self-actualization which means they can reach full potential through creativity, independence, spontaneity, and a grasp of the real world. Priests and Priestesses undergo long and serious training since some ritual includes possession of a Lwa. The ti bon ange (little good angel) is the container for the spirit of priest or priestess which protects it while the Lwa message is being revealed. The gros bon ange (great good angel) is considered the spirit that is shared with the living.

In general Voudo has been misunderstood throughout history starting with the racism connected to slavery. Voodoo came to the Americas a little over 250 years ago with the raids on the African Slave Coast began about 1720. It originated in the West Indies country of Haiti during the French Colonial Period.

In early America, when the country was undergoing much growth upheaval and political and social evolution, slaves were always held 'suspect' and what first was passed off as mere 'superstition' could end up with dire circumstances for followers and practitioners. Clergy was referred to as 'witchdoctors' and all practices deemed evil and sinful. In other places like Haiti, Voudo was successful and to this day is still highly involved in the culture and in politics. The success of Voudo in Haiti caused consternation in America and with European rulers who relied on slavery to make their enterprises successful so to denigrate it to the point of instilling fear in the populace served their purposes.

Most of the dire imagery connected to Voudo is courtesy of Hollywood and the media which took it to levels of debauchery and evil and only used to hurt others. In reality, even Pope John Paul II spoke of Voudo in the context of its fundamental goodness. He attended a Voudo ceremony in 1993. The intention behind Voudo is no different than the intention behind any other act. It depends upon the frame of mind behind the person who is wielding the energy.

Voudo dolls, snakes, magic and animal sacrifices also have much hype surrounding them. Good or bad (white or black) magic holds no distinction in Voudo.

Anything to do with the conjuring of evil is known as red magic. An evil Lwa possessing an individual who has conjured it will often display red eyes. It is the job of the Hougan and Mambo to stop any of this before it even happens. A Voudo doll in itself is neither a good or evil object. Its uses are complicated but for the most part benevolent. Items attached to the doll via pins are meant as an appeal to the spirits to bring good to the individual. In movies, pins are often shown to bring pain and distress to a 'victim' when in actuality that is not why they are used. The snake is a representative of the Damballa or Danballa a god of the Voudo pantheon. It represents old wisdom and not evil. The concept behind animal sacrifice such as the slaying of a chicken is meant as a way of combining the life force of the animal with the life force of the Lwa. It is not all blood and guts as Hollywood would have you believe. What most people do not know is that animal is cooked and consumed as part of the ritual. While this may still be offensive to some it needs to be put into the proper context away from the preconceived notion of evil.

Like other religions, Voudo has public ceremonies and fetes and well as private rituals.

MANJE YANM is a harvest celebration. It has no fixed date and depends upon the harvesting of yams.

FETE FOR A LWA is celebration to serve the Lwas and call upon them to help the community.

PRIVATE RITUALS include divinations and readings, spiritual baths to help the individual reach a goal or remove negativity, wanga which has multi uses for such requests as love, money, work or even revenge (against an evil perpetrator), Anvwa Mo used to send away enemies, Pwen Cho used to acquire a working spirit (this ritual is not practiced by all practitioners since it is considered dangerous), Mariaj Lwa – a marriage ceremony where an individual is married to a Lwa and takes on obligation to that Lwa, Lave Tet which is a head washing to increase psychic ability and magical power, Kanzo which is an initiation ceremony. It belongs to Haitian Vodou Tradition of the Asson lineage where secrets of the lineage are taught.

Black Moon

Nearly everyone has heard of the *Blue Moon*, a rare astronomical occurrence that happens when two Full Moons occur in the same calendar month. A lesser known astronomical rarity is the *Black Moon* which occurs when there are two New Moons in the same calendar month.

All of this is possible because the dual New Moons are associated with altered states of awareness, higher consciousness and collective wisdom. Try making a "Wish Lists" during the next Black Moon. Simply write down ten wishes during the eight hours after a Black Moon and keep it in a handy place where you can easily access it and read it at random times over the ensuing year. Many of the wishes should come true.



Magic of the Elements

Here is an induction into the magic of the elements.

Let's start with Earth element since it represents our home. Earth is stable, receptive, and feminine sustaining all life upon which the other three elements rely. It represents abundance and prosperity and allows all to use creativity in a practical and physical manner. It encompasses all of nature — mankind, animals, rocks, crystals, trees, and vegetation. The energy of Earth houses great strength, common sense, and practical wisdom that can be tapped for success. In magickal practices, Earth element is the grounding force keeping the Root chakra chord connected to Mother Earth. The elemental spirits of Earth are the Gnomes and Dwarfs.

Earth element rules the direction of North, the time of Midnight, and the season of winter. It governs the Zodiac signs of Taurus, Virgo, and Capricorn and the planets Venus, Mercury, and Saturn. Earth Elemental Magic includes garden magic, image magic, stone magic, tree magic, knot magic, and bind magic. Magical tools include the pentacle, salt, stones, cords, and images. All self-respecting Earth spirits carry pieces of emerald, jet, tourmaline, quartz (rutilated and tourmalated), peridot, onyx, jasper, azurite, amethyst, and salt in their magickal bags. When invoking Earth magic your arms should be extended with your palms facing downward. It would also be appropriate to wear Earth colors such as brown, green, and black/white in a check pattern. The goddess energies corresponding to Earth are Hathor, Ceres, Cerridwyn, Demeter, Gaia, Persephone and Rhiannon and the god energies are Adonis, Athos, Arawyn, Cernunnos, Dionysus, Herne, Marduk, Pan, and Tammu. These deities can be fun folk except for Demeter and Cernunnos who tend to be a bit bossy at times. Revered animals under the Earth element are the ant, bear, bison, bull, cow, deer, dog, gopher, horse, snake, stag, and wolf. Revered plants are cedar, cypress, comfrey, honeysuckle, ivy, grain, magnolia, patchouli, all kinds of nuts, and the mighty oak (favored by the Druids).

Fire magic can be pretty tricky since it manifests so quickly. It is highly masculine energy that is very projective and filled with hot primal urgency. The Fire elemental purifies, illuminates, and grants vision and self-knowledge to those who seek it. It amplifies one's personal Will and bestows a new sense of authority. Fire is physical and sexual tied to the blood of life yet also strongly linked to the Divine. It can be very healing or very destructive. Fire is connected to the Solar Plexus Chakra, the season of summer, the time of High Noon, and the direction of South. When invoking Fire magic, your arms should be over your head forming a triangle. You should be dressed in the colors of Fire, which are all the colors of a flame, reds, oranges, yellows, hot blues, and hot whites. You should also be wearing or carrying items made of gold or brass. The Fire magic processes include candle magic, storm magick, and time magic. The magical tools of Fire are the athame, candle, censer, herbs for burning, written requests on paper for burning, and the wand.

The elemental spirit of Fire is the Salamander and a magical bag should hold pieces of agate, bloodstone, carnelian, garnet, quartz, red jasper, ruby, and rhodochrosite. The Zodiac signs of Fire element are Aries, Leo, and Sagittarius. The planets are Mars, the Sun, and Jupiter. The goddess energies connected to the Fire elemental are Aradia, Ameratsu, Brigit, Freya, Hestia, Lucina, Pele, Sekhmet, and Vesta and the god energies are Agni, Hephaestus, Horus, Ra, and Vulcan. This is a lively bunch, especially at celebrations. Most tend to have hot tempers so it is never boring. Vesta is the most conscientious of the group since it is her job to keep the Eternal Flame fueled and glowing. Revered animals under the Fire element are the bee, coyote, fox, horse, ladybug, lion, lizard, phoenix, praying mantis, salamander, scorpion, and snake. The revered plants are allspice, basil, cinnamon, garlic, hibiscus, juniper, lime, nettle, onion, orange, peppers, red poppies, and thistle.

Always remember that the fertile Earth is warmed by the Fire elemental and aerated by Air, which aids plant growth.

That said, the Air elemental also produces projective energies like the element of Fire since it is also masculine. It is tied to communication and the intellectual mind and brings clarity, discernment, Truth, creativity, and higher consciousness to abstract thinking and the written and spoken word. It aids the memory, governs intuition, psychic works, telepathy, and meditation, and is connected to the Third Eye chakra. Air magic can be useful in finding lost objects usually by employing the help of the fairies who probably snatched the items in the first place.

The direction connected to Air is east, the time is dawn, and the season is spring. When invoking Air magic, your arms should be raised and your palms should be held parallel. If you would like to dress accordingly you may wear clothing of light hues that reflect the colors of Dawn such as lavender, white, pale yellow, light blue, pale pink, and shades of gray. The various forms of Air elemental magic are divination, concentrative techniques, prophecy seeking, visualization, and written spells. The tools of Air magic are the athame, censer, incense, and the sword. Ever hear the expression, "the Air was so thick you could cut it with a knife" spoken with reference to a tense situation? It takes proper communication and the appropriate use of words to modify these situations or to cut through them. When you communicate clearly and properly, you are using Air elemental magic to its best advantage by cutting through misunderstanding with your magical sword of skill!

The Zodiac signs of Air are Gemini, Libra, and Aquarius and the coordinating planets are Mercury, Venus, and Uranus. What's that you say...? Mercury and Venus are also Earth planets? Well that just goes to show you how well the Universe works with the elements supporting one another! If you want to create an Air elemental magic bag, be sure it contains amber, amethyst, citrine, fluorite, mica, and topaz. The goddess energies associated with Air are Aradia, Arianrhod, Iris, Nuit, Ostara, and Urania. If you are a writer experiencing writer's block, try calling on Urania to help you. She is a great muse! Ancient god energies associated with Air are Hermes, Mercury, Shu, and Thoth. Those of you who are paying attention are saying that Mercury and Hermes are one and the same. Well, you're right, it just depends upon whether you prefer the Greek or Roman definition.

The revered animals of Air are all birds, particularly the eagle and hawk, insects and spiders. If you fancy nature walks, learn how to pay attention to these animals, especially the spider, because some like to leave silken messages in their webs for you to read. The revered plants of Air are acacia, anise, aspen, benzoin, clover, frankincense, lavender, lemongrass, vervain, and yarrow.

The Water element governs emotions and our deepest feelings. It is receptive feminine energy and is tied to the Heart chakra. It is secondarily tied to the Third Eye chakra so it is easy to see why the Water elemental is connected to love, self-healing, sorrow, reflection, intuition, the unconscious, fertility, and regeneration. Along with Fire that warms and Air that aerates, the Water elemental nourishes the Earth with life giving fluids. The direction connected to Air is west, the time is twilight, and the season is autumn. When invoking Water magic, your arms should be extended with your palms held in an upward position.

The spirits of Water are the undines and mermaids. Water magic is often connected with the phases of the Moon and with the ebb and flow of the Earth's tides. Magical invocations are often conducted near the ocean or other bodies of water. Ceremonies may also involve snow, ice, or rain. If these natural settings are not available, mirror and magnet magic may be performed. The magickal tools of choice are a cauldron, chalice, or mirror. Magical clothing should represent the colors of water such as blue, blue greens, indigo, aquamarine, 'crests of the waves' white, and the shadowy depth hues of black and gray. The metals of Water are mercury (quicksilver), silver and copper. A magical bag should contain pieces of aquamarine, amethyst, beryl, blue topaz, blue tourmaline, coral, lapis, opal, pearl, and sodalite.

The goddess energies connected to water element are Aphrodite or Venus, Isis, Kupala, Mari, Ran, Tiamat, and Yemaya and the god energies are Dylan, Ea, Manannan, Neptune or Poseidon, Osiris, and Varuna. The revered animals are all the creatures of water including fish, sea lions, sea mammals, and sea serpents including the leviathan, shellfish, frogs, and turtles. Also included are cats, dragons, and sea birds. Revered plants are aloe, apple, catnip, chamomile, fern, gardenia, lemon, lettuce, lilac, lily of the valley, lotus, moss, orris, passionflower, rose, seaweed, thyme, valerian, water lily, and the willow tree.

Possessed by a Good Spirit

Are people only possessed by negative or evil spirits? If the devil can possess people then can God or an angel? The story of Mary Jobson has been the subject of a book or two or at least a chapter in an anthology. Her story is fascinating.

In November of 1839, at the age of 12 years, Mary contracted a most peculiar illness. In the beginning she complained of severe pain at the back of the head, her eyes were sensitive to light, she had a slight temperature, constipation and an irregular heartbeat. Her symptoms quickly grew worse eventually leading to convulsions that would ease up and then return. Mary was not able to swallow food. Her doctor and parents did what they could for the girl but all of this marked the beginning of strange occurrences that would last for almost 11 weeks. She was attended by several physicians during that course. Several physicians, family members and others who witnessed the events wrote their accounts of the happenings which can be found in *The Miraculous Case of Mary Jobson* by W. Reid Clanny M.D.

At first the family would hear rapping emanating from Mary's room but upon inspection, each time they found the child merely laying in bad with her hands at her sides. These knockings grew into poundings and finally what sounded like fierce explosions. This was accompanied by phantom footsteps, closet doors that opened and closed by themselves, water falling from the ceiling and melodious music coming from an organ that did not exist.

Then came the voice. It claimed it was using her voice as a "trumpet" and was the voice of God that should not be mocked. It further claimed it was a good spirit who would be lending advice to all who came to hear it and that Mary's possession was only temporary. It insisted that Mary was not harmed and that her spirit was not there and had left its physical form for a time.

Mary's father was not accepting this story and demanded proof. He asked for water to be dumped at his feet. It was and continued to be dumped until the room was soaked more than twenty times.

The human trumpet met with visitors giving out advice and at times summoned people to come to get messages that were important to their lives. They were subject to celestial music via organ and hymns and a disembodied choir. Often the voices of departed loved ones came through. According to author Brad Steiger in *Real Ghosts*, *Restless Spirits and Haunted Places*, who wrote a rendition of this story the voice said:

"Look up, and you shall see the sun and moon on the ceiling." Before the bewildered eyes of a roomful of witnesses, the planets appeared above them as celestial orbs of yellow and orange. John Jobson immediately set about whitewashing the figures, but he soon learned that the voice had intended its artwork to be permanent ... after several coats of whitewash the figures still remained visible.

Despite what the spirit voice had been saying, Mary's condition appeared to be diminishing and the attending doctor told her parents to prepare for her death. The voice however announced that on June 22, a miracle would take place and Mary would be restored. Mary's mother had laid out clothing as instructed and at 5:00, the voice told everyone to leave the room with the exception of Mary's two year old brother. Approximately 15 minutes later the voice instructed everyone to re-enter the room. They found Mary sitting in a chair smiling with her brother on her lap. All was well as if nothing had ever happened.

It is said that Mary grew up into a fine educated woman who was highly respected. There were signs or scars from the "good spirit" who never returned and it was said she very rarely got ill.

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An Astro Look at Master of Horror Stephen King

Everyone knows at least one book or movie that was written by Stephen King. Among some of the more popular cult favorites are "Carrie," a 1976 film about a teenage girl misfit with telekinetic powers who gets revenge on those classmates who torment her daily, by setting the whole town and school ablaze.

The 1978 novel "The Stand," which also became a television movie series, is about a post-apocalyptic battle between good versus evil, after a government experiment for a cure to the flu kills off almost all living people and animals, bringing forth national disaster and mayhem. There is also "The Dead Zone," a 1983 horror/thriller about a school teacher who after awakening from a seven year coma finds that he also has psychic abilities.


All of these books and movies mentioned above and many more are the product of King's dark and prolific imagination, as well as a testament to his many hours of hard work and dedication to his writings over the past 40 years.

He seems to be a fairly normal, intellectual, middle aged gentleman. He has been married for over 30 years to his college sweetheart and dedicated, loyal spouse, Tabitha Spruce King (also a successful novelist in her own right), and together, they have reared three very talented grown children, as well as being the proud grandparents of several grandchildren.

But what about the author himself-who is Stephen King really, beneath the successful author and family man image?

As an astrologer looking at his natal birth chart, this is where we will begin to explore the hidden forces deep within him and in his early childhood and young adulthood environment that helped to shape him into the highly regarded, award winning, prolific author of horror, science fiction, and suspense.

Stephen Edwin King was born at 1:30 AM E.D.T. on September 21st, 1947 in Portland, Maine, the second son to parents, Nellie and Donald King. According to this information, he is a Sun Sign Virgo, with a Sagittarius Moon sign and Cancer Rising sign on the Ascendant. When a person has their Sun placed in the sign of Virgo, this can indicate that their life path is one of some sort of service or healing to others. Stephen came in with a life purpose of healing through writing, educating, teaching and communication with others (Mercury ruled Virgo Sun placed in the 3rd House). He will tend to do this in a manner where he shines behind the scenes, away from the spotlight (Sun in Virgo, 3rd House cadent).



Stephen's 3rd house Sun is part of a stellium or group of planets that form a series of conjunctions to each other, augmenting the 3rd house focus on learning, teaching and writing. This grouping starts with the Sun placed at 27 degrees of Virgo, conjunct Venus at 2 degrees Libra, combining forces with Neptune at 10 degrees Libra, which also happens to be conjunct with Mercury, ruler of the 3rd house, placed at 15 degrees Libra, just minutes from the cusp of the 3rd house, but technically Mercury is placed in the 4th house.

With Mercury so closely placed to the 3rd house group, though, Mercury's energy is being pulled into that stellium and the group of planets together are acting as a concentration of his energy into the house of the conscious mind and every day routine. Simply put, if you want to know what someone is thinking a lot about and the quality of their mind, a good place to start is with the 3rd house and Mercury placements by sign and house. With this kind of configuration, you can be sure Stephen has a fine intellect and razor sharp mind that is quickly able to form perceptive impressions at lightning speed. He constantly reads and writes on a daily basis. These impressions form the basic core of his character and identity of whom and what he is in this lifetime. Stephen's mind tends to be very busy place, concerned with the creative expression of something artistic, beautiful, and balanced in shape and form.

This stellium will tend to influence how he expresses himself with others through writing and teaching. He is always focusing on new techniques of writing and communicating as well. Mercury is also favoring, through a sextile aspect, his 1st house conjunction of both Pluto at 15 degrees Leo and Saturn at 18 degrees Leo. Sextiles always represent some sort of beneficial applied opportunity in the natal chart. In this case, the 1st house conjunct of two of the most powerful planets in the zodiac gives a major clue that he will be influenced by fate and destiny (1st house can represent destiny and Pluto represents hidden, unavoidable forces at work, that shape his destiny). When we take a closer look at Stephen's Cancer Ascendant, and the 1st House Pluto/Saturn conjunction, much more is revealed about the circumstances and forces at work in his early years that has also contributed to who King is as a person today.

Stephen has the family oriented sign of Cancer placed at 29 degrees (Anaretic or karmic degree) on the horizon when he was born. Cancer is an intuitive, perceptive sign by nature. Cancer, the Crab is also a protective sign, with a tough outer shell, protecting the sensitive, tender skin beneath. Those with Cancer rising usually are very protective of themselves and family, can be very patriotic, and approach life somewhat sideways to get to a goal or purpose-but this sign is also noted for being quite tenacious when focused and will never give up or give in-a very determined sign indeed. Cancer rules the stomach and chest (breasts for a woman) and Cancer is not noted as being a very vital sign on the Ascendant, especially in childhood.

With Cancer as his rising sign, as well as Stephen's natal Sun in Virgo cadent, indicates his vitality is not all that it could be and that throughout his life time he must always be vigilant through healthy habits and routines. The Sun in Virgo indicates one of his weak spots could be his solar plexus/intestinal area and the Cancer Ascendant indicates the stomach or chest area in addition needs to be looked after carefully. His Ascendant is receiving a nice sextile from his Venus in Libra in the 3rd House, along with that same natal Virgo Sun in the 3rd-this probably helps to not only strengthen his vitality somewhat, but also indicates he is blessed with a certain kind of refinement and charming manner that most people would respond well to in his personal everyday contacts.

When we look into the 1st House conjunction between Pluto in Leo (sign of royalty, show business, children and creativity), where Pluto is considered at its strength, and Saturn in Leo, which is in its detriment, we see that most of what King has come in to learn about as far as life lessons go, is how to handle internal issues of self- control, transformation and empowerment through right use of power (Pluto) and lessons in self-responsibility, hard work, dedication and planning (Saturn). Pluto in Leo in the 1st House suggests that hidden circumstances around his birth and early years were intense, and that an issue regarding the abandonment of one of the parents early in life (Pluto also rules the intercepted Scorpio 4th house of a parent) would play a big role in how he saw authority figures and handled self-control issues. Pluto's influence over 4th house matters also hints at a lot of family secrets as well.

In 1950, shortly after Stephen's second birthday, his father, a merchant seaman, abandoned his wife and family. Steven's mother then assumed the role of supporting King and his brother through a series of menial, low paying jobs afterward, in addition to some support received through his mother's extended family. King learned great deal about the right and wrong use of power through this parental situation, as the 4th and 10th houses in a person's natal chart also forms what is called in astrology the family and parental axis, and Pluto rules over his intercepted sign of Scorpio in the 4th house. The 4th house rules over one of the parents as well as end of life circumstances, among other things.

King's mother, Nellie King, seems to have been dealt with more than her fair share of hardships. After her husband's abandonment, she became the sole means of support for King and his brother during the 1950's, a difficult position for a woman in that day and era. Nellie relocated often in Stephen's early childhood years in order to find work to support her children. She eventually relocated back to Maine when King was 11 years old, in order to take care of her own parents until their deaths. Afterwards, Nellie became a caregiver in a local residential facility for the mentally challenged for many years. She passed away in 1973 at the age of 59 in a hospice in Maine from uterine cancer.

This event likely occurred under the shadow influence of King's 1st natal Saturn Return, since King was 26 years old at the time. He also had gotten his first major breakthrough book with the publication of "Carrie." His actual Saturn Return date was three years later, in the fall of 1976.

Steven's mother, a very self-sacrificing figure in King's life, was born under the sign of Pisces; the planet of self-sacrifice, Neptune, is at 10 degrees Libra in King's natal chart; Neptune is conjunct within 2 degrees of his 4th house cusp at 12 degrees Libra. Neptune in King's chart also opposes his Aries M/C and rules his Pisces 9th house of higher education and publishing. This aspect alone speaks volumes about his mother's influence through her stoic sufferings and hardships on his financial and educational goals, in addition to his writing career. Often, when Neptune is found in a natal chart connected to or in the 4th house of a parent, one of the parents could have a health issue; usually some sort of a wasting disease can be indicated from this aspect.

A person with this aspect in their natal chart could also be losing a connection with the parent due to a health or mental issue as well. It could have been difficult for Stephen to see his mother in an objective light in addition, because Neptune's energy is more about confusion than clarity. The 4th house also represents the soul, so Stephen is likely to develop his compassion for all of humanity through some sort of personal sacrifice and service that he is uniquely able to offer through his own life experiences.

The patron planet of those that write, teach and communicate, Mercury, is also placed in Libra in his 4th house, conjunct Neptune in the 4th- this aspect is what indicates Stephen's ability to tap into his imagination on a soul level and communicate that back to the masses. Stephen, simply put, is gifted in "telling a good tale". Mercury rules both Stephen's Virgo 3rd house of writing and communication, as well as his 11th house of goals, wishes and dreams.

The planet Uranus, planet of genius and the unexpected, is placed in Gemini, the sign of communication and writing, in the 11th house of goals, hopes, wishes and dreams, is also inconjunct Jupiter in King's natal chart, which rules both the 5th house of creativity and children and co-rules his 9thth house of higher education, higher consciousness and long distance goals. Uranus itself rules his 8th house of other's resources, and endings, and co-rules his Capricorn 6th house of work and health, and the Capricorn 7th house of partnerships and marriage. This means that he is prone to having sudden financial changes, in particular in the arena of other people's money. These changes also affect his health and career. Uranus' influence was likely an issue when he first began receiving book advances for contracts for publishing his books. This means that he is prone to having sudden financial changes, in particular in the arena of other people's money.

In 1973, for example, Stephen received an advance of \$2500 for the book manuscript of "Carrie" which even by those monetary standards in the 1970's was not considered that much of a monetary gain. Later on though, when the paperback rights to "Carrie" were sold, he received \$200,000 dollars, half of the \$400,000 that was split with the original publishers. He had actually thrown the first few pages of the manuscript for "Carrie" in the garbage pail; he thought that the script was "too childish"; his wife fished it back out and encouraged him to complete it and "Carrie" became over time one of his best-selling stories, eventually becoming a best-selling movie.

At that point in time, the notice of this book advance was sent via telegraph, as Stephen, due to financial hardships, did not have a telephone at his place of residence, in a mobile home trailer park at the time.

The struggling writer was working at a local school as an English teacher at the time, as well as working odd jobs and selling short stories to various mystery magazines to help support his wife and small growing family of three small children. The inconjunct aspect between Uranus in the 11th house and Jupiter in the 4th house seems to indicate a need for an adjustment between his family (4th house) and his career goals (the 11th house). The planet Uranus, which also represents our urge to be an individual, is also receiving another harsh aspect, a square from the Sun in Virgo in the 3rd house. Sun square Uranus usually means there is a tendency to have issues with the father or authority figures, as well as foreshadowing sudden separations in his life from important males.

Since the Sun also rules his Leo second house of finances, he had a decision resolve the conflict about his finances (2nd House) and his goals and wishes (11th house). This inner conflict about his personal self-worth (second house) would have also affected his income, at times in a negative way. This inner conflict affects his sense of self or self-esteem, again causing him to likely alternate between being overly willful and prone to being abrupt and a decided coolness and detachment to others. The mounting pressures of struggling with finances, writing and balancing a career and family, began to take a personal internal toll on King during this time- in addition to dealing with a lot of insecurity, rejection and self-criticism. Virgos can be unduly harsh on themselves.

During this time, Stephen began to have a hidden drinking and substance abuse issues that lasted well over a decade. Stephen has admitted that he didn't feel he deserved to be successful in his career-he even went as far as to publish a series of books under a pseudonym of Richard Bachman in the late 1970's just to prove to himself that his success was not just a fluke of chance or fate.

This same aspect also means that the issues with nurturing would have also influenced his selection of a mate or partnership, and that he would seek a mate that was steadfast, supportive and endowed with down to earth qualities (Capricorn 7th house). Tabitha Spruce King, his wife of over 30 years seems to be match for those sterling qualities, and she herself is also a successful author and mother in her own right.

Pluto's influence in the natal chart of King is very strong, because not only is Pluto strengthened by being prominent by angle, maximizing the influence of Pluto and making it more obvious for the world to see, Pluto is also exalted by cosmic state, increasing its power to produce those things related to Pluto and the meanings related to those of the 1st house. In astrology, Pluto is the planet mainly known for horrible or terrible things, like filth, sewers, murder, violence, torment, and hell. Pluto derives these types of meanings because in Greek Mythology, Pluto was the god that ruled Hades or hell, the underworld. Pluto is known to represent hidden forces at work in the human psyche, like those that are involved in volcanic activity. Usually, wherever Pluto is placed in the natal chart, its influence is usually doing something hidden and subversive. This planet intensifies the qualities of Stephen's Cancer ascendant, and Pluto here also represents his need to be in total control of his destiny and life's purpose.

The first house of a natal chart reveals your outlook on life, as well as how you view the world. This house also shows how you may appear to others. With Pluto in this house, it makes him seem more intense, secretive and charismatic, like a Scorpio. His natal Pluto is also well supported by mostly positive aspects from it to his 3rd house of siblings and the mind. So, he is likely to have channeled this intense inner drive in a positive way, through his imagination and writing. Pluto can also represent compulsive tendencies and obsessive behaviors. King is the self-proclaimed "Grandmaster of Horror" and seems to have a fascination with fear, death and horrible things that terrify and go bump in the night. Stephen mentions in one of his interviews that he is compulsive about his writing, literally obsessed by it to the point where he would not sleep or eat that his wife has had to suggest to him to "give it a rest already, Stephen".

The influence of Saturn in his 1st house would also be a major factor in his early life. Often, Saturn in the 1st house denotes a difficult beginning, early in life. His early years were certainly reflective of that. Between the many moves and difficult financial circumstances that forced his mother to accept help from her family, it could not have been a very easy childhood at all for Stephen or family.

The 1st house of the chart also refers to the physical body. In Stephen's case, this seemed to show up as issues with frequent throat and inner ear infections, leading up to perforated eardrums and a loss of his hearing (Saturn in detriment conjunct Pluto in the 1st house).

Saturn rules the skin, teeth and bones, as well as the physical sense of hearing. Pluto references the immune system-Saturn conjunct Pluto probably indicates the suppression of his immune system to fight off colds leading up to the throat and ear infections.

Stephen's advice to aspiring future writers reflects the wisdom he has gained over the years with the passage of time. He says you must be disciplined, work hard and preserve through dedication. He himself sets a daily goal of 4-6hrs of writing time, as well as 2000 words a day minimum. Saturn also represents one's fears; he has a list of phobias from bees to enclosed places. One of his biggest fears is that he would fail at being a successful writer. During his lifetime, Stephen would want to watch his skin, bones, teeth, as well as his back and heart, and take good care of himself through nutrition and frequent physical checkups.

One aspect in particular that stands out in King's natal chart is his Mars placement in the 12th house in the sign of Cancer (Mars in detriment or bad cosmic state). One way this could play out is since the 12th house can represent your unconscious behavior from past lives and the 12th house represents your Achilles heel or weak spot, and Mars represents how well you use your energy; Stephen could unconsciously exhibit tendencies that do not benefit his best interests. He could literally be his own worst enemy. He could also have a tendency to put up a lot of protective barriers, especially about how he handles his anger or irritation (Mars). The 12th house is also a house of chronic health issues, so it could mean he needs to watch his stomach (ulcers or easily irritated stomach) or chest area (Cancer) carefully.

Mars co-rules his 4th house of a parent (Scorpio) as well as his Aries M/C. The Aries M/C also represents one of the parents or an authority figure, so his parental issues of abandonment by a parent affects his destiny and how he earns his livelihood. Aries on the M/C cusp also indicates he wants to be a pioneer in his profession. He likely feels that he has to go it alone in the world (that message is also being repeated by the lone wolf placement of Pluto in the 1st house). This also can indicate he only feels safe if he is in control, because of the damage done to his ability to trust at such an early age. Because Mars is so well aspected though, he is able to mitigate this circumstance and to put it to good use, through healing and writing in particular (Natal Mars in Cancer in the 12th house of hidden matters sextile the natal Virgo Sun in 3rd house).

When looking at his chart, it should be strongly noted that he does have extremely positive, helpful influences in his natal chart that are protecting him from some of the more negative aspects.

He has 7 trines in his natal chart; 3 of which form a major Grand Fire Trine to the M/C-both Pluto and Saturn in Leo in the 1st house of self and destiny trine his 5th House Moon in Sagittarius-this trine completes the circuit to the life path and world at large, represented by the Aries M/C.

The Sagittarius Moon helped him with his popularity with the public (the Moon influences the public and rules his Cancer Ascendant, how he comes across to others). This Moon is very nicely aspected in his chart-he has a great deal of sensitivity and in this case the Moon reflects the light of his soul (the Virgo Sun) in a philosophical and insightful way (Moon in Sagittarius). This Grand Fire trine means that he has a gift of inspiring and encouraging others to challenge themselves to be their personal best. His natal Sun in Virgo is also trine his North Node in Taurus. This means that his life purpose (North Node) is all about building financial security and what he values in life (Taurus North Node).

Stephen also has 7 sextiles, which show that he has still had a life complete with more opportunities, more than the average person. He still had to exert the effort and hard work to receive the benefit of those sextiles; the difficult aspects and life circumstances he encountered helped him to see their worth. A good natal chart usually is a blend of challenging and difficult aspects; together these forces help to develop character in a person and bring wisdom and knowledge, because one is able to go within themselves to correct their mistakes.

Stephen has Jupiter, the planet of happiness, prosperity and bounty ruling the Sagittarius 5th house of enjoyment, creativity and children, placed in the 4th house of home, family and the later years. He has now found happiness through his family and children and grandchildren, and is better able to enjoy sweet success in life in his golden years. Though he officially retired in 2002 from writing, he still continues to write and has passed this legacy on to his own family (two of his grown children also write successful novels in their own right).

When asked by an interviewer why he writes, he responded "The answer to that is fairly simple- there was nothing else I was made to do. I love writing and I was made to write stories and I love to write stories. That's why I do it. I can't imagine doing anything else and I can't imagine not doing what I do." He is also asked often why he writes such terrifying stories and he answered with another question "Why do you assume that I have a choice?" His natal chart shows very clearly that his destiny was to write, for his muse of inspiration was both terror and fear. And now he doesn't have anything to fear anymore.



The Ecstasy and the Reality

In some esoteric circles it is believed that what mystics see and feel while in their ecstasies is so disengaged from everyday reality there are no words to describe them. What of the everyday Joe? Is a person who experiences episodes that defy nature in fact truly being shown another reality or realm or are they merely being tricked by their senses?

The human mind is a powerful agent. The annals of psychiatry hold numerous cases of seemingly normal people who have experienced 'tactile' hallucinations. They have seen, touched, heard and smelled and communicated with solid forms which acted as solid forms blocking out light and casting reflections. 

More interested in intellect and projection than spirituality. Emotions Line (2-5-8) Average. One who may inhibit or repress feelings for one reason or another on various occasions. Effectiveness Line (3-5-7) relatively strong pulse. Has administrative resources but should set limits. Communication Line (1-5-9) relatively strong. Has trouble communicating with the SELF.

Missing number pulses indicate areas of energy of which an individual was unconscious of when given their name after birth. President Trump has no missing number pulses.





Astro-Tarot: How to do an Annual Reading

I always like to get a yearly forecast astrological chart done for my birthday but I love an annual Tarot reading as well. Since it is very difficult to be unbiased about your own reading I find it helpful to have a reading done for me but in addition to that I like to do the Tarot Wheel layout. I lay twelve cards around in a circle and they represent the houses of the zodiac, after I liken the card to the energy of that house I may want more information so I throw another card on top to expand on that first card. Some cards may not draw you in and so it is not necessary to explore them. This is a good thing since we don't need that much drama in the course of a year. Here is the Astro-Tarot model in case you want to do a reading for yourself.



This is very basic and if you like you can use a good astrological book to expand on the meanings of the houses.

First House - Aries, the house of the self, the physical body and how you are viewed

Second House - Taurus, the house of possessions

Third House - Gemini, house of communication

Fourth House - Cancer, house of foundations and home

Fifth House - Leo, house of creativity and sex

Sixth House - Virgo, house of service and health

Seventh House – Libra, house of marriage and partnership

Eighth House - Scorpio, house of death, legacy and taxes and regeneration

Ninth House - Sagittarius, mental exploration, adventure

Tenth House - Capricorn, house of career

Eleventh House - Aquarius, house of hopes, wishes and friends

Twelfth House - Pisces, house of secrets, spirituality, self- undoing

Start on the left hand side with the First House and Aries and lay the first card there continuing around the wheel until you come to the Twelfth House and Pisces. Combine the meaning of the Tarot card with that of the Zodiacal house meaning. For more clarity on a particular house position just lay another card across the original card. This will give you more insight to the information gleaned or even show you an obstacle that you can work through for that month of the year. I like to record the cards that I have chosen and reflect back on them through the year. The card would speak to that particular month but say you are working through health issues or financial issues they can be very similar (that is where the crossing card can be useful.)

Last year I did this reading and even though the cards were all very different they had a medical feel to them. Sure enough it was one of those years I spent dealing with small things that could have been big things if I had ignored them.

The cards and my astrologer were saying, "step up and deal with this or you will really pay for it later." It feels so good to take care of these personal things so we don't have to spend time worrying about them later. That is what the Tarot does for me. It not only gives me a heads up, it's like a kind mother supporting me in taking care of myself.

How many people do we know that don't take care of personal business either because of cost of service or just not wanting to deal with it? As the old saying goes, "to be forewarned is to be forearmed." It couldn't be truer.

The Tarot will make you see what you would rather not see but show you a way into the Sphinx ... and the way out.

There are so many decks out now, they speak to every race, religion, and even sexuality so grab a deck and a close friend or a bunch of friends and settle in to do some readings. Budding readers can share information and see different decks and deep connections are formed in a close group. In most instances readers are into other things they can share at these events like numerology, color therapy, astrology, energetic healing, Reiki, Emotional Tapping for Freedom. It's not all about divining what is going to happen it is about showing that person a way out of the problem. Emotional issues take some training and people with severe problems should be advised to consult a physician.


A Castle for All Time

Using a magnifying glass and metric ruler I scaled the image up to fit a 4 ft. by 6 ft. piece of plywood. I used acrylic house paint because latex paint dries too slowly, so while waiting a few minutes for one area to dry, I was able to jump to another area and keep painting.

The post card had sky, mountains, trees, water, and a ton of architecture so having had a three year course in architectural drafting gave me the background for perspective and scaling. I had a couple of courses in photography and that helped me with mixing the colors and blending. I paint what I see, not what I think. I paint using photo realism. I am not an impressionist — impressionist painting can be done in just a half an hour. Detail and realism takes weeks, months and years. The Castle painting took every bit of 8 months to finish, one stroke at a time, 6 hours a day.

My inspiration for *True Spiritual Awakening over the Grand Canyon* was a photograph depicting the pride of the southwest – the way his face was lit up. It made me think of the southwest Grand Canyon and a sunrise over the canyon. I painted it on interior double doors which were not removable.

I painted lying down on the floor, painting sideways for more than a couple of weeks, then sitting in a chair painting the shoulder and face using airbrush and single brush strokes. The paint was interior latex wall paint. I used the five basics — black, white, red, yellow and blue. I taught myself through trial and error — mix and remix until I got the color I needed. In approximately six weeks (I never really kept track of time) I was totally immersed in trying to figure out what to do next and learned as I went along — "on the job training" as the military puts it. Since the doors were in constant use, the paint on the door knob kept wearing off otherwise you would never know it was hidden in the cheek of my subject.

This is a painting I did from a photo and it is rendered on canvas. Instead of using a camera to capture something, I paint it instead. I had painted an almost identical painting on plywood years before with ducks flying overhead and a seaplane landing.

Most people associate writer H.G. Wells with stories of the fantastic and futuristic but during the years 1918-1919, Wells wrote the *Outline of History*, a serious and accurate account of the world. The book is an immense epic which augmented itself, "as Wells contemplated it." The *Outline* was destined to undergo many revisions that spanned 50 years through the continued efforts of Wells son G.P. Wells and colleague Raymond Postgate.

The *Outline* begins with the beginning...Earth as we know her from a scientific perspective. In the first chapter, Wells discusses the process by which the Earth came to be - a solid mass forming five thousand million years ago that took another thousand million years to cool off enough for water to emerge. Every species of living things is always adapting itself more and more closely to its conditions which are always changing. There is no finality in adaption. There is a continuing urgency towards change.

And in accordance, we find from the Record of the Rocks that there have been long periods of expansion and multiplication where life flowed and abounded and varied, and harsh ages when there was great weeding out and disappearance of species, genera, and classes and the stern lessons by all that survived."

One may merely shrug his or her shoulders and argue that Wells was only talking about the ancient history of the Earth leading up to the present time but, Wells the visionary, also mused about an *Outline of History* that branched out to 2031 AD. What impact would it have on the reader who pulled it off some long forgotten dusty bookshelf? What would be written in the records about war, changes of climate, expansions, depletions, and all who survived by that future date? Mother Earth and Mother Nature are close sisters who work together in unpredictable and unknown ways according to a higher plan. We all chose to be in Earth School at this time. We learn from all that has transpired and will transpire on both the earthbound and collective levels. We adapt to the changes and continue to adapt until our Earth experience is finished. The changes that have underscored our lives become another recorded chapter in the Record of the Rocks that will serve as prehistoric information for others to read in future times. Those in the future will continue to physically adjust and spiritually accept ad continuum for there is no finality to adaption ... just a continuing urgency towards change.

I was born to fly ... literally.

When I was a child I would spend a good deal of time sky-watching and cloud- gazing. From my perspective of a blanket spread out on the lawn, I would be entertained for hours watching cloud pictures transform and change. I have literally spent a whole day watching clouds. I will change my location often to get the most impressions. I also talk to the clouds and ask questions especially about something I want to know. I simply close my eyes, formulate my question and ask. Eventually the clouds will take a form and then it is up to me to discern what that formation means.

For example, if I see a cloud dragon I will make note of what kind of dragon it is.

Is it:

- An Asian dragon?
- A medieval dragon?

- Is it calm?
- How is it adjusting its shape during my observance?

I allow my psyche to make spontaneous connections.


To date I have been told:

- I was one of the Magi at the birth of Christ (to which I replied, "Holy Sh*t! ... Which one?"





DA Roach: you already said that


Lucifer Satana Magix: F*CK U Roach
