The Great Imposter

"Everybody lies." They lie in all sorts of ways with varying means. The more important question might be – why do others believe those lies? Worse - those lies are often accepted without outrage or care. What used to be 'trusted sources' no longer exist and the truth is just plain too inconvenient. Maybe it's just too much trouble to protest or maybe just have a need to believe especially if they are benefitting in some way ... or maybe it's just as simple as it's what we want to hear.

One of the greatest imposters who ever lived was Ferdinand Waldo Demara. He stands tall in the imposter hall of fame right up there next to forger Frank Abagnale Jr. who drove the FBI crazy for years. He was believed to possess a photographic memory and unusually high IQ.

Demara (December 21, 1921 – June 7, 1982) was born into an affluent family (until the Great Depression) headed by Ferdinand Sr. a motion picture operator. He remains one of history's most amusing and colorful conmen. Demara was so adept at what he did he earned the title of the "Great Imposter" and his antics eventually spawned a movie by the same name in the 1960's starring actor Tony Curtis which was based on a book written by Robert Crichton.

Who is this guy you ask?

Demara grew up in Lawrence, Massachusetts leaving home at age fifteen. Many feel that he was probably a genius because his scams were carried through with impeccably devised truths. By using stolen letterheads he was able to acquire a multitude of college records. He was a skillful forger who could assume the names and credentials or whoever he wanted to be at any given time.

The amazing thing about "Fred" however was his capability to perform any of the work associated with his alleged degrees. Demara also had a knack for disappearing when the heat was turned on and a situation became too risky.

He described his recipe for success as follows:

Two – "if you want power and want to expand, never encroach on anyone else's domain; open up new ones."

As Dr. Joseph C. Cyr, he successfully performed duties as a full functioning surgeon while aboard a Canadian Navy Destroyer where he was fondly known as a "miracle doctor." Parading under the guise of Dr. Robert Linton French, he easily gained a position as a college dean and later as Dr. Cecil B. Hamann, he was admitted to a Boston law school. His longest stints were held in monasteries and Catholic orders as part of the brotherhood. It is believed that under the guise of different personas, Demara was most likely accepted into more religious orders than anyone else in America. As one Ben Jones, Demara also had a successful career as an assistant warden/psychologist at Huntsville State Prison. The law finally caught up with Demara after a stint as a high school teacher in New England after friends recognized him in a photo that appeared in the January 1952 issue of Life magazine that ran a story on the Great Imposter. When brought before the judge, Demara swore to live a clean life and he did. He spent the rest of his days as an ordained minister under his rightful name. Demara died in 1982 at age 60.

Earth School and the Accountability Report Card

How good is your awareness meter and willingness to be accountable?

A recent "coined phrase" that has seemed to infiltrate the metaphysical community at large in recent years is, "There is no right or wrong ... there just IS." If an individual is ready to accept this statement, does that mean it is perfectly fine for that person to just go about doing whatever he/she wants at any given time because everything "just IS"?

Since the precepts of right and wrong constitute what we understand as concepts pertaining to human morality, let's approach this from a different angle. The basic common denominator of all universal understanding be it human derived philosophy, theosophy, physical science, or even religion is that all in the Universe is perpetuated by BALANCE. 

Spirituality. Morality. Ethics. These are the values that stand as human code for life conduct or at least they should.

How is all that is spiritual envelope the premise of both morality and ethics?

"Moral" is defined as dealing with principles of right and wrong behavior. It is particularly used to indicate a behavior that is right, such as when we say that we have a moral duty to uphold justice.

The word "ethical" refers to ethics, a theory or system for dealing with morality. It also is often used in the positive sense, such as when we speak of ethical practices in medicine.

"Spiritual" is defined as that which relates to the spirit, to sacred matters, or to religious values. Most people would probably agree that our outward behavior has a lot to do with our spiritual condition, both through reflecting that condition and through reacting with it to yield either spiritual progress or regression. Thus, the moral principles by which we live and the ethical processes that help us decide in any given situation what actions are right or wrong are intimately bound up with the spiritual.

Thus, the spiritual principles given to us by the Manifestations of God constitute a moral and ethical framework for dealing with whatever life sends our way. This framework becomes even more powerful when we draw upon consultation to bring differing viewpoints, backgrounds, and experiences to bear upon a problem.

On the subject of spiritual ethics, spiritual practices are observed to reinforce a commitment to a set of attitudes and thereby insure the manifestation of these attitudes in society, or to open the mind to spiritual insight to allow change in attitudes and thus improved spiritual and even physical well-being.

Now that you have learned your ABCs let's apply them. You need to be by yourself and need about 15 minutes of peace and quiet. Go back in your mind and find the thing which you believe is the very worst thing you have ever done or said. You do not have to say it or write it or anything like that. Just go back in time and place in your mind right before you decided to do it! This means not after or during but right before. Remember what you were thinking, feeling, and the status of your spirituality, level of mentality, emotional calmness (keep in mind any well-educated individual will tell you, emotional upset will cloud your reasoning and judgment) and what your physical condition was at that moment. Were you in any physical pain, or were you in good health? Now remember why you decided to go ahead and do what you did. You may have been told that to do such a thing was 'wrong', 'bad', or a 'sin' ... but at that particular time in your life, in the state you were in, did you really believe it or did you push such thinking aside because at that moment you did not yet believe that it was, for you a 'wrong' thing? 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

Individual Negativity and the Soul

"When an individual persists in negative choices and behaviors, the Soul will turn away and leave its lower incarnations to go through the necessary experiences that will teach them to choose differently, eventually bringing about a conscious choice to pursue ever greater spiritual realization and experience." - Matt Sharpe 2018

Often in the course of life we see many people that we consider to be very negative, whether in our work life or personal life, and especially within our families. We can also see on the news many that we ourselves would put into this category. We might even consider some of these an outright form of evil. Setting aside the many reasons that this conclusion could be considered purely subjective and wrong, and assuming instead that it be correct, one might wonder how this can work in the spiritual sense. Do these people still have a Soul? Have they been possessed by a negative entity? How can our minds reconcile this apparent contradiction?

Perhaps one of the premises were wrong, Or perhaps there is other pertinent information involved that one was unaware of. Reality constantly changes as does the information about it that one is aware of at any given time. It is foolish to ever assume that we have the knowledge of everything about anything, because inevitably life itself will prove that wholly untrue. At such times the lessons can be difficult to endure and see through until their final resolution which requires a change in point of view as to what are good motivations and choices and what is required to bring this change into our everyday reality.

The thing that makes this topic relevant to us is that we often see negative and even criminal behavior practiced by politicians, religious figures, celebrities and others who seem to be immune to facing any legal consequences for the things that they say and do. Then of course the rumor mill never stops churning out new theories (some conspiracies) and ideas about why these people do the things that we question.

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Do they even have a Soul? Has it been taken away or replaced? How can they do the things that they do? Are they possessed by a negative entity? Are they not subjected to the same spiritual hierarchy and laws that the rest of us have to work within, with karma and all of the rest?

There are a variety of things potentially going on with such people. These factors are ones that we all could be subjected to should we make the same types of choices, because literally no one is immune from them. Everyone is Soul in the first place, without exception. No one has or can lose one because It, by Its very nature, is unable to be owned, lost, misplaced, or injured. In the same regard the Soul cannot be taken away or driven out because these are literally impossible, again owing to the Divine and eternal nature of the Soul.

There are many situations where a person has negative entities attached to them and while possession is the end stage of this process, all the earlier stages are more an attempt to influence the decision-making process than anything else. With each negative decision, an entity gains more control and is heard and heeded to a greater extent than had been before. The influence and eventual possession perpetrated by negative entities often has much to do with the Soul "turning away" as it were. It allows space for the learning that experience alone can provide.

One might ask, "Why would a Soul turn away? Does it become offended or displeased?"

The Soul can potentially have any of a variety of opinions, but one of its primary concerns is beauty, and negative experiences are hardly beautiful to the one who must go through them. Do not let this imply that viewing what occurs is in any way detrimental to the Soul, because it is not. Soul's natural state has much to do with love, but mixed with knowledge and understanding which allow the fullness of anything it witnesses to be apparent to it. So while it may find the experiences chosen by its earthly self to be less than ideal, it is also in no way unable to view what transpires.

At the same time, what happens simply may not require Soul's attention to remain fixated upon those events, and having the desire for beauty.

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It can easily go find something beautiful to observe which can often hold its attention. Simply because it wants to observe that thing or situation or interaction, whatever it might be. This detachment that It has concerning the events in Its earthly existence must also be viewed and understood in balance with the various levels of being and the fact that overall, the lower human state must literally become interested enough to make the willing choice to seek the higher states of being and thereby set about attaining those for themselves, from the ground floor up to the top of Eternity Itself.

Often when one speaks about enlightenment or the search for it, this detail is completely missed. The secret is that this specific detail is absolutely required before any degree of progress can be attained in the spiritual sense. From the human standpoint there is a considerable way to go before ever reaching the goal, but from the viewpoint of Soul, love and contentment balanced with detachment, patience and understanding make its job an easy one because it experiences no urgency or impatience. Time does not exist for Soul, so how could it possibly be in any hurry to accomplish anything? It cannot, and even if it were able, it simply would not bother with such a desire.

By the time we gain an understanding of what it means for the Soul to turn away from its lower forms, it soon becomes very obvious that what we may have assumed at the start about this is not necessarily true, nor is that anywhere near all of what is truly involved within the idea. What is going on according to Soul's point of view is very different from the way we view things from the various lower states as we make our way up the ladder of consciousness. As the human form goes through its experiences in life, it can sometimes choose things that are not the best for himself, or can at times gain an attachment for a desire that can lead nowhere good. When these patterns begin to happen, the time becomes ripe for the Soul to step back and allow the lower aspects of itself to go through the lessons necessary to teach.

Most often the course of such experiences can be rough and regrettable, anything but pleasant to learn, not to mention the unpleasant nature of recognition of mistakes made and the admission of guilt and taking the steps to rectify what has been created.

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This is almost never pleasant to experience and the pride can take quite a beating as it is made to see its bad choices and the cost of having made them. The wading out of the cesspool of our choices is not fun, and once it has made its bite felt, the individual tends to not want to repeat it another time. These are the things that the Soul turns away from because its attention is not required as is the attention of the human and its astral counterpart who are directly in the thick of things and having to deal with them.

The Soul does not refuse to look because things are unpleasant, nor because It has some problem with watching it happen, it turns away because It can find better uses of Its attention than becoming mired in the day to day profligacy that has been exemplified by the choices made. Repeating such choices can only be a wasteful use of resources that are not necessarily so readily available from the start. A greater degree of prudence is advised at such times, and after a certain degree of mistake making and resolving the responsibilities that they bring, the hard experience tends to bring a greater degree and ability for sagacity not only in identifying the circumstances faced, but in discerning the not always readily visible situations with their varied interpretations.

This is where the value of dedication and fortitude on the part of the human become essential, for without those qualities, many will simply launch into a distraction that allows them to escape facing the truth about themselves that has been revealed to them. The desire for a distraction can be strong at a time such as this, and where a negative entity's involvement is a factor it will not miss the chance to try to tempt the individual with something that they desire. This also shows clearly the way in which these negative entities actually serve an overall purpose by educating us, despite the fact that their personal desire is anything other than to help a human in any way. Nothing escapes the Divine Will, known to us as many names, such as the Holy Spirit, Ism-i Asm, the Shabda or the ECK.

I must say that when the Soul decides to place its attention elsewhere, this is in a complete and total harmony with the Godhead, what ECKists call the Sugmad. IT knows all things and as the ECK is ITS expressive and creative Force, ITS knowingness must also be obviously included as each are really the same THING.

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And as God is in contact with Soul and communicates to It, each decision the Soul makes is known and openly communicated. Soul is not an Entity that is capable of deception, therefore truth and a complete honesty are basic characteristics of its behavior in every endeavor, eternally.

Generally speaking, the human is never aware of these actions of Soul because they haven't the state of consciousness to be aware of Soul. That comes through the constant effort and learning on a spiritual path. At some point Self Realization happens, but even after that no human is ever 100% constantly aware of themselves as Soul. Each of the factors that are and are not relevant to Soul are learned along the way so that information is available to the individual as they pay attention to the various things taking place throughout life. The goal is to be ever more aware of Soul and thereby to become aware of the choices it makes. Doing all of this is no small nor quick thing, but it can be accomplished within a single lifetime. As for the Soul and its choosing to remove its attention, that is never the end of the story.

Things always continue moving forward, even though it can be very challenging to be aware of all of the various factors as they develop in real time. The best that can be done is to always be learning more and experiencing more of life and paying very close attention to the processes our choices bring us through, both the good and the bad. Then using contemplation and actively seeking further experience on the inner planes, we can move ourselves forward by resolving our karmic debts and remembering the things we learned along the way. There is always another step to take to move forward. Even while we rest, life never pauses, so that tends to force us to focus the attention on what is relevant and necessary at every given moment. So start paying attention.

What useful skills have you learned recently? Which experiences have you lived through that have taught something about skills or awareness? Perhaps the awareness of Soul is not as distant as we tend to think of it as being.

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Breath of the Dragoi

We all have an inner Dragon. It is primal and coiled resting deep within ready to help us blaze the trail of our evolutionary journey.

The Dragon is completely fearless masculine energy. It seeks out fear – your fear. It wants you to push away all self-limitations, expand boundaries, break down barriers --- eat and drink in the fullness of life with a voracious appetite.

Why have you suppressed him? How can you heal him so he will manifest and help you towards maximum evolutionary transformation?

The first lesson of the Healing Dragon is that we can never heal ourselves until we remove the toxic garbage we store in our unconscious mind.

The second lesson of the Healing Dragon is that we **can** heal ourselves by removing the toxic garbage we have stored in our unconscious mind.

The third lesson of the Healing Dragon is that if we can heal ourselves, we can help any other person heal him or herself as well. Unconditional love heals everything.

To perform the Dragon Breath you must become very comfortable. Release constricting clothing and jewelry. Sit, recline or lay down in a comfortable position on a comfortable support. You will be breathing through two nostrils and your mouth during this process - in other words - inhale (breath in air) deeply through your nostrils and exhale (breath out) explosively and completely through your mouth.

Breathe in slowly and deeply. Relax completely and pause in your breathing as the Healing Dragon Energy burns up your unnecessary garbage stored deep within you. During this pause, you open your mouth in a relaxed manner. Then you exhale explosively and completely through your mouth as you blow out negative energy and released toxins. Do this as silently and as peacefully as possible but explosively and completely.

Continued ...

Practice this technique for one minute for three days. For the next three days, practice for two minutes. Add one additional minute for the third three days. Practice three minutes every day until you can peacefully and calmly use the Healing Dragon Breath for the full three minutes. You may find you can accomplish this in less than three times three days and there is no glory or shame in doing this. In our experience anybody can learn to do the Healing Dragon Breath for three times three (nine) practice sessions.

This is because three and three times three is the power number as and three times three is the power number associated with the Path of the Healing Dragon. Anything done three times or in three different ways is very powerful Healing Dragon energy.

Three is the esoteric number of the Healing Dragon Path.

Three is the esoteric number of the Healing Dragon Breath.

We breathe in Divine love, forgiveness and acceptance; pause to burn garbage, toxins and negative energy; and exhale any remaining negative energy, garbage residue and negative energy.

As you gain proficiency with the Healing Dragon Breath, let your mind wander down into your deepest levels. This will automatically happen when you take three Healing Dragon Breaths. The first part of the Healing Dragon Technique is to take three deep Healing Dragon Breaths. If you want, you can think thoughts like: What don't I accept about myself? As you do these three Healing Black Dragon Breaths. Then breathe normally but deeply and relaxed. Do the three Healing Black Dragon Breaths then close your mouth and breathe normally through your nose but deeply while remaining completely relaxed.

While remaining completely relaxed and breathing deeply, think about yourself and the things you've done in your life. Almost immediately you'll remember something you don't want to remember. Relax and let this memory of how you don't accept yourself play itself out. This may be temporarily emotionally painful. Let it play out.

Continued ...

When you reach the point where you've remembered everything you want to remember, return to doing the Healing Dragon Breath. As you breathe in, tell yourself you're a Child of the Divine and you made a mistake. As you pause briefly in your breathing, tell yourself you forgive yourself for this mistake. As you explosively exhale, release all these feelings of not accepting yourself and all the toxins that accumulated around this bad decision and forgive yourself. Let it go. It's done. Let it all go during three Healing Dragon Breaths.

Then relax and breathe normally but deeply. Allow the healing energy created by the Healing Dragon Breath heal you as you accept, forgive and love yourself. Feel the Divine Healing Energy (Dragon Healing) permeate your body as the Healing Dragon Breath transmutes the negative feelings you had toward yourself into acceptance, forgiveness and love. Feel the rest of the negative and toxic energy associated with this garbage leave your body through the Healing Dragon Breath.

Feel the load being lifted from your back as the Healing Dragon Breath destroys the negative feelings you had about you stored in your lower energy levels. Feel the release. Feel the new energy coursing through your body. Feel the healing take place and the negative and toxic energy leaves you. Feel the healing as you become filled with love, forgiveness and acceptance of yourself.

Use this technique for one or two major issues or one to three or four minor issues each *Healing Dragon Breath* session. Heal yourself slowly and completely day by day one day at a time.

Precious Stones and Healing

Precious gems along with crystals and stones have their own healing qualities and characteristics. It is usually costly and in some cases difficult to add these beauties to your healing collection but if possible they make a powerful addition to your meta-medicinal chest.

The <u>DIAMOND</u> is a Master Healer. It purifies both the physical and etheric bodies by reflecting the Will and Power aspects of God in alignment with the Higher Self. Diamond breaks up blockages in the Crown Chakra thus enhancing the full spectrum energies in the body, mind and spirit. As the gemstone representing the sign of Aries which rules the head and all of its anatomical parts, diamond aids the alignment of the cranial bones and also boosts brain functions. It also strengthens the nerves, sensory organs, glands and blood vessels. Many crystal healers with access to diamond have found that it is a good aid in recovery from a stroke.

If you cannot afford to add a diamond to your collection you might consider the zircon preferably white or hyacinth blue in color. The zircon is considered an All-Around Healer. It has traits similar to the diamond but it mainly aligns the subtle body while promoting emotional balance. It also strengthens the mind, stimulates the liver, aids insomnia, balances the pituitary and pineal glands, relieves bowel problems and cramps and helps delayed menstruation.

<u>RUBY</u>, the gemstone representing the strong sign of Leo, is connected to physical regeneration. It vitalizes the blood, enhances circulation, strengthens immunity and fortifies the spleen and sexual organs. If possible, choose a star ruby which has a high vibration. Raw ruby also works very well and if probably the most accessible and affordable. Remember the size of the stone does not matter – even the tiniest specimens hold great healing capabilities.

The <u>EMERALD</u> is the great detoxifier. It enhances the immune and nervous systems while strengthening the heart, liver and kidneys.

Emerald as the gemstone representing the powerfully physical sign of Taurus is a wonderful stone that aids in the recuperation from illness. It also helps headaches, sinusitis, eye disease, epilepsy, intestinal problems and heart ailments. If you cannot afford emerald try peridot which is considered an Overall Balancer and Tonic.


<u>SAPPHIRE</u>, the gemstone representing the analytical and health conscious sign of Virgo is known as the Great Dispeller. Sapphire activates the pituitary gland thus aiding the entire glandular system. Sapphire is a good pain reliever as it lowers fevers and even lowers one's blood pressure.

The Star Sapphire is also linked to healing intestinal issues which fall under the rulership of Virgo. When attempting to heal digestive issues, the metaphysician can also use the less expensive blue topaz which improves digestion and the assimilation of nutrients.





Those who believe in alien cultures and races know that the Arcturians have been attempting to work with humankind for a very long time. Their goal is to instill humankind with higher vibrations of Universal love through brotherhood which is at the foundation of the greater forms of power healing. As one of the most advanced of alien cultures, the Arcturians have a 7th dimension vibration and have been trying to advance the human race in a shift from the 4th dimension to the 5th dimension of consciousness. The stone attributed to the Arcturians is jasper. It is a most ancient stone that has always been used to deter negatvity away from Earth in order to stabalize her energies. It also represents the healing and protecting of "elemental man" which is the reference to humankind. The Arcturians know that the creative mind of man must be opened to a higher level in order to accept the concepts they teach. A replica of this grid can be used for your personal and creative healing meditation. A piece of jasper should be placed at the core. Any variety will work. Remember to request the healing power of Universal love and goodness to remove negativity then proceed with the usual healing meditation of your choice.

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Astro Signs and Wand Healing

Crystal or mineral wands are a great asset to healing ourselves and others. Wands may be used for purposes of massage (smooth, polished, and non-faceted) or for use on accupressure points of the body. Here is a list of highly suggested crystal or mineral wands for each zodiac sign. Enjoy and stay well!

ARIES

Aries rules the head and the face and the nerve endings of any of these areas tend to be sensitive. A <u>gentle</u> scalp massage using small circular motions with the body of the wand (never the point) from the base of the hairline at the back of the neck up to the top of the skull is soothing and helpful. Try wands made of Amethyst, Green Calcite or Smoky Quartz.

TAURUS

Taurus rules the neck, throat, and collarbone areas. Gentle wand massage of tiny circular motions starting at the area under the earlobes down to the back nape of the neck serves Taurus well. (In some cases it is almost erotic!). Wands made of Blue Lace Agate for the neck area and Lapis Lazuli for the throat area work well.

<u>GEMINI</u>

Gemini rules the shoulders, arms, hands, fingers, and lungs. As Gemini is a dual sign, two wands may be used to massage the hands and arms simultaneously with long gentle strokes. Start from the wrist and move up towards the shoulder. Use Hiddenite, Bloodstone, or Moss Agate wands on Gemini.

CANCER

Cancer rules the breasts and the stomach and Cancerians are prone to stomach upsets and digestive problems such as ulcers, gall bladder and gastritis. Working on the stomach area from under the breastbone to the naval is helpful. Gentle circular motions on this area will help to reduce "dis-ease." Try wands made from Pink Carnelian and Red Jasper. Continued ...

<u>LEO</u>

Leo rules the heart, spine and back. Careful massage work along the spinal column influences the vitality of the entire body for Leo. Use a gentle long stroking motion along each side of the spine with wands made from Carnelian, Quartz, or Bloodstone.

VIRGO

Virgo rules the intestinal tract and the nervous system. Short stroking and small circular motions as the massage technique on the lower abdomen will increase circulation. A fountain or mister nearby will enhance the healing stimulus. Use wands of Sugilite, Magnesite, or Amber.

LIBRA

Libra rules the kidneys and the lumbar region (lower spine and back). Extremely light massage using circular motions on the lower back up around the kidney area is very beneficial. Playing some nice peaceful music during the massage will enhance healing for Libra. Favored wands for this sign are those made of Green Jade, Natural Opal, and Amethyst.

SCORPIO

Scorpio rules the sexual organs and some of the nasal areas. Scorpios are often subject to problems with the urinary tract and cystitis and a good place to employ massage is from the area below the belly button to the top of the pubic area. A combination of gentle strokes and circular motions will bring healing to the external and internal areas. Wands made from Chrysoprase, Topaz, and Beryl work well. All Scorpios should drink plenty of water after any healing session.

SAGITTARIUS

Sagittarius rules the hips, thighs, and the liver. Use circular motions on the hips and strokes on the thighs. As a strong mental sign, Sagittarius might enjoy some good conversation during the massage session so his/her mind can be expanded and healed at the same time! Use wands of Quartz, Red Calcite, or Charoite.

CAPRICORN

Capricorn rules the skeletal system, knees, teeth and joints. Vertical strokes on the backs of the knees and some light stroking motions along the lower part of the back to the end of the spine (remember that Capricorn's ruler Saturn holds jurisdiction over the base chakra) help keep Capricorn in balance. Try wands made from Fluorite, Quartz, and Jadeite.

AQUARIUS

Aquarius rules the entire circulatory system as well as the claves, shins, and ankles. It is very important for the lower legs to receive stimulation in order to promote good circulation in the body. Long circular strokes along the lower legs and small circular motions around the ankles works well. The wands of choice are Moonstone, Amethyst, and Bloodstone.

PISCES

Pisces rules the feet and toes. Circular motions on the soles of the feet followed by a long stroke to each one of the toes is wonderful for Pisces. Also lay the wand horizontal just under the <u>back</u> of the toes in the space between the toes and the rest of the foot then gently pressing the toes to "hug" the wand is beneficial. A nice follow up foot soak and lotion application with a lavender based product would be top rate! Use wands of Pietersite, Smoky quartz or Lithium Quartz.

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Silent Night of the Dead

Happy Holidays! I have digressed some from my usual seriousness to present this article and hope that all who read this will understand that some of the information is fictional and that the article has been written for entertainment purposes. Sometimes you just have to have a little fun ...

The 21st or 22nd of December is the longest night of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and it is called the Winter Solstice. The longest night follows the day that has the smallest amount of sunlight so it stays darker longer. Many ancient cultures and religions celebrate this time in recognition of the rebirth of their deity or the Sun. I have often thought that this night would have more paranormal activity than Halloween night because for the simple fact that there is more night.

In the study of the paranormal you find that most things that are paranormal reside in the darkness. Many think that this a big holiday for Vampires - that they may even have a party. They may not even have to feed on the living this night as their urge or hunger is not there for one night. They can eat regular food and drink regular liquids with no side effects. Most of them have some type of food with garlic and use real silverware. They can even go to church and they can see their reflection in a mirror because it is like they are not a Vampire for just one night. However, this can cause them problems also because they do not have any of their supernatural powers. Therefore, if they run into someone who knows what they are, they will be as vulnerable as a regular human to injury and death. If a Vampire dies on this night, because it is one of the undead, it will change into something else that is undead ... a Zombie!

From an old Vampire hunters journal I found a story that I would like to share with you. There was a small town in Mississippi that was a host to one of these Vampire parties on the Winter Solstice sometime in the 1950s. They rented out a ballroom in a hotel and had a local restaurant to cater the food for the party.

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The same person said that most of the people at the party seemed like they were from another country because of the way they talked and that there were several people there that were not "white." This comment is what caused a problem with several locals who were racist, because in the 1950's in the small town Meridian, Mississippi this type of situation was "unheard of." Only whites stayed at this hotel and the only people at a party that were not white were the people who work the party. According to the journal, in the early evening, two of the locals tried to crash the party and had an altercation with several of the Vampires. Sometime after the people working the party left (because they were just hired for the meal), the locals returned with more of their friends. According to the journal three of the Vampires were killed by the locals and the rest were run out of town. This was a big mistake by the locals because the Vampires would have taken care of their dead. The locals wanting to hide the bodies buried them not far from town in an old building's basement. Just like when they first changed into vampires it took a day for them to change into zombies. The journal did not know who the zombies' first victim was but within three days there were 15 dead and another 20 or so that were sick. So there was a fully-fledged zombie outbreak by Christmas Eve - the history books do not tell that the National Guard was called out to quarantine the town. There is no record of anything that happened there except in the journal, which told that they had to go house to house with flamethrowers burning the zombies, the dead and all that were infected. The journal said that more than half the population of the town was gone by the end of the outbreak.

This was one of the stories that appeared in the Vampire hunters' journal relating how a vampire could turn into a zombie. It also relayed how to make a zombie that you could control. It told how a Hougan (a Voodoo Priest) used some zombified vampire's blood, herbs and the Hougan's own blood to make a potion that he would use to make a Zombie. He would pick his victim and tell them that he was going to curse them and for three days he would somehow get the victim to consume small amounts of his potion.

The victim would become sick with a fever and hallucinations that would end in their death. The victim would be buried and after three nights the Hougan would dig up their new zombie servant. It seems that the Hougan's blood and the herbs would allow them to have control over the zombie, but not for more than a week or two. If the Hougan became unaware that he was losing control over his zombie he would become the zombie's victim. However, as long as he had control over the zombie he would use it to kill his enemies, *without* feeding on them. This was how he would know if he was losing control over his zombie. Also that he needed to dig up the victim he had killed to destroy the corpse before it turned into a zombie. The Hougan would want to keep control, only ordering his servant zombie to kill people, so that he would appear to have absolute control over the dead. All the stories in the journal had a common thread in how to deal with a zombie and how they are made.

The journal relayed some of the strangest ways to put zombies to rest that I have ever read starting with the French and the guillotine. According to the journal, it was invented to behead a zombie placing its head in a basket so it would be easily disposed. The guillotine became an instrument of execution after a time because the French believed that evil people would become zombies if they were not killed by beheading. There were also hanging cages that they would put the zombie in and let the birds feed on them. It seems that birds and most animals are immune to being affected by the zombies so animals were used to help dispose of the zombies. They would put the zombies in a pit letting the rats feed on them. Some believe that this was what caused the plague so burning bodies was started. Zombies had always feared fire so it was used to round them up and destroy them. The flamethrower was originally invented to destroy zombies it was only used in war later on when the special zombie disposal units were sent into the regular war. It was said that every country had their own zombie disposal units that were used any time there was an outbreak. Many of the men that were in these special units became independent contractors and even Vampire hunters. The journal that I read was from a man that was in one of these units and became a Vampire hunter when he retired.

In his journal he said that the many fires that claimed a large number of lives were actually zombie disposal units doing their job. Our history could be written differently if we knew how many zombie outbreaks have actually happened. The journal said that he had not heard of a large outbreak in years, but there have been small ones that were taken care of quickly. He also talked of how some countries have tried to use zombies or their blood as a biological weapon. There were labs that studied zombies and tried to discover how to make use of the ability to reanimate the dead. The scientists have made the process quicker so that it did not take but an hour or two for a victim to change into a zombie. Luckily no one has used any zombie biological weapons but it has not kept the accidental infections from happing.

The bio zombies are not like regular zombies; you have to destroy all of them not just the head. You can chop off a hand or any part of its body and it stays animated until it is burned or destroyed by acid. In addition, the bio zombies did not decompose as fast as a regular zombie, he said that they actually were faster and stronger than a regular zombie. The scientists never found any use for their research except for the bio zombies they never found anything beneficial to man. The journal's last entry was about the folly of man trying to control something that should be destroyed.

If you go look for old journals you may find one like I have and if you read it the way you view the world may change. Like this article many journals have been written with many creative liberties which could cloud the facts. So if you find yourself at a vampire winter solstice party make sure that none of the vampires die unless you are ready to take their head sometime before Christmas!

PROTECTIVE MANDALA


Here is a physical remedy ...

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Kallikantzaroi

Growing up with two sets of Greek grandparents meant there were plenty of tales from the Old Country to go around especially on the holidays. This led me down the path of much research on various holiday topics. One of my favorite research projects was on the Kallikantzaroi a notorious goblin of ill repute. Here are my findings:

"It used to be a serious matter for a Greek couple to have a child born at Christmas. Although Christmas was a happy time it meant that the baby had been conceived on March 25, the Feast of the Annunciation, when the angel told Mary she would bear Jesus. Great care was needed to stop such a baby from turning into a Kallikantzaros, or goblin." – Strange Stories and Amazing Facts

The Kallikantzaroi appear during the twelve days of Christmas (aka winter solstice, Yuletide) from the end of December until January 6 (Epiphany). Depending upon one's point of view, the tale of these little horrors can be considered humorous or quite scary. A traditional Greek couple of my acquaintance swears they were subject to the actions of some Kallikantzaroi during the Christmas holidays some years ago. A thorough paranormal investigation did not turn up poltergeist activity as was expected and the cause remains unknown. Fortunately they were only harassed once.

I find the best source for information about the Kallikantzaroi comes from *Christmas in Ritual and Tradition, Christian and Pagan*, by Clement A. Miles.

"Traditions about the Kallikantzaroi vary from region to region, but in general they are half-animal, half-human monsters, black, hairy, with huge heads, glaring red eyes, goats' or asses' ears, blood-red tongues hanging out, ferocious tusks, monkeys' arms, and long curved nails, and commonly they have the foot of some beast."

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"From dawn till sunset they hide themselves in dark and dank places ..., but at night they issue forth and run wildly to and fro, rending and crushing those who cross their path. Destruction and waste, greed and lust mark their course."

When a house is not prepared against their coming, "by chimney and door alike they swarm in, and make havoc of the home; in sheer wanton mischief they overturn and break all the furniture, devour the Christmas pork, befoul all the water and wine and food which remains, and leave the occupants half dead with fright or violence." Many like or far worse pranks do they play, until at the crowing of the third cock they get them away to their dens. The signal for their final departure does not come until the Epiphany, when the "Blessing of the Waters" takes place. Some of the hallowed water is put into vessels, and with these and with incense the priests sometimes make a round of the village, sprinkling the people and their houses.

Besides this ecclesiastical purification there are various Christian precautions against the Kallikantzaroi - e.g., to mark the house-door with a black cross on Christmas Eve, the burning of incense and the invocation of the Trinity - and a number of other means of aversion: the lighting of the Yule (= Christmas time) log, a large log of wood called a *skakantzalos*, the burning of something that smells strong (sometime the Greeks will also burn old shoes, the smell of which keeps the wicked elves away), and perhaps as a peace-offering - the hanging of pork-bones, sweetmeats, or sausages in the chimney.

Just as men are sometimes believed to become vampires temporarily during their lifetime, so, according to one stream of tradition, living men become Kallikantzaroi. In Greece children born at Christmas are thought likely to have this objectionable characteristic as a punishment for their mothers' sin in bearing them at a time sacred to the Mother of God.

In Macedonia people who have a "light" guardian angel undergo the hideous transformation.

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Many attempts have been made to account for the Kallikantzaroi. Perhaps the most plausible explanation of the outward form, at least, of the uncanny creatures, is the theory connecting them with the masquerades that formed part of the winter festival of Dionysus and are still to be found in Greece at Christmastide. The hideous bestial shapes, the noise and riot, may well have seemed demoniacal to simple people slightly "elevated," perhaps, by Christmas feasting, while the human nature of the maskers was not altogether forgotten. Another theory of an even more prosaic character has been propounded that the Kallikantzaroi are nothing more than established nightmares, limited like indigestion to the twelve days of feasting. This view is taken by Allatius, who says that a Kallikantzaros has all the characteristics of nightmare, rampaging abroad and jumping on men's shoulders, then leaving them half senseless on the ground."

Such theories are ingenious and suggestive, and may be true to a certain degree, but they hardly cover all the facts. It is possible that the Kallikantzaroi may have some connection with the departed; they certainly appear akin to the Modern Greek and Slavonic vampire, "a corpse imbued with a kind of half-life," and with eyes gleaming like live coals. They are, however, even more closely related to the werewolf, a man who is supposed to change into a wolf and go about ravening. It is to be noted that "manwolves" is the very name given to the Kallikantzaroi in southern Greece, and that the word Kallikantzaros itself has been conjecturally derived by Bernhard Schmidt from two Turkish words meaning "black" and "werewolf." The connection between Christmas and werewolves is not confined to Greece. According to a belief not yet extinct in the north and east of Germany, even where the real animals have long ago been extirpated, children born during the Twelve Nights become werewolves, while in Livonia and Poland that period is the special season for the werewolf's ravening.

Those who wish to pursue further the study of the Kallikantzaroi should read the elaborate and fascinating, if not altogether convincing, theories of Mr. J. C. Lawson in his "Modern Greek Folklore and Ancient Greek Religion."

He distinguishes two classes of Kallikantzaroi, one of which he identifies with ordinary werewolves, while the other is the type of hairy, clawed demons above described. He sets forth a most ingenious hypothesis connecting them with the Centaurs."

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Protective Colors

Think about how people have associated color with different things like a power tie - the color is what indicates the power. 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Dream Sending

Dream Sending is defined as a magical ability to enter the dreams of another person in order to deliver a message, alter the content of the dream or influence the dreamer's actions and behaviors. It is a very old magical art dating back to the ancient Egyptians and its most common use is for love spells.

It is best accomplished during a waxing Moon and by invoking the Moon goddess Selene or the archangel Gabriel who rules the Moon and Monday considered the day of the Moon.

The ancient Egyptians used Dream Sending combined with sympathetic magic in special rituals to cause an individual to have a specific dream that suited what they were trying to accomplish which was often political in nature. In legend Nectanebo, the last native of Egypt used Dream Sending to cause the Greek queen Olympias to dream that she would bear a "god" fathered by Amun.

He next used this magical skill to influence Phillip of Macedonia by casting a spell over a hawk which flew over Phillip while he was asleep and whispered in his ear that queen Olympias would bear a child who was the son of a god. The result was Alexander the Great who always attributed his divine origin to Dream Sending.

The ancient Greeks and Romans were thought to be skilled in this art. They performed rituals for sending dreams by petitioning the aid of intermediary beings to serve as messengers. These messengers included 12 spirits who were known to govern the hours of the night and who were under the control of the goddess Selene. The entities were summoned in the middle of the night at the 'appropriate hour' during a special ritual.

In contemporary times those who work with dreams or dream therapy have discovered that they can successfully send a dream message to others however, the recipients are very unlikely to experience coercion and take action against their will.

Psychical researcher Harold Sherman found that he experienced the best results when he would "send" and "receive" impressions during the relaxed state bordering on sleep. When "sending" he would make sure the other person was sound asleep thus ensuring their "receptivity" to his sent messages.






Seal of Aldebaran



Hircus

Hircus was known as the goat star and to the Arabs the 'Shepherd's Star'. It abides in the constellation Auriga and lies in the goat huddled in Auriga's arms. In astrology it is associated with civil and military honors. In magick it was used to gain favor of authority and to heal disorders of the bones and teeth. Talismans were made of tin and held a sapphire along with the seal of Hircus. On the flip side an image of a wandering minstrel could be found. Incense made of horehound, mugwort, and mandrake were used to infuse it.

Sorcerer's Desk Reference – Auguries

AUGURY: Augury is a type of divination that involves interpretations in the signs of nature. It is generally believed that spirits or the Divine inhabit all that constitutes the natural world and can reveal Divine Will concerning human actions and decisions.

In Ancient Rome, Augury was considered a science. It was borrowed from the Etruscans and first started as an oral tradition. As it grew in importance it eventually became "institutionalized" and during the Roman Republic it was both taught and practiced at formal colleges. Augury was instrumental in politics where it was used to determine routes of action in elections, war declarations and installation ceremonies. Readings were made by *augurs* who were only superseded in importance by *haruspices* who were diviners who *read* the entrails/livers of sacrificed animals. Readings were kept in secret archives.

AEROMANCY: Divination of the future from the air and sky. More than just weather observation, it concentrates on cloud shapes, comets, spectral formations and other phenomena not normally visible in the heavens.

ALECTRYOMANCY: Divination based on the eating habits of birds, black hems, white gamecock or roosters. The bird of choice is allowed to pick grains of corn from a circle of letters allegedly forming or spelling words of prophetic significance. An additional method was to recite letters of the alphabet noting which ones at which the cock or rooster crowed.

ALEUROMANCY: Divination where slips of answers are rolled into balls of dough and baked. After baking, the balls would be mixed up with one chosen at random for the prophetic answer. It is believed that "fortune cookie" came from this ritual. Continued ...

ALOMANCY: Divination by salt thought to be the responsible for the many superstitions concerning salt (also known as HALOMANCY).

ALPHITOMANCY: Divination using special "cakes" which can only be digestible by those with a clear conscience. To a guilty person, these cakes would be distasteful.

AMNIOMANCY: Divination based upon the condition of a child's caul at birth.

ANTHROPOMANCY: Divination based upon the behavior of dying sacrificial humans. This is a very Ancient form of augury that was outlawed rather quickly as man advanced in understanding.

APANTOMANCY: Divination based upon forecasts of chance meetings with animals, birds and other creatures. This form of augury is popular today and is commonly known as Animal Totems and Animal Spirit Guides.

ARMOMANCY: Divination based upon the haphazard appearances of objects.

ASTRAGALOMANCY: Divination concerning the casting of marked knucklebones.

ASTRAGYROMANCY: Divination using dice bearing numbers and letters. Over time this augury developed into the modern version of fortune telling with dice.

AUSTROMANCY: Divination of the observation of the winds.

AXINOMANCY: Divination based upon the balancing of a stone on red hot axe.

AXIOMANCY: Divination requiring the use of a hatchet or axe that answers questions by its quivers or points out the direction of miscreants.

BELOMANCY: Divination requiring the tossing or balancing of arrows or their observation in flight.

BIBLIOMANCY: Divination by books or Bible passages.

BOTANOMANCY: Divination made from burning tree branches and leaves or briar or vervain branches.

CAPNOMANCY: Divination from patterns made by smoke rising from a fire.

CARTOMANCY: Divination from cards.

CATOPTROMANCY: Divination achieved through use of a mirror that has been turned towards the Moon to catch lunar rays.

CAUSIMOMANCY: Divination from objects placed in a fire. If they ignited and burned slowly it was considered a good omen.

CEPHALOMANCY: Divination using the skull or head of a donkey or goat which would be boiled.

CERAUNOSCOPY: Divination that draws omens from the study or thunder and lightning.

CEROMANCY or CEROSCOPY: Divination whereby melted wax is poured into cold water forming bubbles which are interpreted.

CHALCOMANCY: Divination of tones made by striking a copper or brass bowl.

CHEIROMANCY or CHIROMANCY: Divination of the study of the lines on and the shape of the hands (also known as CHIROGNOMY).

CHRESMOMANCY: Divination made from the utterances of a frenzied person.

Continued ...

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CLEIDOMANCY: Divination using pendulum made of a key on a string suspended from the third finger of a virgin. (Also known as CLIDOMANCY)

CLEROMANCY: Divination based upon the casting of lots using pebbles or other objects of color.

COSCINOMANCY: Divination using a spinning sieve.

CRITOMANCY: Divination requiring the use of barley cakes with hopes of drawing omens from them.

CROMNIOMANCY: Divination concerning the growth of special onions and the significance of their sprouts.

CRYSTALLOMANCY: Divination of crystal gazing.

CYCLOMANCY: Divination based upon a turning wheel.

CYLICOMANCY: Divination made from the appearance of images on water in a vessel or hole.

CUBOMANCY: Divination that makes use of thimbles.

DACTYLOMANCY: Divination that makes use of rings made according to planetary auspices.

DAPHNOMANCY: Divination that requires listening to burning laurel leaves in an open fire. The louder the crackle the better the omen.

DEMONOMANCY: Divination through the aid of demons.

DENDROMANCY: Divination associated with oak and mistletoe.

EMPYROMANCY: Divination made by observation of objects placed in sacrificial fires.

FELIDOMANCY: Divination based upon the observation of cat behavior.

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FLOROMANCY: Divination based upon the study of flowers and plants.

GASTROMANCY: 1. Divination based upon the reflections of lighted torches on water in a round glass bowl. 2. An Ancient form of ventriloquism whereby the voice is lowered to a sepulchral tone as though issuing from the ground. Prophetic utterances were delivered from a trance-like state.

GELOMANCY or GELPSCOPY: Divination based upon the tone of someone's laughter.

GEOMANCY: 1. Divination based upon patterns of dirt, sand or pebbles cast on the ground. 2. An occult practice which began with tracing figures on the ground which was later extended to include dots made with a pencil which were then interpreted. Some believe this practice was the forerunner of doodles.

GYROMANCY: 1. Divination based upon persons walking in a circle marked with letters until they became dizzy and stumbled at different points "spelling" out a prophecy.2. Divination drawn from the mutterings of people who were exhausted from wild dancing.

HEPATOSCOPY: Divination of "liver gazing" from sacrificed animals.

HYDROMANCY: Divination by water covering a wide range of lesser auguries such as the color of water, its ebb and flow OR ripples produced by pebbles dropped into it. An odd number was considered good and an even number bad. Some believe modern tea leave reading and coffee ground readings came from this augury form.

ICHYOMANCY: Divination concerning the examination of both living and dead fish.

LAMPADOMANCY: Divination from the observation of lamp flames.

Continued ...

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LECANOMANCY: Divination concerning the "whistling sounds" made from pebbles dropped into water.

LIBANOMANCY: Divination concerning the observation of incense smoke.

LITHOMANCY: Divination of the reflection of candlelight in precious stones. Stones of various colors are chosen and scattered on a flat surface. Whichever reflects the light the most fulfills the prophecy. Blue=good luck; green=realization of hope; red=happiness in love or marriage; yellow=disaster or betrayal; purple=sadness; black or gray=misfortune.

MACHAROMANCY: Divination concerning the observation of swords, daggers and knives.

MARGARITOMANCY: Divination utilizing pearls which are supposed to bounce upward beneath and inverted pot if a person is guilty.

METAGNOMY: Divination utilizing intuition while viewing scenes from the past or present while viewed during a hypnotic trance.

METEOROMANCY: Divination based upon omens signified by meteors.

METOPOMANCY or METOSPOSCOPY: Divination based upon line in a person's forehead.

MOLEOSCOPY: Divination based upon examination of moles on the human body.

MOLYBDOMANCY: Divination using noise of drops of molten lead cast into water.

MYOMANCY: Divination concerning rats and mice and the cries they make and the destruction they engage which are seen as prophetic tokens.

NEPHELOMANCY: Divination of the shape and movement of clouds.

OCULOMANCY: Divination of observance of the eyes.

OENOMANCY or OLINOMANCY: Divination concerning the color, taste and appearance of wine.

OENISTICY or ORNITHOMANCY: Divination based upon the flight of birds.

OMPHALOMANCY: Divination of the study of one's own navel.

ONEIROMANCY: Divination made from dreams.

ONOMANCY: Divination that answers the question, "what's in a name?"

ONYCHOMANCY: Divination concerning the study of fingernails in the sunlight looking for symbols that can be traced through reflections of light.

OPHIOMANCY: Divination concerning the study of serpents.

OVOMANCY: Divination of egg whites dropped in water.

PEGOMANCY: Divination of the examination of spring water or bubbling springs.

PHYLLORHODOMANCY: Divination consisting of the slapping of rose petals against the hands. The louder the sound the better. This augury dates back to Ancient Greece.

PHYSIOGOMY: Divination concerning the examination of facial features.

PODOMANCY: Divination of the soles of the feet.

PSYCHOGRAPHY: Divination using mysterious writing.

PYROMANCY or PYROSCOPY: Divination that utilizes the smoke and flames of a fire when powdered substances are thrown into it.

RHABDOMANCY: Divination using a wand or stick. It is of Ancient origin and thought to be the forerunner of the divining rod.

RHAPSODOMANCY: Divination accomplished by opening a book of poetry and reading a passage at random which serves as an omen.

SCIOMANCY: 1. Divination using aid of spirits. 2. Divination concerning the size, shape and changing appearance of the shadows of the dead.

SIDEROMANCY: Divination using the burning of straws on a hot iron and studying the shapes formed as well as any flames or smoke.

SPLANCHOMANCY: Divination of the study of the entrails of human sacrifice victims.

SPODOMANCY: Divination of the study of cinders or soot.

STITCHOMANCY: Divination accomplished by opening a book and finding a random passage that acts as an omen or inspiration.

STOLISOMANCY: Divination that draws omens from the odd ways in which people dress.

SYCOMANCY: 1. Divination performed by writing messages on tree leaves. The slower they dry the better the omen. This can also be accomplished by writing questions on slips of paper (also including a blank slip), rolling them up and placing them in a strainer above a steaming pot. Whichever roll opens first will be the question answered. 2. Divination based on the drying of fig leaves. The slower they dry the better.

TASSEOMANCY or TASSEOGRAPHY: Divination made by reading patterns of tea leaves left behind in a teacup.

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TEPHRAMANCY: Divination concerning the reading of ashes. Tree bark is often used for this purpose.

TIROMANCY or TYROMANCY: Divination using cheese... generally omens seen in its coagulation.

TRANSATAUMANCY: Divination based in events seen or heard during an accident.

UROMANCY: Divination concerning the inspection of urine.

XYLOMANCY: Divination made from pieces of wood. Some are picked up off the ground at random and discerned while other pieces are placed upon a fire while the "way" they burn is observed.

ZOOMANCY: Divination based upon reports of imaginary monsters and animals.

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Do real psychics need to rely on a record of correctness?

Prophet of Doom

Human beings love to be right about things or at least to figure out correct endings. It gives them a positive sense of self-assurance. But what if you are a psychic and rely upon having a record of correctness all the time?

Jacques Cazotte, a French eighteenth century writer was for all accounts a creative genius. His sense of foresight and boundary breaking imagination for creating works that embraced fantasy, the macabre and sci fi preluded other greats in the field such as Edgar Allan Poe. It is not too terribly surprising that his contemporaries believed that his brand of literary talent included dabbling in Ouija board sessions and scrying.

Cazotte was invariably known as a 'prophet' who was correct far more often than not and as a result his popularity scored him invitations into the salons and the rich and famous. One such invitation to a Parisian dinner party in the summer of 1788 led to some rather startling if not thrilling dinner party entertainment.

The guests were engrossed in discussions of the approaching Revolution and what might be in store as a result. Cazotte, of course was invited to speak on the subject to the esteemed guests ... and speak he did with the following ...

- King Louis XVI as well as many of the distinguished female guest sitting at the table would be executed.
- Writer and critic Nicholas Sebastian Chamfort was told he would meet with a long suffering death after trying unsuccessfully to slash his wrists 22 times.

Continued .

- Philosopher and mathematician Marquis de Condorcet whose ideas helped shape nineteenth century sociology, was told was told he would die on a prison floor after taking poison to cheat the executioner.
- Jean de la Harpe, a bitter atheist and critic, was told that the Revolution would change his non-believing ways and he would turn into a God-fearing Christian.

Needless to say, his predictions met with the range of human reactions from fear to hysterical laughter. Such prominent people could never meet with such horrific ends.

In 1789, the French Revolution brought in the historic abolition of the old order by mostly gruesome means. Mass executions on the guillotine changed the minds of many and most men of all social orders either joined the Revolution or left the country.

Nicholas Chamfort decided to join the Revolution in its early stages but became disheartened and disgusted by all the mass executions. In 1793, he was confronted by Jacobin leaders and threatened with arrest. He knew that sooner or later he would be executed so he decided to commit suicide. This turned out to be more difficult than he anticipated ... he had slashed his wrists with 22 death attempts only to die an agonizing death several days later.

Marquis de Condorcet was actively involved in the revolution and was even elected to represent the French capital in the Legislative Assembly eventually becoming its Secretary. He seemed to sail along successfully on the wave of the Revolution until he voted against the execution of Louis XVI and also when he voted to against the arrest of the Girondins.

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He became very paranoid believing the house he was hiding in was being watched. He spent three days on the run moving from place to place in the village of Clamart but as fate would have it, he was recognized and taken to Bourg-la-Reine where he was imprisoned. The next morning he was found dead on the floor. He had poisoned himself.

Jean de la Harpe was an early advocate of the revolution but true to his nature began to find fault with the new order. He was labeled a dissenter and thrown in to prison for five months. As predicted, his experience moved him to renounce atheism and become an ardent supporter of Christianity.

Jacques Cazotte own fate was dire as well. Gifts of prophesy at such a superstitious time in history were looked upon in a positive light. He was labeled an enemy of the people and a "Royalist." He was sent to the guillotine in 1792.

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Georges Gerapolis

"Madame," the Count said smiling, "I am very old." "But then you must be nearly 100 years old," exclaimed the Countess.

The Count St. Germain is mainly known in esoteric circles as the Ascended Master of the Uranian 7th Ray of Ceremonial Order and Magic. In some religious apocryphal circles he is believed to be the ever living embodiment of Cartaphilus the man who mocked Christ as he dragged his cross through the streets on the way to Calvary and was sentenced to walk the Earth until the Second Coming. Whatever the background belief, the stories surrounding St. Germain speak of a man with extraordinary abilities and talents.

Pictured above is the only known portrait (engraving circa 1783) of the man who called himself the Count St. Germain. He was or is according to all accounts both a mystery man and a Renaissance man. Housing a plethora of talents he was brilliant alchemist (chemist), a fine artist, knowledgeable historian, a philosopher, a political diplomat, an extraordinary jeweler, and accomplished pianist, violinist and singer, AND an astonishing linguist who was fluent in Spanish, Greek, Italian, Russian, Portuguese, Chinese, Arabic, Sanskrit, English, Dutch, German, Hindu, Persian and French. He had a reputation as a healer, prophet and a magician but his most amazing claim was that he was over 1000 years old.

The tale of Cartaphilus, the Wandering Jew was handed down through European folklore until the thirteenth century when travelers returning to England from the continent spoke of an encounter with a strange man who blasphemously claimed to be around in the time of Christ. Continued ...

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During the following centuries, more encounters with the strange man occurred and it seemed that they were taking place closer and closer to Western Europe. Then one day in 1740, a mysterious man dressed in black appeared in Paris. The fashion conscious Parisians were shocked at the man in black yet could not help but admire his many diamond rings and diamond shoe buckles. This led the Parisians to believe the handsome and obviously Jewish man to be an aristocrat of great wealth and he was welcomed into Parisian society. They could not identify the man but the superstitious citizens of Paris believed him to none other than the Wandering Jew.

The man identified himself as the Count of St. Germain - an accomplished man who had traveled widely and learned much about the world including many arcane lessons of the occult. He spoke freely about his travels and his great age claiming to have known many historical celebrities. Historical skeptics often tried to trip him up by questioning him about historical details that were trivial and not well known but the Count always replied with astonishing accuracy. If a conversation turned to religious matters, he would become somber and tearful while movingly describing Christ as if he had known him personally. No matter what the subject, the Count left his audience quite perplexed.

The Count's claim to be much older than he looked was actually put to the test when he met the elderly Countess von Georgy who recognized him as the same person she had met 50 years earlier in Venice. The countess was in a state of disbelief that the man she met so long ago did not look a day over 45. When the Count proved to her that he was the same man she said that if it was true he must be "a devil."

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The Count took great offense to this remark raising his voice stating, "For pity's sake! No such names!" With that he turned his back on the astounded Countess and left the room.

Another oddity about the Count was noticed during the time he spent in the court of Louis XV, King of France. At the numerous banquets he attended it was noticed that he would abstain from food and wine occasionally sipping only mineral water. The courtiers noted that if the Count did eat it was always in private. They also assumed that he was a vegetarian.

In 1745, the Count St. Germain turned up in London. It was the time of the Jacobite Rebellion in Britain and the Count somehow managed to get himself arrested for spying. He was described as a mad man going by the name Count St. Germain who played the violin and sang wonderfully. He was also said to have used the power of hypnotic suggestion to persuade his captors that he was innocent. The latter allegation was verified by Anton Mesmer, the creator of Hypnotism who claimed to have taught the Count the art of hypnotism. He claimed that the Count, "possessed a vast understanding of the human mind."

The Count was seen in many places over the years:

1756 - The Count was spotted in India by Sir Robert Clive.

1760 - History records that King Louis XV sent a Monsieur St. Germain to Hague to assist with the treaty between Prussia and Austria.

1762 - The Count took part in the deposition of Peter III of Russia and took an active role in helping to bring Catherine the Great to the throne. Continued ...

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1769 - The Count opened a mass production factory in Venice where he developed a synthetic form of silk.

1770 - The Count engaged Russian politics and was seen in the uniform of a Russian general.

1774 - After the death of King Louis XV, the Count appeared in Paris to warn the new King Louis XVI and his Queen Marie Antoinette of the approaching danger of the French Revolution.

1784 - Prince Charles of Hesse-Cassel, Germany announces that the Count is dead and will be buried in a local church cemetery.

1785 - After his alleged death and burial the Count shows up at the Congress of Freemasons.

1867 - The Count is briefly seen in Milan at a meeting for the Grand Lodge of Freemasons.

1869 - Theosophist Annie Besant claims she met the Count and Theosophist Helena Blavatsky claims he had been in contact with her.

1914 - During the early days of World War I, two Bavarian soldiers capture a Jewish-looking Frenchman in Alsace. After an all-night interrogation, the man still refuses to give his name and warns them that the war is futile and that it will end in 1918 with defeat for the Germans. He goes on to tell them that in 1939 the "anti-Christ" will lead Germany into another war but will be defeated after committing "inhuman, unspeakable things" in six years. After the prophecy, the man begins to sing and sob and the soldiers thinking him quite mad let him go.

Historically, the only surviving manuscript penned by the Count St. Germain, *La Tres Sainte Trinosophie*, is kept in the library at Troyes, France. To date it has resisted every attempt to decipher or translate it with the exception of the following passage:

"We moved through space at a speed that can be compared with nothing but itself. Within a fraction of a second the plains below us were out of sight and the earth had become a faint nebula."

Undecipherable works seemed to be his forte - there are some who believe St. Germain had a variety of embodiments including that of Roger Bacon. Bacon is often considered the author of the Voynich Manuscript a strange composition that to date cannot be deciphered

Who was or IS St. Germain - the "Wonderman of Europe" ... a hoaxer or a supernatural time travelling being with alchemical skills?

As a metaphysician he was skilled in the healing arts and herbology. Some believe that his use of herbal elixirs combined with good eating habits prolonged his life and the life of others. The Countess von Georgy is said to have lived an incredibly long life never looking her true age due to the herbal intervention of St. Germain. It was believed that he was also an Eastern adept who employed yoga and meditation and that he could communicate with animals. King Louis XV of France was so taken with his alchemical skills that he provided the Count with a laboratory and residence at the royal castle of Chambord after the Count magically removed the flaw in one of the King's diamonds. In another European court, the Count asked for some deer bones and some boughs from a tree for a demonstration. He retreated to a large empty room and after a short time alone invited the guests into the room.

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They were greeted by a room that was transformed into a lush forest with grazing deer. He was a philanthropist who gave away valuable paintings, jewels and money. He secretly helped the poor and aided charitable institutions. He was a patron of science and technology and its progressive role in the spiritual awareness of mankind.


In metaphysical circles, Saint Germain is an Ascended Master - a light being who has earned the right not to reincarnate. The concept of the Ascended Masters was brought into the limelight by the Grand Dame of Theosophy Helena Blavatsky (1831-1891). Blavatsky's Theosophical movement was based upon teachings she claimed to have received from a group of living adepts she called 'Mahatmas' or 'Masters.' Various organizations, past and present, have incorporated the Ascended Masters into their belief systems but to date skepticism still exists as to whether she perpetrated fraud and if the Masters were merely real persons who were 'fictionalized.'

History makes one thing clear about Helena Blavatsky and that was her concern that the concept of the Masters would fall victim to 'pretended agents' who would use the teachings for commercial gain. This certainly has become a fulfilled prophecy. Despite all of the controversy, in an unpublished article written in the last year of her life, Blavatsky stated that she felt that the publicizing of the Masters had done more good than harm even she herself felt entrapped by the myth she had created in an attempt to keep the identities of the men she called Masters hidden and protected.

In Metaphysics, Saint Germain is connected to the 7th RAY of Ceremonial Order and Magic. As part of the White Brotherhood he works with the Archangel Zadkiel and he teaches that the highest form of alchemy is the transformation of one's consciousness into the Divinity of the Higher Self.

He is the sponsor of the United States and the hierarch of the Age of Aquarius, who comes bearing the gift of the violet flame for world change.

Aside from the Wonderman of Europe it is generally believed by metaphysicians that Saint Germain's other Earthly personas and incarnations include Francis Bacon, Samuel the Prophet, Christopher Columbus, Roger Bacon, Alban, Merlin, and a High Priest of Atlantis. Will the Count appear again? Not everyone believes that the Count is dead. In 1972, a Parisian named Richard Chanfray appeared on French television claiming to be St. Germain. On live TV he successfully turned lead into gold using nothing more than a camping stove. What do you believe?

The "Lie" of the Land



According to its modern discoverer author Katherine Maltwood (1927), and its original discoverer the infamous Dr. John Dee (300 years earlier), the Glastonbury Zodiac covers an area of thirty miles in circumference around Glastonbury Tor in England. The huge terrestrial figures are shaped by natural earth formations, roads, tracks, rivers, pools and a few areas that were filled in by ancient people to finish out the pattern. Each sign of the zodiac is represented in order and the entire work is believed to have been originally fashioned by a mystical society circa 500 BC.

The Law of Psychic Phenomena

This of course includes the Law of Psychic Phenomena which concludes that man possesses in addition to his mundane consciousness, mental abilities and mental processes of which he is unaware.

It is quite simple really by concept until you start venturing into those areas of cloudy vagueness of the unconscious. Yet, if we accept that we are made up of billions of interacting cells that house the total body of knowledge that our spiritual consciousness has gathered and retained during pre-existence and infused into us currently in this space and time, the ensuing phenomena becomes easier to digest and discern. These so-called memory cells can and do react physiologically to all this input.

MORPHIC RESONATION ... Have you ever had and unexplained and irresistible affinity with a thing or a place?

There are several definitions out there but basically Morphic Resonation occurs when the subconscious is physically confronted with a person or place that is so profoundly familiar from a past life that it triggers the conscious mind and brings about a total recall that is totally recognizable. The resonation occurs whole body – mentally, emotionally and spiritually and is undeniable. If you're thinking déjà vu, think of it as compounded and multiplied by a gazillion.

On June 22, 2010, a young man who we shall call "Jim" visited the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. He had recently been undeniably drawn to the Egyptian exhibit and the cut-away model of an Egyptian Royal Tomb of the New Kingdom that was exhibited there. He had no interest in anything "Egyptian" prior to this sudden impulse to go there and "see." He had never read any Egyptian history and was not attracted to any media concerning Egypt. If anything he had a dislike of the culture.

Oddly enough, Egyptian artifacts are only a small part of the Anthropological collections in the museum. There is a more extensive exhibit in the American Museum of Natural History which is located across Central Park from the Met. It was the cut away that interested Jim. Upon his first view of the exhibit, Jim became cognizant of "mistakes" in the structure and presentation of the model right down to the minutest details. He began to scribble notes all over his brochure so that when he returned home he could verify these "strange" findings. He was quite disgruntled feeling that the exhibit owed more to Hollywood than to Egyptology and he was certainly mind boggled at the notes he had scribbled on the brochure. AND search Jim did, finding enough evidence which provoked even more recognition and also a visit to a past life regressionist.

Not just one but two past lifetimes associated with Egypt were uncovered. One life was that of a physician and the other as an architect located in the Valley of Kings who worked on the cliff tombs carved there. The architect was apparently of the same age Jim was currently when he first received the impulse to go "see."

PNEUMATIC TRAVELERS ... Are you on a Universal mission?

This concept often gets confused with Time Travelers (transversing the time/space continuum) and Soul Travel (expansion of consciousness). In essence, Pneumatic Travelers are those souls who have agreed to be sent by a higher power (God/source) wherever they are needed in the universe. "This little boy opened the door," Hilary recounts, "and I said, 'I'm looking for the person that runs Love in the Mirror.

And he kind of blushed and said, 'I do.' [...] His mission in life is to help people and to give them a chance to really look inside themselves and see the beauty in what sometimes is an environment that normally wouldn't have anything beautiful coming out of it ... I wish everybody could spend some time with that kid. [...] He's like an old soul."

An old soul indeed.

Don't take my word for it. If you ever get the chance, sit down and talk to a Pneumatic Traveler. They will make you feel as though you're in 1st grade. Hilary certainly did.

WALK-INS ... WHO the hell are you?

Confusion of course abounds once this happens since soul # 2 has not been afforded the role of entering the body of an infant who is allowed to grow and acclimate to the environment. There-in the suspicions abound and further issues occur. It can get quite messy and is always illogical.

"I am troubled by the walk-in theory as another escape mechanism. I believe the whole idea of walk-ins to be a false concept. According to the proponents of this theory, tens of thousands of souls now on this planet came directly into their physical body without going through the normal process of birth and childhood. We are told that these possessing souls are enlightened beings who are permitted to take over the adult body of a soul who wants to check out early because life has become too difficult. Therefore, the walk-in soul is actually performing a humanitarian act, according to devotees of this theory. I call this possession by permission ... To give another soul permission to come in and take over your karmic life plan defeats the whole purpose of your coming to Earth in the first place! It is deluded reasoning to assume that the walk-in would wish to complete their own karmic cycle in a body originally selected and assigned to someone else. If I am a senior in a high school trigonometry class, would I leave my class and go down the hall to a freshman algebra class where a student is struggling with an exam and tell him I'll finish the exam for him so he can leave early? This is a "lose-lose" situation for both students -- and what teacher would permit it?"

ASTRAL CATALEPSY ... Get the f*ck off me!

Most of us have experienced this one - that totally unnerving episode of being woken up out of a dead sleep and feeling paralyzed and unable to breathe as if something or someone weighing a ton was sitting on the chest. Paranormal Investigators often have a field day with this ruling out or ruling in menacing entities that are generally up to no good. The most important point to note in these cases is that the person is not insane they simply took a trip out of body.

The term astral catalepsy was coined way back in 1930 by Sylvan Muldoon an American researcher and writer who spent most of his life recording his own personal astral travels at night while he slept...

Muldoon's first recorded astral trip during sleep started with his waking up in the middle of the night to find himself unable to move, see or hear, with a painful sensation of severe pressure on his head. As his senses and ability to move returned, and the pressure on his head subsided, he realized that he was actually outside his body, floating above the bed and able to look down on himself and watch himself sleep. He was conscious of his spirit being pulled from a horizontal position to a vertical one as it left his body, and of embarking on a very detailed tour of the house in which he, in his spirit form, was able to move with great ease through doors and walls ... And then he was above his body again, his spirit was pulled back into a horizontal position, and he experienced the same paralysis, loss of senses and pressure on his head that he had gone through earlier. After a feeling of being jerked abruptly back into his body, he sat bolt upright in bed, in a complete panic, able to remember and immediately write down the whole sequence of events with crystal clarity. ~ Phenomena

Enter the medical department and sleep research...

Sleep paralysis usually occurs at one of two times. If it occurs while you are falling asleep, it's called hypnagogic or predormital sleep paralysis. If it happens as you are waking up, it's called hypnopompic or postdormital sleep paralysis. During sleep, your body alternates between REM (rapid eye movement) and NREM (non-rapid eye movement) sleep. One cycle of REM and NREM sleep lasts about 90 minutes. NREM sleep occurs first and takes up to 75% of your overall sleep time. During NREM sleep, your body relaxes and restores itself. At the end of NREM, your sleep shifts to REM. Your eyes move quickly and dreams occur, but the rest of your body remains very relaxed. Your muscles are "turned off" during REM sleep. If you become aware before the REM cycle has finished, you may notice that you cannot move or speak. Sleep researchers conclude that, in most cases, sleep paralysis is simply a sign that your body is not moving smoothly through the stages of sleep. Rarely is sleep paralysis linked to deep underlying psychiatric problems. Up to as many as four out of every 10 people may have sleep paralysis. This common condition is often first noticed in the teen years. But men and women of any age can have it. Sleep paralysis may run in families. Other factors that may be linked to sleep paralysis include:

- a lack of sleep
- a sleep schedule that changes
- mental conditions such as stress or bipolar disorder
- *sleeping on the back*
- other sleep problems such as narcolepsy or nighttime leg cramps
- use of certain medications
- substance abuse ~ courtesy WEB MD

This leaves the issue regarding when exactly REM occurs as it is tied to the ability to astral travel in the first place and the whole OOB and Lucid Dreaming variants. **The latest:** 'sleep paralysis' or 'astral cataleptic state' occurs as a result of the transition Beta - Alpha, and Low Alpha brainwaves. It's really the first stages of sleep, the 1-4 cycle is a journey from beta (alert) to alpha (relaxed), then theta (asleep) to delta (deep sleep, coma). There have been studies proposing that the Obe experience happened during the REM stage, so, neurophysiologically there would be no distinction between Obe and dream.


Everyone knows that thousands of broken fragments of rock and metal known as asteroids exist between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter. It is no surprise that since the discovery of asteroids astronomers have wondered if all this cosmic debris is actually the remnants of a long ago exploded planet.

The Titius-Bode Law of 1776, implemented by German mathematician Johann Titius and later popularized by astronomer Johann Bode supports this theory. The law is based on a series of numbers -0, 3, 6, 12, 24, 48 and 96. Note that each number is twice the preceding number with the exception of the first two numbers. Now adding 4 to each number the series becomes 4, 7, 10, 16, 28, 52 and 100. Marking the Earth's distance from the Sun in units, this series denotes an great accuracy of the distances between the planets Mercury through Saturn and the Sun – Mercury at 4, Venus at 7, Earth at 10, Mars at 15, Jupiter at 52 and Saturn at 95. All of these are in very close agreement with the Titius-Bode Law. The problem is there is no planet at number 28 marking the space between Mars and Jupiter.

This gave early astronomers food for thought and circa 1800 a group of astronomers met in Lilienthal, Germany and agreed to search the skies for the missing planet. Although many asteroids were discovered named and numbered no other evidence was found in what became known as the asteroid belt.

In contemporary times the interest still exists regarding the missing planet theory and a Russian academician Sergei Orloff has even named the missing planet Phaeton after the son of a Greek god who was destroyed by the gods because he drove his chariot so recklessly he scorched the Earth and would have annihilated it had he been allowed to continue.

Adding to the story, Russian writer Aleksandr Kazantsez and his friend Professor Felix Zigel further theorize that the civilization that once populated Phaeton invented thermo-nuclear weapons millions of years ago and its misuse led to the destruction of the "missing planet."
