Contemplating Frosty The Snowman

(1) All of your experiences that determine how things appear to you; (2) the state of being actual or real; (3) the state of the world as it really is rather than as you might want it to be; "businessmen have to face harsh realities."

Human Nature:

(1) The shared psychological attributes of humankind that are assumed to be shared by all human beings; (2) the sum of qualities and traits shared by all humans.

At the basis of all these definitions is subjectivity. If *reality* is based on our own personal perceptions, and *real* is something 'possible' to be treated as fact and *human nature* presumably reflects a collective consciousness, well, then where does that leave us?

Just as everything has yin-yang opposing aspects, in order to know what's "bad", we have to first know what's "good". Of course, the converse is true, as well - in order to know what's "good", we have to know what's "bad".

So, that leaves us with defining "human nature" from a moral and ethical standpoint.

And the question becomes "Why have the shared psychological attributes of humankind, assumed to be shared by all human beings, taken on a negative connotation? Why has it become societally acceptable to behave in amoral and unethical manners?"

"Any time we are confronted by an event that is inconsistent with our core beliefs, we will likely feel some level of stress. In fact, a long-used psychometric for measuring stress is the Holmes and Rahe Stress Scale. Most of the items on this scale represent a change in a person's life that is known to lead to some amount of stress ... The important thing to keep in mind is that there is a continuum between "positive" and "negative" so not all changes are easily codified as good or bad. In fact, other psychological factors (such as one's temperament, mood, and global IQ) can affect how a person codifies a change along the positive-negative continuum ... Because new information bothers our brains, we tend to find friends and form groups that reinforce our beliefs—whether they're correct or not. When many people agree, it's easy to discount the opinions of others in the face of undeniable logic. This occurs because of a phenomenon known as the illusion of asymmetric insight."

Further, according to writer David McRainey:

"The illusion of asymmetric insight makes it seem as though you know everyone else far better than they know you, and not only that, but you know them better than they know themselves. You believe the same thing about groups of which you are a member. As a whole, your group understands outsiders better than outsiders understand your group, and you understand the group better than its members know the group to which they belong."

And on and on it goes. The bottom line is that each of us is responsible for our own selves. We can choose to be gullible and lazy or we can embrace the new changes that are upon us and use discernment when choosing our battles. It is very unlikely we could really "change" anyone else for, "A man convinced against his will is of the same opinion still." – Benjamin Franklin

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Is There Reincarnation?

When I first questioned reincarnation, having been raised in a religion which did not believe, I prayed and meditated for a long time. I suggest that you do the same thing and then read the following. It is what I was lead to in an answer to my prayers. It did not all come at the same time. Allow no man, including myself, to instruct your belief. I believe the Truth is in the Bible and if we with an open mind search for the Truth, trusting our God who lives in, with, and through us, the Truth will be shown. Place your faith and trust ONLY in that TRUTH!

It must be remembered, the Jews have always believed in reincarnation. That is part of their belief system. If you search, you'll also find the Christian religions believed this too until about the 14th century when the council of churches decided it would be better if this was no longer taught. Picture yourself as being the Savior sent by God to a people who believed in reincarnation. If you knew that this was not a truth, would you not have, at least once, told them so? He said, "Neither hath this man sinned," (knowing the man would have had to live and sinned prior to his birth) "nor his parents..."

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The History of Stellar Healing

And in choosing a name to take the place of the one discarded, he joined the words which expressed his religion of Life, Light and Love. Aten means light. To indicate to his subjects that he was a Brother of the Light, he called himself Akhenaten, meaning Living in the Light." ~ Elbert Benjamine aka C.C. Zain, Hermetic Scientist, Occultist, Astrologer, Naturalist

Defying the Priests of Shadow ...

The priests of Amen had grown to be the strongest group in Egypt. They had vast holdings from levying tremendous financial tributes and with this stockpile they built magnificent temples at Luxor and Karnak. They were dark by nature and said to be influenced by the Lower-Plutonian or Lower Astral forces. Cunning and inverse, they easily compelled the people to do their bidding which including loyalty to perverse doctrines and religious ceremonies, prostitution and murder.

Akhenaten, originally known as Amenhotep IV ascended the throne at the age of 13 following the death of his father in 1375 BC. He realized from the start how totally dominated his people were with the Shadow Priests of Amen and their corrupt magical rites and rituals. The Sun God Ra was universally venerated by the public, and the dark priests ever mindful of political power cleverly joined the name of Ra to Amen so they would be sole representatives of the newly created deity Amen Ra. The young king, surrounded and guided by these priests, remained orthodox in his faith to Amen Ra until he turned 19 years old.

Spies and assassins pervaded the huge temples at Karnak and the young king knowing he could not combat the dark forces that so permeated the area decided to move the capital and take with him those who he felt were willing to learn the true power of Nature, live constructively and defy the power of the Shadow Priests. With his entourage, he sailed down from the River Thebes to a point he felt would best serve his needs about 160 miles above Cairo. There he founded the City of the Horizon. Many joined him in his quest for new spiritualism, the suppression of corruption and freedom from ignorance Akhenaten had no use for war, vengeance or fear. Egypt would be revolutionized.

The Brethren of Light ...

The symbol of Ra that was worshipped in the time of Akhenaten was a gold disc representing the Sun. Akhenaten perceived something more behind the physical symbol – he perceived an all-pervading intelligence. From his studies of the rolls in the Library Tahuti, he learned and taught the constructive use of astrological knowledge. He also taught the use of art and beauty and any ennobling activity that he felt the mind could channel advantageously. Spiritually, the doctrine of hell and eternal punishment were no part of his teachings, rather, he focused on happiness during and after a given lifetime. He built a superior culture whose religion was the Religion of the Stars also known as the Devotion to Light.

Stellar Healing ...

"Among other things, he created a new art, Stellar Art, and developed a method of treatment, Stellar Healing. All the essentials of this Stellar Healing are set forth in sufficient detail in the language of symbolic pictograph in his Stellar Art, so that were there no other source of information available to us on this subject it would be possible to learn it from the many pictures he has left." ~ C.C. Zain

The general idea or premise of Akhenaten's Stellar Healing via Zane can be summed up thus:

- Planetary energies reaching man not only map his character at birth, but exert definite influences over him, at times which can be predetermined, throughout the whole of his life. This is pictured by the rays descending to certain parts of the bodies of human beings.
- The physical environment by which he is surrounded, each item of which is also influenced by planetary energies, also exerts an influence upon man. To what extent his physical influence opposes or cooperates with the planetary energies operative at a given time must be ascertained by observation of the physical environment. This is pictured by the various objects by which human beings in the pictures are surrounded.

- The events and conditions which are present at any given time in an individual's life are the offspring of his character as it exists at the time, energized by such planetary energies as then reach it, and acting upon the available physical environment, which influences both the trend and the importance of what occurs. This is pictured by both rays and objects adjacent to human beings.
- The amount of control which an individual can exercise over what takes place in this life at a given time depends upon two factors whose relative importance constantly varies, but which on average are about of equal power: Upon his ability to energize and modify in the desired direction the factors of his character which respond to planetary energy; and upon his ability to select physical environmental conditions which offer little resistance to the events he desires.

A true Renaissance Man of Healing and Mental Alchemy...

Akhenaten was ever mindful that a diagnosis in of itself no matter how well realized, offered no help to humanity... it merely was just an indicator that a condition existed and was present. He knew that for an individual to benefit from diagnosis he must know what to do to change the condition and then do the thing which would make the indicated change. The Light or "Aten" to Akhenaten and his followers not only represented an all pervading deity but also the whole inner plane environment. All those thousands of years ago, he grasped that the inner plane and its forces can only contact the physical plane through energies travelling at the velocity of light. So, Akhenaten basically devised the system whereby the electromagnetic energies of the "healer" could be used to gather up and transmit to a patient the planetary energies as were necessary to temporarily change character or the thought structure of a patient. In essence, it was a form of mental alchemy... thought structure to enable the overcoming of afflictions.

In both diagnosis and in healing, Akhenaten gave equal weight to the influence of planets and the influence of the physical environment. He did not feel that a condition of the physical body, for example, coincident with lack of proper diet could be corrected merely by proper thinking. Nor did he believe that proper diet without a change of thinking would bring health. He did not believe that attention should only be given to the factors of one plane; but that the power of inner plane energies, such as those of thoughts and the planets, and the resistances of the physical plane, such as those exercised by people and objects should be given equal consideration. His Stellar Healing methodology modified the desires of thought cells and the resistance of the physical environment to bring about a desired outcome as well as alterations to the Soul.

Stellar Healers combine mental healing with the use of planetary energies which are permitted to flow through their bodies as a conduit to the astral form of the patient. Stellar Healers are natural healers who develop the ability through which planetary energies flow in large volume. Actual touch is not necessary because the energy flows at will. Akhenaten understood astrology and was able to discern the inner factors of disease from the horoscope of an individual and knew that energy healing could be administered specifically to cure disease and health crisis. The pictures he left us included use of color, music and thought to enable the Stellar Healer to tune in on the particular planetary energy needed.

According to Zane's interpretation:

- The electromagnetic energy of the healer which passes from his hands to the patient.
- The astral vibrations of a planet or planet, which the healer is tuned in on and which pass from his hands with the electro-magnetic energy to the thought cells of the patient.
- The thoughts and mental images in the healer's mind which direct the electromagnetic energy and planetary energy to the accomplishment of the specific healing job to be done according to disposition in the patient's chart.
- The electromagnetic energy must be guided by the astral energy.
- The healer must visualize the color of the planetary energies and saturate the body of the patient. When viewed from the Astral Plane this color is vivid and intense.
- The tonal vibrations of the planet (s) are used as musical accompaniment.

Akhenaten believed that man should control his life and destiny to the end of contributing his utmost to "Universal Welfare." The degree of success depended upon the degree of which man could energize and modify the cells within his Soul in the desired direction and the degree to which he was able to select a physical environment that would facilitate the modification of these cells to bring about desired conditions and good health.

Interview with Dr. Bernie Siegel

His surgical training took place at Yale New Haven Hospital. Your powerful book, *Love, Medicine & Miracles* has helped so many people what part does faith and attitude play when it comes to healing?

Faith in yourself, your doctor, your treatment and your Lord can bring you peace of mind and with that your ability to heal is increased. I know people who have left their troubles to God and had their cancers disappear and others who think God is punishing them. So understanding what true faith is and that your attitude also changes your body chemistry are important factors in healing. Some prayers are not answered when we are at full term and it is time for us to be born again and commence a new and authentic life.

I understand you have had a near death experience. Would you describe what happened?

When I was four years old I was home in bed with one of my frequent ear infections. I took a toy telephone I was playing with and unscrewed the dial and put all the pieces in my mouth as I had seen carpenters do with nails which they then pulled out to use. The problem was that I aspirated the pieces and went into laryngospasm. I can still feel my intercostals muscles and diaphragm contracting forcefully, trying to get some air into my lungs, but nothing worked and I was unable to make any sounds to attract help. I had no sense of the time but suddenly realized I was not struggling anymore. I was now at the head of the bed watching myself dying.

I found it fascinating to be free of my body and a blessing. I never stopped to think about how I could still see while out of my body.

I was feeling sorry my mother, who was in the kitchen, would find me dead but I thought it over and found my new state preferable and intellectually chose death over life.

Then for no apparent reason the boy on the bed vomited and all the pieces came flying out. He began to breathe again and I was very angry as I returned to my body against my will. I can still remember yelling, "Who did that?" My thought as a four year old was that there was a God who had a schedule and I wasn't supposed to die now. So an angel apparently did a Heimlich maneuver on me is the way I would explain it today.

Do you believe our time on Earth is predestined?

I really do believe there is a schedule we create unconsciously because of later life experiences. Twice I have had my car totaled by people driving through red lights and once I fell off our roof when the top rung on my wooden ladder snapped off. In none of these incidents did any significant injury occur to my body. Someone told me it was because I had an angel and he knew his name. I asked what it was and he asked, "What did you say when the ladder broke?" I said, "Oh Shit!" He said, "That's his name." I will add he always shows up when I call him in an impassioned way.

Why are so many people, distressed, depressed and worried these days?

It is because most people do not know how to deal with life's difficulties. Life is not unfair it is difficult. Parents, teachers, clergy, doctors and others rarely teach us how to confront problems and see that they can be redirections, gifts and blessings as they make us more complete human beings. 70% of high school students have considered suicide. We need to be taught how to eliminate what is killing us and not ourselves. When God closes one door further down the corridor another will open and if it doesn't use the window.

What is the best way to overcome anger and resentment? How do you forget a painful past?

There is appropriate anger and it is in defense of one's self and one's respect. You can love the other person but not like how they treat you. Submissive patients do not do well. You can abandon your past and use the energy to redirect your life rather than waste your life's time with anger and rage and resentment. Then people are still injuring you because of your thoughts. So accept you are here for a limited time and that you are in charge of what you think and move on.

You said troubles can be a blessing in disguise, it doesn't seem like that when we are going through tough times, will you expound on this?

As my mother said, "It was meant to be. God is redirecting you. Something good will come of this." If you had a flat tire on the way to the airport on 9/11 would you be upset about missing the plane? We do not consciously know the future so stop picturing the worst and keep an open mind. By living in the moment as children and animals do you change the future?

You were founder of *Exceptional Cancer Patients*, which has helped so many. Tell us about this.

As a surgeon I couldn't cure everything. I care about people and it was a painful experience which our medical training ignores. A patient of mine said to me, "You're a nice guy. I feel better when I am in the office with you but I can't take you home with me. So I need to know how to love between office visits." I was amazed at how few patients responded to my letter to help them live a longer better life by coming to a meeting and basically what I learned was when you helped people live they didn't die when they were supposed to.

You have helped so many people heal their lives, tell us about YOUR experience with famous healer Olga Worrall.

I had injured my leg training for a marathon. It was very painful and not responding to rest or therapy. At an American Holistic Medical Association conference Olga was a guest speaker. My wife told me to ask her to heal me. I was embarrassed to ask and very frankly a non-believer. Never the less my wife pushed me forward and Olga sat me down in a chair and placed her two hands on my leg. The heat from her hands was incredible. I remember putting my hands on the opposite leg to compare the heat sensation. There was no sense of warmth from my hands coming through the dungarees. When Olga was done I stood up and was completely healed. The pain was gone and I could walk normally. Another time Olga and I spoke at the funeral of a mutual friend. After the ceremony we were standing in a deserted hallway when she asked, "Are you Jewish?" I said, "Why are you asking?" "Because there are two rabbis standing next to you." She went on to tell me their names and describe their garments, which included their prayer shawls and caps. Her description of them was exactly what I saw in my meditation and imagery sessions when I had met these figures while walking on my path.

Another evening after I gave a lecture, which felt like someone else was giving it and I was simply verbalizing it for them, a woman came up to me and said, "Standing in front of you for the entire lecture was a man and I drew his picture for you." Again, exactly the face and features of my inner guide. I still have the picture hanging in our home."

What part does laughter and optimistic thinking help in healing?

I was criticized for saying these things were therapeutic and blaming people for being sick, which is not what I was saying. I asked people what was going on in their lives to understand why they might be sick now. Studies show that loneliness affects the genes which control immune function, and that cancer patients who laugh live longer. Just laugh four times a day and watch how it makes you feel and the reaction from the people who hear you laughing.

What is your belief on reincarnation?

I was telling a friend about how busy I was and she said, "Why are you living this life?" Her intention was to get me to slow down and travel less but her question sent me into a trance and I immediately saw myself with a sword in my hand killing people. My first thought was that I had become a surgeon in this life to use a knife to heal and not kill.

I spontaneously went into a trance again a few days later and saw myself living the life of a knight who killed because he feared his lord and what he would do to him if he didn't carry out his commands. I killed my wife, in this life, and her dog and was devastated by the experience. But at the same time it revealed to me why my wife's face has always had a hypnotic effect upon me and why I am so involved in rescuing animals.

Ultimately it taught me about having faith in the true Lord and like Abraham, Jesus, Moses, Noah and others to understand that what our Lord asks of us is for the greater good and that if I had said yes I would have not been asked to kill anyone.

You believe animals are a phenomenal and frequently untapped source of innate healing? Can you give some examples?

Animals are more complete than we are and excellent teachers. When in doubt WWLD; ask yourself What Would Lassie Do and see how it changes your life. Petting animals raises bonding hormones and helps our relationships and animals show us we are more than our bodies by how they live with afflictions.

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One study showed that if you had a heart attack and went home to a house with a dog the 12 month mortality rate was 5% while in a house without a dog it was 26%. They understand they are here to love and be loved and teach us about forgiveness. One of our cats disappeared when a door was left open. After several weeks with no sign of her I was sure she was killed by a predator. A friend I had made, Amelia Kinkade, is an animal intuitive who lives in Los Angeles. We live in Connecticut and Amelia has never been to our home or near it. I pestered her to tell me where the cat was and one day I received an email, without even sending Amelia a picture of the cat, and it detailed the house, yard, other animals and people who were involved in the cat's life. The next day I went out and found the cat exactly where Amelia said it was hiding. She told me in the email, "The cat is alive because I can see through its eyes."

If that doesn't make me a believer nothing will. I totally believe that consciousness is nonlocal and not limited to the body. I also have experienced this through the drawings and dreams of patients I have cared for which allows them to know their diagnosis and what the future holds for them. As Jung said, "The future is unconsciously prepared long in advance and therefore can be guessed by clairvoyants."

I believe it is this unconscious awareness which we each bring with us when we are born. So I do not believe we literally live many lives but that we bring with us the experience of previous lives. Thus the wiser we get the better the future will be for those who follow us.

You have touched so many lives all over the world what are your predictions in the field of health and well-being in the years to come?

I hope we will see medical education become more humanized and related to caring for people and their experience rather than just treating a body and a disease. Hopefully doctors will be trained in communication so their words do not become swords. I also think we will stop trying to kill diseases and fight wars and focus therapy on healing the body and resisting illness. However, if children are not brought up with love they become selfdestructive and invalidate the system.

How does one deal with adversity, the loss of a loved one, a pet, a job, their home etc.?

Read my book *Buddy's Candle*. What is the point of grieving endlessly? What would your loved one want for you today? See your life as a labor pain and rebirth yourself when change occurs. When you finish school your graduation is called a commencement and not a termination. So keep beginning.

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In 1978 you began talking about patient empowerment and the choice to live fully and die in peace, you embrace a philosophy of living and dying will you share this with us?

When people grow up with love their living and dying are not about failing but about experiencing life. They live their authentic life and so save their lives and when they tire of their bodies they can die surrounded by loved ones and not alone at night, which most people do in the hospital, feeling like a failure and guilty. Life is about our connections and relationships and the only thing of permanence is love. It connects the living and the dead.

Do you believe in visualization?

Definitely; your body cannot separate the actual from the imaginary. So visualize a successful operation and you will have a more rapid recovery and shorter operation due to changes in your body. Think about chemotherapy as the devil giving you poison versus a gift from God to save your life and watch the difference in side effects which occur.

Do you feel that there are no coincidences?

Elisabeth Kübler Ross said that all the time because Carl Jung said, "The future is unconsciously prepared long in advance and therefore, can be guessed by clairvoyants." We create our futures. I work with dreams, images and drawings and people draw their past, present and future in their drawings and experience them in dreams too.


Where do you stand on reincarnation? Do you believe in life after death?

I have had a near death experience as a four year old choking on a toy I aspirated so I know we are more than our bodies because I left my body and was watching myself die. People born blind who have this experience are amazed when they can see when they leave their bodies. My belief is that our consciousness exists even after our bodies die. So we are affecting the future by how we live and the message we pass on to others. I believe we are all born with an awareness of what those who precede us experienced so I do not believe it is me repeating things but that I am aware of what has preceded me and that affects my lifestyle, relationships, choices and even the profession I choose.

I was born in raised in Vermont. I still live here in the same house with the same haunt. I say haunt and not a ghost because the experience only happens on a particular date and only if it snows heavily. I was told by the 'specialists' that this experience is an environmental residual haunt or an area haunt such as what happens on certain battlefield sites at certain times.

The house was originally an old farmhouse built in the early 1800s. It had been renovated many times and occupied by many families. Like many old houses it had seen good times and bad times ... especially on any February 24 - 25 if there was a heavy snowfall. The first time my family experienced it was in 1966 when a storm dropped about 17 inches of white terror in a short period of time.

We were always well equipped for storms as the power usually went out – food was stocked, lanterns filled and there was plenty of wood for our old woodstove and fireplaces. That year grandpa was staying with us and he was always well versed in local lore. I remember him originally telling the story when I was about 5 and he reveled in it but on this night he was more somber and kept checking the window. He turned around, winked at us and said:

"In the Wintertide when the snow runs deep –

The payment due will be reaped -

Better stay warm within your bed -

Lest the axe dispatch your head."

Of course the story had its own legend to go along with those words. The house was originally built by an older 'gentleman' farmer for his young wife who was with child. What he did not know was that the child was not his child but was sired by a young buck from town who his wife had been having an affair. On February 25, the farmer was returning from town with supplies trying to make haste to beat an upcoming storm and to confront his wife about the gossip he had heard in one of the local bars. The horse's hooves hit the frozen ground with a series of heavy thuds as he pulled his creaking wagon up to the front of the house.

Leaving the supplies in the wagon, the farmer shoved open the front door in a state of bluster and immediately began a fight with his wife. She of course denied the whole affair not wanting to give away her secret plans to run away with her beloved later that evening while the old farmer slept. The old man did not let on that he knew of her plans and pretending to let her go to bed in peace. He told her he would shortly join her. Instead he began plotting a trap for the nemesis who would come for his wife.

Pretending to have fallen asleep in a chair by the fireplace in the parlor, the wife bustled around quietly in the bedroom and then waited anxiously by the bedroom window for her lover. He was to arrive around 1 AM where she would let him in through the backdoor by the kitchen. He would them proceed to shoot her husband dead. They would mess up the proper rooms to make it look like murder/robbery and leave.

As the snow quietly fell she could see her lover at a distance approaching the back the house. She peeked through the parlor door to see her husband sitting in the chair by the fireplace or so she thought.

Her lover approached the door and as she opened it to greet him she saw his expression change. Blood began to pour from his head as he fell forward towards her – blood soaking her clean frock and coat. At the doorway stood her husband with an axe. She began screaming – her voice echoing through the thick woods behind the house never to be heard. She was still screaming as her husband dragged her from the house.

The story ends there because no one knows where the farmer and his wife went or what happened to them. The lover's body was found the next morning by a visiting neighbor who needed to borrow a horse from the old farmer. Bloody drag marks could be seen on the floor from the back vestibule to the bottom of the door frame. The snow and wind and apparently taken care of anything else. There were no tracks going anywhere. Nothing was taken or missing – not even a horse.

The authorities were brought in and not much was filed except for the fact that a body had been found. Any records that survived time were burned up in a court house fire twenty five years later.

So did it really happen or was it a local legend? There is no way I believe it did not happen because on that snowy February 24th early evening in 1966 we were all made distinctly aware the sound of horse hooves when there could not have been any. We all just laughed and blew it off as 'snow sound acoustics'. A little past 1:00 AM on February 25 we were awoken by a loud scream and the sound of something being dragged across the floor by the back door. We all heard it and nothing could explain it.

All we had was grandpa who was nodding and smiling.

Bah Humbug

One night after Thanksgiving, I was watching TV and the movie "A Christmas Carol" came on and I half watched it and half daydreamed about my own situation. I read the book by Charles Dickens in my youth and have always enjoyed the old black and white movie. The first ghost in the story was Jacob Marley and his first appearance was as Ebenezer's familiar door knocker. This is when the light bulb went off in my mind for my article. This story has the ghost of Christmas past, the ghost of Christmas present and the ghost of Christmas future. Of course, I would not want to forget Jacob Marley's ghost for he is a big player in many different ways. In no way do I intend to retell "A Christmas Carol" but would like to talk about some types of ghost and entities that often times are mistaken for ghosts.

Jacob Marley was the first ghost that visited Ebenezer Scrooge in the story so let us first look at his appearance as a door knocker. How many of us have seen a face in a cloud, in the mist or in the smoke of a camp fire? In many ways, this is similar to the way the first ghost appears in the story. There are many different views on this phenomena and one is that our eyes are playing tricks on us. This is to say that we are letting our imagination put a face in the smoke because of a trauma or some other subconscious reason. Another view could be that there is a ghost trying to contact us and they only have the energy to manifest in this way. Knowing the way Jacob manifested next would lead me to believe that the ghost was priming the witness to be able to see him.

It seems that a lot of times before you see a full apparition you will get glimpses of the ghost... this is to get your attention without using up a lot of energy. It is like clearing your throat so that what you're going to say is heard but on a visual level. If you question, "did I just see that?" you are giving your subconscious more control over your conscious mind and in doing this you are opening yourself up for the experience. This is not the same thing as having a séance and asking spirits to manifest. It is akin to being open to trying a new food that you have never eaten before without any predisposition of how it will taste. You could have only this type of experience but in the story, this was just the first unworldly encounter.

The next ghost was Jacob Marley again but this time as a full body apparition with the ability to communicate with Ebenezer. This is rare for a ghost to been seen and be heard at the same time because the energy level to do this would be off the scale unless the witness was a spirit medium. If you were an investigator and were told this story with all the visitations, you would want to question Ebenezer to see if he had any similar experiences when he was younger to see if he was a medium. Oops, once an investigator always an investigator. Let's get back to the story...

The story then describes the reason for the ghost of Jacob Marley coming to Ebenezer as a warning and to let him know of the visitation of another ghost that night. Considering Jacob Marley was seen and heard would lead me to consider that he was not a ghost but one of these other types of entities: Spirit Guide, Angel, Demon, or even an Elemental. From my research, I have found that many times one of these four has been mistaken for a ghost in some instances that were thought to be hauntings. A ghost involved in a haunting for the most part is not there to help - they are just there because of the history of a person, place, or thing. This is not to say that a spirit of a family member will not be around you in your hour of need to console you and guide you in your life. In an alleged haunting, you would consider the account of the witness and if you could not question him or her, the account statements would have to be the only evidence. The statements made in the story lead me to believe that Jacob Marley was not a ghost but a Spirit Guide that was sent to aid Ebenezer to change his direction in life. He was sent to let Ebenezer know the errors of his ways and to pave the way for the "others" that were to follow.

The next two ghosts were the ghosts of Christmas Past and Present and in their own ways they were more guides that ghosts. The ghost of Christmas Past showed Ebenezer how he was happy and loved early in his life. It showed him a time before he had let his greed for money ruin his life. This opened the door for the next ghost. The ghost of Christmas Present then showed him the struggles of the people around him and how he did not notice this or help. Both of these ghosts were guides because of the fact that they took Ebenezer out of his room and out of his body to his past then to the present to other locations where he could not interact with his surroundings. I have spoken to several people that have had an out of body experience and they had a guide there to help them to understand or to reach a turning point.

In the story, Ebenezer did not have any control of his out of body experience which leads me to believe it was a guided experience and he had no recourse but to get the message. Part of the message was that he had some control in his life to help others like he used to do when he was younger. The presence of these two ghosts or guides led up to the last visitation in this "night of ghosts."

The last ghost in the story was ghost of Christmas Future. This ghost is depicted as Death or the Grim Reaper and it did not have any conversation with Ebenezer at all. In the story, the ghost of Christmas Future is the strongest contributor in making Ebenezer change his ways. The ghost that takes on the appearance of death has a sense of finality about him and brings the visitation of all the ghosts to an end. If the story was an actual event and if you considered each visitation separately, this one would be the most significant due to the fact that Christmas Future provided a possible destiny that would come to pass if Ebenezer did not change his ways. He did not provide him with anything to work for but something to fight against. This is a classic Spirit Guide or Angel encounter where they don't show you how to avoid a problem that you are headed for, rather, that there is a problem that you are heading for if you don't change or take action. Sometimes they will show you things to work on for your own spiritual growth or to prepare you for an event without showing you the outcome. For the most part, you will not get the whole picture of the event and what you will need to do to make it happen.

We do have free will and as the name implies these entities are guides and their job is to guide you or to point you in the right direction. If you look at the progression of the visitations that Ebenezer experienced, it is possible that it was just one entity that visited him taking on a different guise for each part of the lesson that he needed to learn. When dealing with the paranormal events you must look from many different points of views to discern what is really happening. If an event like the one depicted in the story "A Christmas Carol" happened today and I was asked if this was a haunting I would say no. Looking at what was stated in the story it is more likely that there was a spiritual intervention happening to help rather than a haunting. From my own personal experience dealing with my Spirit Guide, its appearance is part of the message as with this story. I hope that in this article you become aware that all the things that are labeled as ghosts might not be ghosts. Also - when we look at things from many different points of view and not just jump to one conclusion there are lessons we can learn. Always aware that down the hall between the last two bedrooms the entity stood guard, watching and waiting. For what, we were not sure.

We were no threat, yet we felt we were uninvited and forever intruding. It dared you to walk down the hall. It knew we could feel its menacing presence. Massive shoulders, arms crossed. Feet spread the width of the hall, nearly as tall as the ceiling. Other than brow-beating us, we were generally left physically unmolested...that is until the week our father passed, some eight years before now.

I always slept in the last room on the right. I never entered that room without feeling I was being watched. The night after we buried our Father, I was drawn toward consciousness from a deep sleep. There was a growing pain from the back of my throat. Coldness became evident when saliva dripped from the side of my tongue onto my cheek. It was at that split second I realized the pain was from my tongue, which was being pulled out of my open mouth. My jaw and lips were not in any way touching my tongue. The fireplace is the source of energy that makes these rooms the heart of the house. It is built from large, heavy fieldstone pulled from the very land surrounding it. A double-sided hearth, it is so massively heavy, it had to be laid on virgin soil under the house foundation. Soil to chimney, it stands some twenty feet in height. Inside the house I can walk all the way around it, being eight feet deep from hearth to hearth and twelve feet wide. The children loved to play hide and seek; round and round they would run and laugh.

Later that evening, I had finished packing for the night and was talking to my sister from Atlanta on the phone. The wind picked up and it began to rain. I could hear tiny ice pellets tinkle lightly on the eight foot picture windows. I noticed my dog (all six pounds of her) looking straight up at the ceiling next to the fireplace as she began to bark. Odd, but dogs can be at times. It was then I felt a new energy move swiftly into the rooms surrounding the fireplace.

I knew instantly angels had just entered directly opposite the house from where the entity brooded. Not meekly did they enter, but with real fanfare, signaling their presence. And we all knew without a doubt they were God sent and with loving intent. The dog continued to bark, wagging her tail with great vigor and happiness. She licked the air as the angels came down came down to pet her little furry head. Then I knew for sure I had made no mistake when the dog stopped dead still and cocked her head to one side. In retrospect I figure it was too haunted for anyone to stay. Jet loved to wander over there daily through a gap in the fence between the two yards and chase chipmunks and squirrels and dig up holes for whatever reason struck his cat fancy.

Jet showed up at our back door one afternoon as usual waiting to be let in. I pushed open the door but he was busy toying with something shiny on the doormat as if he was trying to knock it into the house. The object was small and shiny – a small golden rectangle all covered in dirt. I picked it up and walked to the kitchen sink to wash it off with Jet fast on my heels. He jumped up onto the drain board and sat there watching as I washed it off. A little soap and water revealed it was a tie clip that appeared to be quite old and also appeared to be genuine gold with a fancy engraved monogram of MRJ. Once all the grime was washed off Jet seemed to lose interest in it and wandered off to his food bowl. I dried it off and left in on the window sill above the sink and returned to my household chores forgetting all about it.

The first night we had the object in the house, my husband and I were awoken three times by water running in the kitchen sink. There was nothing wrong with the sink or the faucet that we knew and that was confirmed the next morning by my husband who had checked it out completely right down to the seals. Of course hanging around the sink for two hours of investigation, he noticed the tie clip that I had completely forgotten about. He studied it for quite a while and decided to take it to an antique dealer he knew to have it appraised and to see if it had any value. A few hours later he came home exclaiming that the clip was indeed made of gold and a bonafide antique.

The tie clip was placed in a small jewelry box and tucked away in a dresser drawer until we decided what to do with it.

On night two the activity heightened. Again we were awoken but this time by objects on top of the dresser (that held the tie clip) falling off onto the floor. While I was picking the items up my husband proceeded to the family room area to address what sounded like a large crash and breaking glass. He came back and announced that the large family photo portrait we had hanging over the fire place had fallen off the wall and broken. Again, not necessarily anything paranormal about a picture falling off a wall except that this one did not land in front of the fireplace on the floor. It had landed across the room in front of a large window. The window faced the neighbor's backyard.

After review the next morning we decided we had gotten to the point where we couldn't write some of these things off as natural occurrences so we decided to run a little investigation. We did not have much by the way of equipment back then but we did have a video camera and a couple of recorders. That afternoon I followed Jet out to the neighbor's back yard to see where he was digging or snooping and I snapped a few photos with my old cheap camera just for good measure. The rest of the day was normal and we went to bed as usual.

During the night around 3:03 AM we thought we heard the front door open and close, then someone walk through the house to the kitchen and exit through the back door. My husband got up to check armed with a baseball bat but found no one there or outside and nothing in the house disturbed. He checked the video camera and saw it was running fine as were the recorders so there was nothing else to do but go back to bed and try and sleep. We would check any findings the next day.

What we found was unnerving but none-the-less exciting. Although it was very hard to see, we could make out what seemed to be a dark figure move through the family room and them vanish. There had been a full moon so that aided in what was filmed because light had filtered in. The recorders were even more thrilling. At around a recorded 3:04 AM we could make out what seemed to be a man's voice saying, "Help ... find it."

The next morning we brought in a professional investigator who had been mentoring us to review our findings. After checking through everything thoroughly we all went next door to inspect the neighbor's yard then all went to town to a quick develop photo place and also to a local historian.

The photos did not reveal much except for three consecutive pictures on the frame that showed a strange blob of light near a hole that Jet had dug up. The historian proved to be much more interesting. She told us that the original house had been built by a very wealthy man for his family in the 1920s. The 13/4 vibration in numerology is thought to bring spiritual insights into expression and into form through regeneration tearing down the old and becoming new.


The Druids who favored odd numbers because there was always a middle or balancing number would have looked to the number 7 as the balancer since it lies at the center of the other six numbers on either side of it:

Pendulum Divination to Test Food

All of us have had an experience with food or drink that does not agree with us. Sometimes the food itself may have been ill-prepared which causes us physical distress but distress can also come from the chemistry of the food that is simply not in harmony with one's vibrations.

The first step in using a pendulum to check food and drink is to know which way the pendulum swings or gyrates to indicate yes or no or in this case, positive or negative. You will be holding the pendulum about 2 inches from each food tested. If the pendulum swings positively the food is fine for that day and if it swings negatively find something else to eat. I have tested some foods that were negative for me repeatedly so I eliminated them from my diet and was better off for it. It's all trial and error.

If the pendulum "stays" and won't move the food being tested will be fine on some days and not on other days. It is best to test that food on another day.

It may seem a bit of a nuisance but you will need to separate each food you are planning on eating by placing the portions on separate clean plates. For example is you are planning to eat a lamb chop, broccoli and potato, place each one of these on a separate plate then go ahead and run each individual test. You will want to check the food *before* you cook it to see if it vibes with you personally on the day you are planning to eat it. I often get an argument about this because people will say that cooking removes impurities. This is true however what you are seeking is if the food you have chosen will agree with you vibrationally on the particular day you are testing it. It might be fine for the day you have chosen or it might be better for another day. I have also been asked if frozen food can be tested. It can but you will need to remove the packaging.

It must always be remembered that no food is either good or bad per se – it is about whether it is good or bad for you. A pendulum used correctly merely reflects the Cosmos working in conjunction with the practitioner – diving means to connect with the Divine - so heed your inner voice as the pendulum has shown you!

It just might help to spare you a stomach ache.

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Picatrix

A short time ago while perusing for information on some long forgotten obscure data, I came upon a rather intriguing pitch for the *PICATRIX*. The *Picatrix* is a classic of occult literature written sometime in the ninth century by an, "anonymous Arab wizard in North Africa or Spain, and credited in the fashion of the time to the notable Sufi and scholar a-Majriti and originally titled *Ghayat al-Hakim*, 'The Goal of the Sage.'" ~ Translators' Introduction

In essence, *the Picatrix* is THE Occult Classic of Astrological Magic Complete. Whether or not I am a scholar of Astrology is irrelevant. The pitch had caught my attention - right down to the fact that it was blatantly revealed that to even own a copy of the *Picatrix* that merely sat on a bookshelf and nothing more did not stop the power of the book from causing strange and amazing changes and occurrences in the owner's life! It was touted as NOT being politically correct and was even said to affront the modern reader. It even carried a warning and disclaimer!

Damn if that wasn't one of the best C.Y.O.As I have ever seen!

WOWZA! Now I HAD to have it! So I purchased a copy that had been translated by Renaissance astrologer Christopher Warnock and the Arch Druid of the Ancient Order of Druids in America, John Michael Greer. I had hit the proverbial arcane jackpot!

Like so many works of Arabic occultism, the *Picatrix* eventually found its way to Europe and was translated into Spanish and Latin at the court of Alfonso the Wise, King of Castile in the year 1256. At that time it was renamed *Picatrix* – a name that to this day evades attempts by scholars to figure out what the blazes it means. So of course speculation reigns.

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Is *Picatrix* the Latin version of an Arabic transliteration of some Greek name like Harpocrates, the Hellenistic Egyptian god of silence and mystery? Or does the Latin text foster something even more intriguing ... that *Picatrix* is actually the name of the tome's author? Heck if I knew or cared - I just wanted to dig in.

So, according to the general history of mighty magical tome, most of the most significant scholarly occultists of the late middle ages drew information from it or from material borrowed from it by other authors. Marsilio Ficino borrowed heavily from it for his "path breaking" Three Books on Life and Cornelius Agrippa's Three Books of Occult Philosophy were extensively influenced by it. Simon Forman, Elias Ashmole and the famous astrologer William Lilly used it as a primary source for their magical work. With the end of the Renaissance and the rise of scientific materialism the *Picatrix* dropped from sight. Today it remains one of the least known and most mysterious works of western occultism. The philosophy that grounds the *Picatrix* is the same Neoplatonism that fills the aforementioned books. It is not a hodge podge of magical recipes and rituals but a construct of detailed instructions in magical procedures gathered by Arabic occultists over two centuries. The astral magic of Mesopotamia and the magic practiced in Ancient Egypt and other magics that were clearly borrowed from Hindu tradition all contributed to the collection of magical technique in the *Picatrix*. The most important fact that must be considered about the *Picatrix* is that it is the product of a much older world. Its magic draws on a conception of the nature of magic and the universe that differs drastically from contemporary occult traditions ... its source of power is found in the macrocosm and not the microcosm, a power that is native to the universe and not the mage.

So, as fate would have it, as I pondered weak and weary on a Lovecraftian midnight dreary with the *Picatrix* in hand, the magic happened. I was not trying to cast any spells as that is not my 'thang' but it did prove to be a most fascinating excursion. Here are a few admonitions from the *Four Books of Picatrix* that will be used for purpose of review and to set scholarly examples...

EXCERPT BOOK ONE ~ CHAPTER 1 (of 7)

How you may know your degree (place) in the universe

Holy Moley! All the ramifications of what THAT could mean were attacking my brain in a renegade assault. Did that mean I would be able to identify my place in the Grand Landscape of All That Is? Was I about to unearth some long forgotten magical discourse that would reveal my true passage apart from my pathetic ride on the mundane autostrada?

Continued ...

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The first chapter opened with:

You should know, my dearest brother, that the best and most notable gift that God has given to humanity in this world is knowledge. By knowledge we become acquainted with ancient things, and the causes of everything in the world, and what more immediate causes are the causes of other things, and how one corresponds to another. By this we can know everything that is and why it is, and why one thing is raised above another in due order, and in what place exists the root and beginning of all things of this world: that thing by which all things are dissolved, and through which everything new and old is made known.

And ended with:

Wherefore you should know that the secrets we intend to reveal in this book of ours cannot be won unless you obtain knowledge first. Whoever desires to know ought to acquire a passion for the sciences and thoroughly scrutinize their rules, or it is ordained that theses secrets cannot be won except through wisdom and study in the sciences. In these secrets, however, is a great purity with which you may be able to help many.

O.K. So I am a dumbass lost in the perpetual abyss of defining "knowledge." Selfcompensation sets in...

Nam etipsa scientia potetsaest ... Knowledge itself is power (Francis Bacon)

AND

If a little knowledge is dangerous, where is the man who has so much as to be out of danger? (T.H. Huxley).

Maybe I am better off with...

Teach thy tongue to say, "I do not know.' (Maimonides)

Psych! This is after all a tome of astrological magic and the "knowledge" spoken of here is astrology. This includes planets, Fixed Stars and Mansions as used by the ancients. A word to the wise? Anahata Nadam Exercise

The ancient masters knew that each lesson learned during initiation studies and exercises of the great mysteries awakened the psychic centers of man. They also recognized the importance of sound that occurred during regular sessions of meditation since it was sound (word of God) that heralded creation before light was manifested.

The Hindu Anahata Nadam (sound of no instrument) Exercise is an old feat of awareness. The more it is practiced the more the psychic centers or chakras open. Here is how you go about it:

In a quiet space, sit on the floor cross-legged with your back erect. You will need to have a low seated chair or table in front of you that will allow you to rest your elbows comfortably. You should not be bending forward. Once in proper position, plug both ear openings with your thumbs to block any mundane sounds. The use of the thumbs provides the best sound blockage and does not hurt your ears. Next close your eyes gently and let your other fingers rest gently on your forehead. Allow your inward gaze to stay fixed on the point between your eyebrows and breath rhythmically through your nose for several minutes.

It is generally believed that the flow of cosmic energies is greatest in the right ear and if you are right handed this will most certainly be true. If you are left handed you may find the sounds are greater in your left ear. Trial and error will teach you the best ear for listening. As you begin to hear sounds and there will be more than one sound, you must learn to put your attention on the sound you first during a session.

According to Nadam you may hear the following:

Om Nadam: a rolling sound such as the mighty sea waves

Cin Nadam: humming sounds, whistling sounds, rainfall sounds or merely a high frequency sound

Cincin Nadam: the roaring sound of a waterfall

Ghanta Nadam: the sound of bells that are at a distance



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A Number is just a Number ... or is it?

YOUR HOME AND/OR BUSINESS ACTUALLY HAVE AN ASTROLOGICAL SIGN!

YEP – Every address has its own "sign" ... and the degree within that "sign or constellation."

NOPE – I'M NOT REFERRING TO

HERE'S HOW TO CALCULATE THE SIGN AND THE DEGREE OF THAT SIGN FOR EVERY ADDRESS.

Base information:

There are 360 degrees in the total zodiac - 30 degrees per sign or constellation - 12 signs.

The 360 degrees is our base from which to work: Aries, of course, is the first sign... and the others follow in order:

- 0 29 Aries
- 30 59 TAURUS
- 60 89 Gemini
- 90–119 CANCER
- 120 149 Leo
- 150 179 Virgo
- 180 209 LIBRA
- 210 239 SCORPIO
- 240 269 SAGITTARIUS
- 270 299 CAPRICORN
- 300 329 AQUARIUS
- 330 359 PISCES

Okay, let's say your address (hypothetically, of course) is 67 West Main Street. You can see that 67 falls within Gemini – and since Gemini begins at 60, the sign and degree are 7 DEGREES OF GEMINI.

ANOTHER ONE: 289 West Main Street

Using the chart, 289 falls into the Capricorn category. Since Capricorn begins at 270 within the total 360 degree wheel, 289 will be 19 DEGREES OF CAPRICORN.

Now, let's say your address is a higher number than 360.

ALL YOU HAVE TO DO IS DIVIDE 360 INTO WHATEVER NUMBER IS ABOVE 360 AND THE REMAINDER IS YOUR ANSWER (here comes the test for whether you are smarter than a 5th Grader):

Let's say the address is 1568 West Main Street:

4 <u>360</u> 1568 1440 128 (REMAINDER AND OUR ANSWER)

Again, you can see by referring to the above chart that 128 falls into Leo. Since Leo begins at 120, this sample address is 8 DEGREES OF LEO.

Pretty easy, huh?

SO, CALCULATE YOUR OWN HOME OR BUSINESS.

Now, what are the qualities of that sign? How does your home (or neighborhood) reflect that? And, where does that address (sign and degree) fit in your own personal natal chart? If the sign of your home happens to be your Venus or Moon sign, you are definitely comfortable there – you resonate emotionally. Maybe you're a private person and your house is Sagittarius. Well, forget the privacy. Sagittarius is anything BUT private. Plus, where are the planets NOW??? What relationship do the current planet placements have to your address?

Here's an example:

My address in California was 236 2nd Street. As you can see by the chart above, 236 is 26 degrees of Scorpio. Well, let me tell you – when the planet Pluto transited or hit that degree of Scorpio, some interesting things happened. Pluto is the planet of death/rebirth, transformation, privacy and digging deep (so to speak). It also rules PLUMBING AND SEWERS.


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Another example: When some friends of mine had Uranus transit the sign and degree of their home, they had some electrical issues and ended up re-wiring the entire house. Uranus rules electricity.

Political examples: The White House is located at1600 Pennsylvania Avenue – which converts to 10 degrees of Virgo. When John F. Kennedy was assassinated, Pluto had been transiting that very degree since his inauguration. Also, when Nixon resigned the Presidency, Neptune was transiting square that degree (from Sagittarius). Neptune dissolves. The most recent transit to the White House by a transpersonal planet has been Uranus. Guess what that event was??? The so-called democratic elections in Iraq and the newly elected "first time" President of that democracy, Talabani, visited the White House, along with Tony Blair, Prime Minister of Britain. Uranus represents INSTABILITY. No further explanation is needed.

By the way, 9-11 was under a transiting Pluto opposed transiting Saturn square to that very 10th degree in Virgo – The White House degree. That means that BOTH Pluto and Saturn (our structure and security) were both challenging the White House. Major power struggle. An entire book could be written about THAT scenario.

Now back to your personal information... You may need an Astrologer to provide the detailed information for you, i.e., the transits, progressions, your own chart, etc.—depending on your level of knowledge about Astrology. It IS good to know this information about your home and/or your business.

So, you've found that perfect someone and your friends are urging you to check in with an astrologer about the relationship and the compatibility quotient before you get in any deeper. You think about it but then begin to experience some reservations because you fear the astrologer is going to tell you to "run for the hills!" This is something that you don't want to hear yet somehow you know that it might be worth it to find out more about that "human embodiment of perfection" you adore.

Real astrology is about finding balanced solutions for dealing with situations and people. Psychology 101 tells us that "who" we are attracted to is strictly a psychological matter and while this is certainly true, it is not a full equation. Relationship Astrology does not discriminate ... it does not care about age difference, sexual gender preference, or racial preference. Astrology tells us that we are attracted to those who round us out as an individual and help us to fulfill Karma so our Souls can achieve growth in this particular life adventure. Astrology is a very accurate and useful tool for helping us understand another individual be it friend, lover, life partner, parent, child or even a boss on the psychological, emotional, and intellectual levels. When we understand how we react and interact with someone else we become equipped for equipoise and harmony and able to achieve common ground which promotes healthy communication and allows us to deal with the core essence of the any matter that challenges us. Does this mean that astrology is the magic pill that can turn EVERY relationship into "la-de-da pie in the sky" wonderful by supplying means to circumvent the sometimes harsh realities and disappointments we all experience at one time or another? Let's face it, not every relationship is meant to be BUT astrology does reveal the TRUTH of co-existence. Forgive this bit of a corny play on words but "the astrological truth can set you free"... one way or another!

So, what exactly does an astrologer analyze when comparing the energies of two individuals?

The Individual NATIVITIES

All good astrology starts with analysis of the NATAL CHART and relationship analysis is no exception. A NATAL CHART or NATIVITY is a basic map of where all astral bodies were posited at the time of an individual's birth. It is a guide to the personality and carries the "potentials" of an entire life. In relationship analysis, it gives the astrologer a good view of an individual's propensity to love and be loved. Transits and progressions show how current life events and life cycles are affecting an individual and if the time is ripe for love and commitment.

The SYNASTRY

A Synastry is an astrological study of human relationships. The word "Synastry" is derived from an ancient Greek term meaning "similarity of stars." A Synastry is an inter-chart comparison between two individuals. This means that all of the aspects that occur between the two charts come under scrutiny for their energetic propensities to produce ease and harmony known as soft aspects OR for challenge and block known as hard aspects. Astrologers use the Synastry to discern, compare and to view the causes of crisis and impetus for growth that can exist between two people. A perfect Synastry does not exist just as a perfect human being does not exist. An astrologer looks for balance when analyzing a Synastry between hard and soft aspects. Too much ease provided by many soft aspects would make a relationship boring and complacent. Too many hard aspects can cause volatility or propensity for control. The best combination of aspects grants stability with just enough spice to keep things interesting. In every relationship, the interplay of human nature requires adjustments and compromises if the relationship is to function and flourish. The benefit of the information provided by Synastry analysis should not be used to deem a relationship good or bad but rather to glean knowledge for the most positive interaction possible. Much light can be shed on the deeper ramifications of an initial attraction and whether it has the capacity to grow into a meaningful and healthy proposition. The propensity for longevity and stability can also be discerned. Most importantly, since the problems in most relationships tend to sustain themselves at an unconscious level, the Synastry can prove to be an invaluable tool for opening the door to conscious development and growth because it pinpoints the emotional and psychological factors inherent in human exchange.

The COMPOSITE

A Composite chart is actually a hypothetical chart that is calculated by using the midpoints of the inter-chart planets in the Synastry thus forming a chart of the "relationship." An astrologer will look for balance between the Synastry which tells you how you get along on all levels with someone else, and the Composite which relays how the relationship is likely to play out. The astrologer will study the basic composite to tap into the flavor of the relationship and the potential for partnership. The Composite has proven itself to be a very effective tool of discernment and of understanding a relationship and its perspective gives the individuals involved a bit more control to alter or repair issues that would have been left undone due to lack of awareness. The Composite map has its own set of rules for planetary placements and aspect interplay. It is an invaluable template of the future.

The OTHER ASTRAL BODIES

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Many astrologers like to include certain asteroids in relationship analysis as they add a bit more depth or often provide a different tilt on regular analysis. Some of the asteroids that are often used are Cupido, Eros and Amor. Sappho is often considered in Gay relationships.



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Cupido is named after that infamous mythological arrow shooting cherub Cupid. Those who have been struck by Cupid's arrow tend to become besotted with love and desire for their intended and whether or not this means "intended victim" or "intended idol" depends much on the cosmic condition of Cupido in a natal chart and in an inter-chart Synastry of those involved. Let's remember that in mythology Cupid was the son of Venus or Aphrodite the Goddess of Love so his intentions when he takes aim at a hapless human can lead to some pretty complicated situations when it comes to matters of the heart. For example, Cupido connecting with the planet Saturn can represent bondage or confinement, often self-imposed, because the idolizer is often acting as a martyr or an enabler just asking for heartache. While this is often a temporary situation it can be very disconcerting until reason and reality are restored. Conversely, Cupido connecting with the benefic planet Jupiter can signify release and freedom of choice, happiness and joy in a relationship be it old or new. So, regardless of your current status concerning Cupido remember a few things... the word "cupidity" is derived from the legendary god Cupid and it equates with carnal desire, greed and covetousness. Too much of a good thing can be unhealthy indeed.

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Eros defines unconscious instinctual sexual drive and eroticism. In other words it defines what turns you on via whom or what is sexually attractive to you. It is a good indicator of sexual spontaneity and the emotional response needed to consummate earthy desires. Acting as a type of "vitality meter" certain expressions of Eros can manifest as blocked sexuality and low physical drive such as when it I being adversely affected by Mars, Saturn or Pluto. ON the other hand, supportive energy from planets like Mars or Pluto can indicate a veritable love machine! Wowza!!!

Amor is a Roman god of Love who represents the lofty principle of "platonic love." The energy of Amor is expressed as loving kindness and compassion that houses no judgment and expects nothing in return. In many ways Amor is somewhat of a good will ambassador who provides selfless service to others. One of the important factors concerning the energy of Amor is that it is a good indicator of how an individual is capable of lending support both emotionally and physically to another person which is necessary in a good relationship and human exchange.



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Sappho was actually a Sixth Century B.C. Greek poetess who died because of unrequited love. In astrology she represents not only artistic sensitivity but also romantic sensitivity. Emotions of all kinds are associated with Sappho and include everything from sexual pain to ecstasy. All types of love-conjugal and non-conjugal, heterosexual, gay, single, multiple and even maternal are represented by Sappho. More importantly the power to heal through love by facing how love is presented in one's life is the gift of Sappho. When Sappho is adversely affected in a chart, the energy can manifest as emotional difficulties in sexuality and love due to lack of honesty within the self-regarding the fulfillment of true needs and desires.

For those individuals who are interested in the deeper esoteric meanings of relationships such as possible shared past life experiences, some astrologers who specialize in this genre can also offer a third type of Synastry chart.

The KARMIC SYNASTRY

There are different ways of calculating a Karmic Synastry depending upon the specialization of the astrologer. The astrological method mentioned here for the Karmic Synastry is based on an ancient Middle Eastern procedure encompassing reincarnation. In this process, it is believed that a soul is reincarnated into successive lifetimes until it has been karmically and spiritually purged of all desires through archetypical experiences expressed within the Zodiac.

A Karmic Synastry uncovers the subliminal nuances that underscore any type of significant relationship. These undercurrents are often hidden and tied to Karmic lessons.

Relationships are one of the gifts of life. All relationships, whether we perceive them as positive or negative, exist for a reason ... evolutionary soul growth. Karmic relationships provide awareness by stripping away any illusions connected to old Karmic baggage. Karmic relationships are often described as "unavoidably irresistible." This is because each individual sees in the other the capacity for help or assistance with the resolution of old Karmic issues. Residual memories of a past life can be so strong that an individual will seek or attract similar relationship themes in the current lifetime. These relationships may be viewed as fact finding expeditions used for collection of information that will be valuable at some future time in the resolution or closure of karmic signature.

Why is karmic analysis important? If one believes the basic tenants of reincarnation then it is easy to accept and understand that every single experience in life is representative of a choice made on a Soul level in order to gain wisdom and thus perfect the essence of the Spirit. With all of this wonderful and useful information available, who would not want to pursue it? The TRUTH and a good astrological analysis can set you free!

Fear Not the Void of Course Moon

There is probably more lore attributed to the Moon than any other celestial body. Its fast moving essence makes it an invaluable tool for astrologers but you don't have to practice astrology to heed Mother Moon's advice.

The transiting Moon spends approximately 2.5 days in each sign of the zodiac completing its total tour of the zodiac in about 28.5 days. There is a period of time just before the Moon transitions from one sign into the next where it makes no aspects to the planets. This is known as Void of Course. The period can last from minutes to up to several days. Any astrological calendar will depict the VOC and you can also get the info from the internet.

Some of you may be aware of the harsh "written in stone" warnings about the Void of Course. Astrologers will say to avoid "first." These include not making any important decisions, purchases, plans, engaging major projects, or even going on a first date. Things you might notice during a void have to do with silence. Public places like restaurants or malls might be more quiet than usual and people might act drifty and out of sorts. Be that what it may, it's time to throw all of the negativity out the window and accentuate the positive!

Here are some suggestions:

- Organize yourself and your surroundings. Get rid of junk; clean up your personal space. Make a list of restock items for home and office. Also make "to do" lists.
- Revise any written work. Mistakes in editing miraculously show up prominently during this time making correction a breeze.
- Engage in creative musing and let your imagination reign! Many innovative ideas are born during Void of Course periods.
- Relax, meditate, or sleep. Engage a bit of "Neptune Time" as I fondly call it! Those of you who meditate and/or channel may find your experiences during a Void of Course to be a bit "trippy." This is because the Moon is sending mixed signals since it is trying to adjust from one sign to another. What the heck... think of it as a cheap high!
- If you MUST shop, then go to the dollar store. If an item you purchase turns out to be useless you'll be less likely to care about having to return it. If, while you are out shopping, find yourself drawn to more expensive stores that you can't resist, engage yourself in window shopping. Save major purchasing for a better time... and the sales!

Raed Waen

Alexander "Odin" Agape

Raed Waen is a ceremonial technique of runecasting. Raed Waen means "riding the wagon" and refers to the runecaster being envisaged as a "rider in a heavenly wagon of the gods from which all things can be seen."

Traditionally, only handmade wooden or stone runes should be used in the shoat and the environment takes on great importance.

When shoating indoors the main axis of the room is the *rig* or guide line. Known as the "right line" it is merely an imaginary straight line on the floor that is aligned with the earth energies in the room. If the walls in the room are oriented according to European tradition, the axis of the rig should run from east to west. In Northern tradition, the axis of the rig runs from north to south.

The shoat is always lined up along the rig and the runes should be cast on a white shoat cloth. Traditionally, the white cloth should be the same bodily measurements of the runecaster:

Length = runecaster's height from the feet to the fingertips with arms stretched fully over the head.

Fathom (Width) = distance from the runecaster's out stretched arms at the sides, fingertip to fingertip.

The white shoat cloth is placed on the floor about one-third of the way along the rig so the runecaster's view is along the longer part of the room.

It is always best to cast the runes outdoors. When outdoors the rig should face towards the Sun at the time the divining is taking place. It is not recommended to divine in the darkness except for special circumstances.

Some runecasters use a STOL to sit on which is a ceremonial pillow embroidered with runic symbols. This is always placed at the negative end of the shoat. Others place another cloth on top of the white shoat cloth at the positive end of the shoat if they intend to use a mearomot (personal talisman) during the reading so they have an area to place it. Issues (never questions) are written (always with red ink) and placed on the second cloth along with the mearomot. Symbolic objects can be placed at the four corners of the white shoat cloth as well.

If you work with runes I highly recommend Raed Waen!

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Trinity Rosary of Protection

The TRINITY of PROTECTION ROSARY was custom made with three decades of 11 Amethyst beads, 11 Malachite beads and 11 Hematite beads with Lapis divider and drop beads. The focal is a silver Celtic cross and the decades are emphasized by a Celtic Knot.



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



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The Pros and Cons of Elves

Elves - I have always loved them. I even lived a lifetime as one.

J.R.R. Tolkien's writings were a major foundation for much of what went on in 1990 during our cosmic cult, Nuahj. One thing that Ross was particularly keen on was Elven language, specifically the Tengwar alphabet that is reproduced in the appendix to *The Return of the King*. The Egyptian hieroglyphic trumps that we used to channel various intelligences were limited in scope for his purposes. Ross needed a better cosmic alphabet to work with if he was going to achieve his goal of manifesting every archetype of consciousness involved with the Earth. But because I was a human inside an elven body, my subjective experience of time was multiplied by a factor of one month for every one minute of elapsed time in this dimension. "Aryan formula?" I asked.


